I. Call to Order and Welcome – Ms. Gerri Hobdy, Chairman LSAC Ms. Hobdy welcomed Tommy Usrey, Executive Director of LPA/LPAA.

II. Approval of Minutes

III. Committee Reports – Committee Chairs

a. Advocacy – George Marks

Mr. Marks has been working with LPA/LPAA and encouraged Council members who have not joined the LPA to join and actively participate. He encouraged Council members to attend a LPA regional meeting and invite organizations in their region to attend.

b. Special Events - Dána La Fonta and Gena Gore

i. South Arts - Performing Arts Exchange (PAE) 2011 – Dána La Fonta

PAE will take place in Baton Rouge on September 21 – 24, 2011. The Division of the Arts is the local host. In addition to council representation on the Local Host committee, council is invited to serve on working committees. The public will be invited, and 800 – 1000 people are expected to attend the conference. The host committee is looking at the possibility of raising funds to give stipends to artists, and showcasing Louisiana artists regionally or some other way that Louisiana artists can be incorporated in PAE.

Background Information about South Arts

South Arts is the regional arts agency that works in partnership with the state arts agencies of Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Kentucky, Louisiana, Mississippi, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee. South Arts is funded by the National Endowment for the Arts, member states, foundations, businesses and individuals. Their mission is to strengthen the South through advancing excellence in the arts, connecting the arts to key state and national policies and nurturing a vibrant quality of life. Dána La Fonta and Derek Gordon serve on the South Arts board.

c. Policy - Michael Echols

Ms. La Fonta gave the strategic planning update in lieu of a policy report.

LSAC Board Appointments – Gerri Hobdy

There are discrepancies with the current terms of office are posted online by the Governor's Office. Ms. La Fonta is working with the Governor's Office on the current listed appointments and to make sure the rotation of terms is what the Council understands them to be. Currently there are vacancies on the council.

IV. LDOA Strategic Planning - Dána La Fonta Planning timeline & status

Ms. La Fonta distributed handouts of the Strategic Plan Survey; Outline and Draft Schedule of the LDOA 2012-2015 Strategic Planning Process; and the Strategic Planning Proposed Timeline. The Strategic Planning Survey will be distributed using Survey Monkey. The survey will be distributed to all constituents in Louisiana, anyone who applied for a grant through the Arts Division, the 9 Regional Development Agencies, Artsmail lists, listservs, corporate and business partners, and anyone who participates in the arts. The Council is encouraged to participate.

The Council requested formal names tags. The Arts Division will provide name tags for the Council and the Arts Division staff when the new administration logo has been approved. Staff will provide the Council with an updated listserv.

Creative Capital – Ann Russo

Ms. Russo gave a PowerPoint presentation of participating artist's work and distributed handouts on the Creative Capital Weekend Retreat for Artists. 70 artists have been impacted by Creative Capital training since 2008. A summary, of the positive career impact for individual artists and outcomes of the program, was distributed to the council.

Discussion ensued from the Board and LPAA representatives regarding electronic and hard copy access for applications to accommodate artists unfamiliar with new technology. Like ADA accommodations including traditional paper methods of applying would be taken in consideration in future and similar calls for applications to allow for more artists to

participate or compete for state programming opportunities. In the case of Creative Capital the use of technology as a competitive tool is part of the curriculum and thereafter artist would be in an informed position to choose their level of computer literacy.

Council also requested staff prepare a glossary for the LSAC binder, with common acronyms and their meaning. Due to changes on the council, the Ms. Hobdy requested an updated list of the currently serving LSAC members for distribution at the next meeting.

At this time the Arts Division is only offering Stabilization grants. Stabilization grants provide general operating support to Louisiana arts organizations and institutions.

Division staff is offering grant workshops throughout the state designed to walk applicants through our new online application system, Cultural Grants Online (CGO). Division staff will train applicants in the grant submission process, provide helpful tips on grant writing, and meet with staff one-on-one for technical assistance. Applications are due by the close of business March 1, 2011. Council members are encouraged to attend a workshop in their area and inform the staff if they are present so they can be introduced.
