- 5. Financial Statement Report
 Bailey presented to the Board the February 2021 General Fund and CRDC Fund financial statements. The Board
 unanimously approved a motion by Babin, second by W. Lee to approve the February 2021 General Fund and
 CRDC Fund financial statements.
- 6. Executive Director Report
 - Comite River Diversion Canal Project: Rietschier said that the construction of the Project is currently in the hands of the USACE and DOTD. ARBC remains 1 of 4 partners of the Project. Monthly meetings are held to provide updates and discussion amongst the 4 partners. He provided the status of the construction, real estate, rights-of-way, and utility relocation of the project. Utility relocations and right-of-way acquisitions are going on simultaneously all along the channel. Provided and discussed with the commissioners a "timeline spreadsheet" from the USACE. There will be a lot of work done in 2022. Current estimated completion date is December 2022.
 - Rietschier presented the LA DOTD Report: Utility Relocations and ROW acquisitions are ongoing as follows: 57 out of the 83 parcels acquired, 1 suit is pending, all have been appraised and 24 are under negotiations, utilities continuing to relocate, LA 964-bridge design complete, CMAR LA 67-bridge design at 90% complete, LA 19-bridge design at 90% complete.
 - Hunting Lease(s): 6 hunting leases are coming up for re-bid but ARBC is waiting on a response from the USACE on whether or not to re-bid or terminate the lease(s).
 - The Board unanimously approved a motion by Bailey, seconded by Thompson to allow the Executive Director to proceed towards the development of a river maintenance manual for the Amite and Comite Rivers. A river maintenance program for the Amite and Comite Rivers should be considered as an integral part of the overall strategy to ameliorate flooding losses in the Basin.
