Regular Meeting Minutes

March 18, 2026

Board President, Anthony Alford called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, March 18, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Alford, Moore, Chauvin, Davis, Daisy, Henry, Cenac and Smith. There was one Commissioner recorded as absent, Daniel Walker.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated March 4, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the routine maintenances in areas.

Trey Middleton gave updates and an end of the year presentation on the HNC lock, Reach A, Reach H-3, Reach I, Reach J-2, Reach K, CPRA Projects, Eastern Terrebonne Restoration Project, Wine Island Restoration Project and Reach L.

Trey Middleton asked for approval for the purchase of a new water pump for the Bush Canal Floodgate Dry Dock Project. The previous pump had damage from IDA and was not repaired being it was functional at the time. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 28 February 2026. Motion by Commissioner Daisy, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of Resolution 26-003 certifying compliance with the Louisiana State Bid Law for the Morganza to the Gulf Reach L Apache Farm Levee Rehabilitation Project. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the Recommendation to Award to Low Land Construction in the amount of \$1,253,250.00 for the Reach J Indefinite Embankment Supply and Delivery Project. Motion by Commissioner Moore, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.
