Regular Meeting Minutes

May 20, 2026

Finance Chairman, Jack Moore called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 6:00 P.M. on Wednesday, May 20, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Walker, Moore, Chauvin, Davis, Daisy, Smith and Henry There were two Commissioners recorded as absent, Tenner Cenac and Anthony Alford.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin, to approve the meeting minutes dated May 4, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on the routine maintenance in areas, all maintenance is done and everything is in working order. He spoke about the Upper Little Caillou closure due to the incoming weather.

Trey Middleton gave updates on the HNC lock, Reach A, Reach H-3, Reach I, Reach J-2, Reach K, Reach L.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Operating and Engineering Invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Financial Report FME 30 APRIL 2026. Motion by Commissioner Daisy, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval to advertise bids for the Reach J-1 +15' Levee Improvement Project. Motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Daisy. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hildago asked for the approval to advertise bids for the Reach L Apache Farm +12' Levee Improvement Project. Motion by Commissioner Walker, seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the Core Leadership coming up on May 21, 2026, The I-Storm Workshop that she attended, and the Parish meeting she will attend on June 1, 2026 for water levels.

There was no Executive Session.

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Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Jay Duplantis with All South Consulting provided updates on the following projects: Reach K Water Structures, Reach K Rehabilitation, and the J-1 Levee Improvement Project.

Philip Chauvin with T. Baker Smith gave updates on the following projects: General Services Agreement and Reach I Phase 2 Improvements. In the general services agreement, the only open project is the articulated mats.

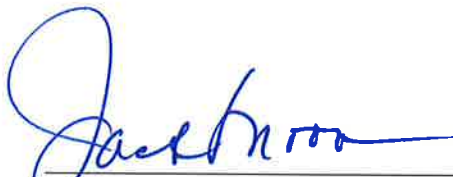

He gave updates on the Reach L Pipeline Floodwall which will be done within the next few weeks for substantial completion. He also gave an update on the Reach L Apache Levee Lift to +12', plans will be complete in the next few weeks.

David Boudreaux with Delta Coast Consultants gave updates with his May Monthly Status Report. He spoke about HNC with lots of concrete being poured recently. Reach I, J-2, and phase two for the EOC building, the plans will be done by the second week of June.

Mr. Boudreaux asked for the approval of Amendment No. 2 for All South Consulting Engineers for the Engineering Services on the Reach J-1 Levee Project. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Seconded by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Mr. Boudreaux asked for the approval of Amendment No. 10 for Angelette Design to the Engineering Contract in the amount of \$11,266.50 for pipeline vibration monitoring. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Henry, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the April 15, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 6:30 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
