MINUTES OF THE LOUISIANA ARCHITECTS SELECTION BOARD July 15, 2020

A meeting of the Louisiana Architects Selection Board (LASB) was held via Zoom Teleconference on July 15, 2020.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 am by Mr. Michael Hunley, Chairman. Those members present were: Ms. Lisa Smeltzer, Mr. Michael Hunley, Mr. Benjamin Bradford, Mr. Brent Baumbach and Mr. David Abrams. Those members absent were: Ms. Jill Maumus. Mr. Fred Dugas was present as proxy for Mr. Mark Moses. Also present as Legal Counsel was Ms. Candice Rodgers Hillman, Attorney General's Office.

The first item of business was the adoption of the May 20, 2020 minutes. Ms. Smeltzer moved to adopt the minutes, and Mr. Baumbach seconded the motion. With no opposition, the May 20, 2020 minutes were adopted.

The next item of business was to ask for any new business. Ms. Smeltzer advised that the agency for Item #1, Replacement of John S. Kyser Hall, Northwestern State University, Natchitoches, Louisiana, requested in-person interviews. The interview process is scheduled for July 30. The Louisiana Purchase room has been reserved; it seats 250 people and will accommodate social distancing issues. All attendees will be required to go through a temperature check and wear a mask throughout the day. She stated that five board members are available; this is a quorum, but three of the five members are State employees. The interview date could be postponed but only by two weeks. Mr. Hunley stated that this was acceptable. Ms. Kroll stated that two other board members are available for a virtual meeting. She further discussed the possibility of a dual meeting, i.e. both virtual and physical. Ms. Rodgers Hillman advised there is no legal issue with a virtual and physical meeting. Mr. Hunley advised Ms. Kroll to research the feasibility of a dual meeting. Regardless, the in-person interviews will be held on July 30.
