



TERREBONNE LEVEE & CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Regular Meeting Minutes



Finance Chairman, Jack Moore, called to order the Board Meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at the Terrebonne Levee & Conservation District Office located at 220A Clendenning Road, Houma, Louisiana, at 12:00 P.M. on Monday, May 4, 2026.

Angela Hidalgo led the opening prayer and Commissioner Henry led the Pledge of Allegiance to the American Flag.

Upon the roll call by Mrs. Hidalgo, Commissioners recorded as present: Moore, Chauvin, Walker, Davis, Henry, and Cenac. There were three Commissioners recorded as absent, Arlanda Smith, Anthony Alford and Jeff Daisy.

Under approval of minutes, there was a motion by Commissioner Henry, seconded by Commissioner Cenac, to approve the meeting minutes dated April 15, 2026. The motion passed without objection.

Under Management's Report, Jonathan Gautreaux gave updates on J2 which was started. He also confirmed that Placid Canal will be reopening on Wednesday or Thursday of this week. He spoke about the damage that was done to the Lower Dularge hole which was repaired.

Jonathan asked for the approval of a five-year lease with Caterpillar Financial Services in the monthly amount of \$4,106.33 for the rental of a 326-07 Model Excavator. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, seconded by Commissioner Davis. The motion passed without objection.

Jonathan asked for the approval of a quote with Vermeer Midsouth for the purchase of a Hydro seeder in the amount of \$56,125.00. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, seconded by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Trey Middleton gave updates on the J2 to +15' project as well as the Reach K project.

Under Finance Committee Matters, Jack Moore asked the board to approve the APTIM invoice #709465 in the amount of \$398,537.67. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve the Sealevel invoice #23105-022 in the amount of \$8,008,395.67. Motion by Commissioner Henry, Second by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Chairman Moore asked the board to approve Operating and Engineering invoices. Motion by Commissioner Davis, Second by Walker. The motion passed without objection.

Under Executive Directors Report, Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval to enter into a Cooperative Endeavor Agreement by and between Restore or Retreat and TLCD in the amount of \$1,000.00 to assist in its efforts to aid in restoring our coastline. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the approval of the Professional Services – Task Order Edition contract between T. Baker Smith and TLCD. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo asked for the authorization to advertise RFPs for the HNC lock quality assurance testing. Motion by Commissioner Chauvin, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Mrs. Hidalgo spoke about the Financial Statements due in May, the Lower Bayou Dularge Emergency Repair Update, and the 4-3C West Levee collapsed culver emergency removal.

There was no Executive Session.

Under Planning & Projects Committee Matters, Nicole O'Dell provided updates on the following project: HNC Lock Complex. He gave updates on the cofferdams, concrete pours that are being done, marsh creation areas, and the operations area.

Mrs. O'Dell asked for the approval of Change Order No. 10 in the amount of \$372,555.50 to realign the strut and waler system of the GSSG Cofferdam. Motion by Commissioner Cenac, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Kevin Dezarn with GIS Engineering gave updates on the following projects: Bayou Black Emergency Levee Repairs Project – ATF Permit Project, Reach B Levee Lift Project, Reach H2/H3 Levee Lift to EL. 15' Project (H3 is complete), Reach A Levee, Wine Island Restoration Project and the Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project. The Bush Canal Floodgate Maintenance Project should be completed by May 23, 2026.

Mr. Dezarn asked for the approval of Change Order 3 for Allied Shipyard to add an additional twenty-eight (28) calendar days Motion by Commissioner Walker, Second by Commissioner Chauvin. The motion passed without objection.

Neil Angelette with Angelette Designs gave an update on the Reach L Pipeline. They have an estimate date of completion in spring. He also gave updates on the Reach L (Apache Farm) Interim Levee Lift to +12'.

Mitch Marmande with Delta Coast Consultants asked for the approval of Amendment No. 17 to the Engineering Services Contract between APTIM and TLCD for the addition of the UAV (Unmanned Aerial Vehicle) surveying to the rate sheet. Motion by Commissioner Moore, Second by Commissioner Henry. The motion passed without objection.

Under the President's Report, there was nothing to report.

There being no further business to come before the board, it was moved by Commissioner Henry, with a second by Commissioner Chauvin, to adjourn the May 4, 2026, board meeting of the Terrebonne Levee and Conservation District at 12:34 P.M. The motion passed without objection.
