Regular Meeting Minutes

June 3, 2026

Commissioner, Daniel Walker, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, June 3, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Chauvin, Walker, Davis, Henry, Smith and Cenac. There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Jack Moore, Anthony Alford and Jeff Daisy.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Davis, to approve the meeting minutes dated May 20, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the closing of the Placid Floodgate and Humble Floodgate. He also spoke about finishing up the general maintenance of the floodgates.

Trey Middleton gave updates on the HNC, due to the rain, there wasn't much work done.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Daniel Walker asked the board to approve the APTIM invoice #747358 in the amount of \$375,882.00. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Cenac. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Sealevel invoice #23105-023 in the amount of \$6,497,598.56. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve Operating and Engineering invoices. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Cenac. The motion passed without objection.

Under Executive Directors Report, Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the recommendation of Award, contingent upon Contractor, for the approval of the proposed Rate Schedule for the Emergency Services Contract, Land and Marine Based Operations for the 2026 Hurricane Season. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo discussed the possible action to enter into an agreement with LDWF for repairs to the Western Levee of the Pointe-Aux-Chene WMA Unit. A call was received about a portion of the levee by Island Road that needed repairs. TLCD would do the work in place of the LDWF. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

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Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the new office building update. TLCD is projected to go to bid by the end of the year. She also spoke about her upcoming trip to Vicksburg, MS to go explore the GIWW design.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Nicole O'Dell provided updates on the following project: HNC Lock Complex. She gave updates on the cofferdams, concrete pours that are being done, marsh creation areas, and the operations area.

Mrs. O'Dell asked for the approval of Change Order No. 10 in the amount of \$372,555.50 to realign the strut and waler system of the GSSG Cofferdam. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave updates on the following projects: Bayou Black Emergency Levee Repairs Project – ATF Permit Project, Reach B Levee Lift Project, Reach H2/H3 Levee Lift to EL. 15' Project (H3 is complete), Reach A Levee, Wine Island Restoration Project and the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project. The Bush Canal had to have a few repairs but should be back running by the second week of June.

Neil Angelette with Angelette Designs gave an update on the Reach L Pipeline. The project is complete and will have Substantial Completion soon. He also gave updates on the Reach L (Apache Farm) Interim Levee Lift to +12'.

Under the President's Report, there was nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Walker, with a second by Commissioner Cenac, to adjourn the June 3, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:30 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
