- Comite Clearing and Snagging: The overhead flight was completed. CSRS is identifying blockages.
  They will run H&H models and determine if there are any negative impacts. Access points will be
  identified and a Benefit Cost Analysis will be performed on the project. ARBC may have a report
  within 2 months. Bankston said that in regard to access, ARBC has statutory authority to give
  rights of entry onto private property to do engineering work. ARBC would have to pay for barges
  to get that material off.
