The Executive Director announced that the first two topics are Hearing #2011-027, Naruto, Inc. and Hearing #2011-029, Jackel Distributors, LP. Considering there was no representation on behalf of either Naruto, Inc. And Jackel Distributors, LP, Chairman Brandt continued the hearings and directed Commission staff to resend the hearing notices to Naruto, Inc. And Jackel Distributors, LP.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on April 28, 2011 from J. C. Bruno, Counsel for Fisker Automotive, Inc.:

"Thank you for your earlier correspondence and advice. We have filed the application as a motor vehicle manufacturer and requested a waiver of the bond. Please include this on your May 9 agenda. I am providing December 31, 2010 financial statements and the following information which I hope is helpful to the Commission in its role of protecting the public.

1. The financial statements for 2008-2010 (Exhibit A) as authenticated by the Affidavit of Matthew Paroly are attached. The December 31, 2010 Balance Sheet included in the attached financial statements shows:

A. Current Assets are \$164,498,000 and Current Liabilities are only \$56,708,000. The sale of vehicles (which begins shortly) will provide additional funds. Thus, Fisker is able to meet its general business obligations as they come due.

B. Total Assets are \$286,887,000 and Total Liabilities (including long term debt) are \$238,864,000. Thus, Fisker assets substantially exceed its liabilities.

In conclusion, on an asset test or meeting obligations test, Fisker is financially healthy.

2. A February 11, 2011 news article (Exhibit B) references a Department of Energy loan. In order to obtain that loan Fisker had to provide satisfactory evidence of its good financial condition.

3. The attached article also announces an additional \$150,000,000 of financing to enable Fisker to

complete the launch of the Karma this spring and the 2012 launch of its second model.

4. As mentioned, Fisker is nearing the end of pure development stage with the beginning of production and revenue producing sales and it has obtained the capital required for its operations, as described in the attached article.

5. The size of the loan and equity investments by public and sophisticated private investors provides good evidence to the Commission that Fisker is backed by parties with the resources and commitment necessary for Fisker to be successful in the market. A list of its 5% shareholders is attached as Exhibit C. Its investors include suppliers such as its battery supplier and its drive train supplier, in addition to investment funds, the most well known of which is Kleiner Perkins, an investment fund specializing in energy. A list of Kleiner Perkins' investment is also attached as Exhibit D to show how Fisker fits with other progressive companies to help address America's energy needs in an efficient manner.

6. The development stage of Fisker has been costly and it includes the purchase of an idle General Motors plant in Wilmington, Delaware to produce its second model, a hybrid family sedan. However, the development stage has been successful and Fisker is bringing fresh automotive engineering to the automotive market.

7. Shareholders' equity (when considering preferred stock) is a positive:

8. In addition to the stamp of approval from leading private and government analysts, Fisker has also been successful in attracting quality dealers.

In conclusion, Fisker has the financial resources to bring its high tech environmental friendly cars to market and has quality dealers to sell them. We ask that the bond be waived and the license application be approved."

At this time, the Chairman opened the floor for Tom Casey, Esq., representing Fisker Automotive, Inc. to address the Commission Members regarding Fisker Automotive's sales and financial situation. After reviewing their balance sheet and financial statement, the Chairman stated that Fisker Automotive's financial situation was not strong and the operating deficit was high. After much discussion regarding the financials, Commissioner Hoyer made a motion to waive the bond requirement for one license year, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) for Fisker Automotive, Inc. at which time new financials would be reviewed. Commissioner LeBlanc seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on April 15, 2011 from Jeanne C. Comeaux, Counsel for Bad Boy, Inc.:

"We represent Bad Boy Mowers, a company from Arkansas who recently applied for a manufacturer's license with the LMVC to do business in Louisiana. Bad Boy Mowers manufacturers certain low speed vehicle and therefore needs of manufacturer's license. Pursuant to La. R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a.), we are requesting a waiver of the million dollar bond requirement for licensure. Detailed financial statements will be provided so that the Commission can feel confident in Bad Boy Mowers' financial wherewithal and stability in order to meet any and all financial obligations to the State of Louisiana.

Accordingly, please place Bad Boy Mowers and its request for a manufacturer's bond waiver on your May 9, 2011 docket, if possible. Ryland Kieffer with Bad Boy Mowers and I will attend, at which time Mr. Kieffer will be happy to answer any and all questions you may have about his company or its financial strength. If you have any questions about the foregoing request, please feel free to call me at anytime."

At this time, the Chairman opened the floor for Jeanne Comeaux, Esq., Ryland Kieffer, Vice President and David Brogdon, CFO of Bad Boy, Inc. to address the Commission Members regarding Bad Boy Mowers' financial report. The representatives of Bad Boy, Inc. responded to the questions posed by the Commission Members regarding the operations of Bad Boy, Inc. and its financials. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Farver made a motion to waive the bond requirement pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) for Bad Boy, Inc. Commissioner Hoyer seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on April 27, 2011 from Jeanne C. Comeaux, Counsel for Caterpillar Inc.:

"We represent Caterpillar Inc., a company based in Peoria, Illinois that is contemporaneously applying for a manufacturer's license to do business in Louisiana. Caterpillar produces a Vocational truck, a vehicle that is a dump truck (see attached picture). CAT plans to use a dealer network for sales to the ultimate consumer, including Louisiana Machinery Company, LLC in Louisiana. Louisiana Machinery will sell this vehicle only to end consumers.

Pursuant to La. R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a), we are requesting a waiver of the million dollar bond requirement for licensure of a manufacturer here in Louisiana. Attached hereto are pertinent financial statements of Caterpillar Inc., evidencing the company's substantial financial position. (For review of Caterpillar's 2010 Annual Report with detailed information, please go to www.cat.com). For year ending 2010, Caterpillar posted total assets of over \$64 billion dollars. Caterpillar Inc. is willing and is able to meet any and all financial obligations it has to the State of Louisiana and its citizens.

Accordingly, please place Caterpillar Inc. and its request for a manufacturer's bond waiver on your May 9, 2011 docket, if possible. J.P. Kumar, corporate counsel for Caterpillar Inc. in Peoria, Illinois requests that he be allowed to participate telephonically to answer any question that Commission may have of him. If telephonic participation is not possible, Mr. Kumar will appoint a regional representative to attend. As always, if you have any questions about the foregoing requests, please feel free to contact me at anytime."

At this time, the Chairman opened the floor for Jeanne Comeaux, Esq. and Ben Hulsex of Caterpillar to address the Commission Members regarding Caterpillar's financial report. The representatives and their counsel answered the questions of the Commission Members regarding their business and its financials. After a brief discussion, Commissioner Ryan made a motion to waive the bond requirement pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) for Caterpillar Inc. Commissioner Corley seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on March 23, 2011 from Charles Buckie LeBoeuf, owner of Buckie's Mini Trucks, LLC:

"My name is Charles Wayne LeBoeuf. I go by my nickname Buckie. I am applying for a Distributor's License. I am requesting a waiver for the \$1,000,000 bond. I operate a small business by the name of Buckie's Mini Trucks, LLC. I have a used dealer license. These mini trucks are imported from China. Up until now, these mini trucks only came used. Now they are offering new mini trucks. I have several used mini trucks leased to the different refineries in this area. They have really proven themselves as far as durability and fuel efficiency. Since I am a small business this \$1,000,000 would not be feasible for me to have to have annually for 5 years. This is a great product and I know that Louisiana would benefit from having them here. I would be the only distributor so I would be the only one that would be at a risk. I believe in these trucks so much that I am willing to take the risk. They have already been passed for street use. The were put under the new car commission."

The Executive Director stated that no one present for Buckie's Mini Trucks, LLC. The Chairman reviewed Buckie's balance sheet and suggested deferral of this matter until the next meeting to allow time for Buckie's Mini Trucks, LLC to submit a current financial statement. Commission Hocevar make a motion that Buckie's Mini Trucks, LLC to submit a current financial statement for bond waiver request. Commission Duhon seconded this motion.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence received on April 1, 2011 from Van G. Bohn, General Manager of Three Brothers Luxury, L.L.C. DBA New Orleans Audi:

"This is a formal request for an off-site display of vehicles from May 26-28, 2011 for New Orleans Audi.

The request is related to our sponsorship of the New Orleans Wine and Food Experience. This event consists of 2 separate activities, the "Royal Street Stroll" to be held on Royal Street on the evening of May 26th and a wine and food tasting in the Louisiana Superdome May 27-28th. We are requesting permission to display 10 new vehicles at both activities. The vehicles would be moved from Royal Street to the Superdome.

We have invested thousands of dollars in this event and would appreciate your approval to make it more productive.

This request is for display purposes only and is not intended for any type of selling or customer contact.

We appreciate your timely attention and consideration. Please contact me at 293-3205 if you have any questions or need any additional information."

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to approve Three Brothers Luxury, L.L.C. DBA New Orleans Audi's request to display ten new vehicles at the New Orleans Wine and Food Experience at Royal Street and the Superdome conditioned upon the Law and the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Commission being strictly adhered to and all representations made in the request correspondence of April 1, 2011, remaining constant. Commissioner LeBlanc seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director announced that the next topic is the ongoing efforts of Commissioners Westbrook, Bent, Hicks and Tarver and Counselor McCranie regarding the propose changes of the recreational trade show rules and presented the Commission Members with the following draft to be submitted to the Louisiana Register:

Chapter 15. Recreational Product Shows

§1501. Authorization for Recreational Product Show

A. The commission may authorize or prohibit recreational product shows at offsite locations.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1503. Definitions

Promoter—any person who alone or with others assumes the financial responsibility of a recreational product show in which recreational products are displayed by licensed dealers, manufacturers or distributors.

Rally—an event held and organized by recreational product clubs of specific product owners or manufacturers of specific products where owners of the specific products are members of the club and are invited to participate in the event.

Recreational Product Show—a controlled event in which a promoter charges or barter for booth space and/or charges spectator entrance in which 3 or more recreational product dealers exhibit vehicles.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1505. Promoter License Fee and Application

A. A promoter shall obtain a license from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:

1. the application for license shall be on forms prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;

2. a license fee of \$100;

3. a promoter's license shall expire on December 31.

B. All applications to the commission for display permits not received within 30 days of that start of the trade show or exposition shall be charged a \$50 late processing fee.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1507. License Application for Recreational Product Show

A. The promoter of a recreational product show shall be required to obtain a license for the show from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:

1. the application shall be on a form prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;

2. a license fee of \$500;

3. the license shall be for the recreational product show subject of the application.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1509. Recreational Product Show Requirements

A. The application must be submitted to the commission no less than 60 days prior to the opening date of the recreational product show.

B. Only licensed recreational product dealers whose area of responsibility includes the show site may display and conduct sales of recreational products at recreational product shows.

C. All licensed recreational product dealers within 30 miles of the recreational product show's location must be offered the opportunity to participate in the show.

D. Each respective manufacturer shall grant authority to the dealers participating in the recreational product show.

E. Not less than 30 days prior to the opening day of the recreational product show the commission must receive a list of all participating recreational product dealers together with the consent of each respective manufacturer.

F. Participation by a recreational product dealer shall include display of vehicles and presence of dealer personnel.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1511. Invitations and Priority

The promoter shall contact and invite potential participants to a recreational products show as follows:

1. The promoter shall first contact all recreational product dealers who sell the type of vehicle to be displayed at the recreational product show whose location is within a 30 mile radius of the show. Only dealers whose area of responsibility includes the show site may display the particular make of recreational products sold by them.

2. The promoter may invite, but shall accept any request from a recreational product dealer, not excluded by 1, above, whose business is conducted beyond the 30 mile radius whose area of responsibility includes the show site.

3. If a recreational products trade show is being held in a location where a recreational product does not have a dealer whose area of responsibility includes the show's location it shall be the manufacturer's responsibility to determine which licensee will represent that manufacturer at the show. If the manufacturer has not assigned a dealer to represent their product at a show, then the dealer that is the closest proximity to the show location shall determine which dealer has the first right of refusal to participate in a show based upon the shortest land based route.

4. The promoter shall maintain all records of invited, participating and declining dealers and shall furnish these records to the commission 10 days prior to the opening of the recreational products show.

5. A recreational vehicle manufacturer or distributor may exhibit its recreational products at a show only through a recreational products dealer.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1513. Off-Site Expositions of Recreational Products

A. The executive director must approve all off-site expositions by licensed recreational products dealers. A request for an off-site exposition, accompanied by a fee of \$200, must be received and approved by the executive director 10 days prior to the commencement of the exposition. Any application received after that date shall be charged a \$50 late fee.

B. The location of any off-site exposition must be within the dealer's area of responsibility.

C. An off-site exposition of recreational products is limited to a single dealer and shall not exceed 9 days.

D. A recreational products dealer may have only 4 off-site expositions per calendar year and at the same location only once each 6 months.

E. The number of vehicles at any off-site exposition of recreational products will be left to the discretion of the executive director, with a maximum of 20 vehicles.

F. The presence of any sales personnel, business cards, brochures, pricing sheets and other points of sales devices will be allowed to answer consumer questions. However, recreational products cannot be delivered from the off-site exposition location.

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1515. Licensee Participation in a Rally

A. Closed rally

- 1. A closed rally is conducted and limited to a single product line.
- 2. A closed rally shall be subject to the provisions of §1513 of this Chapter.

B. Open rally

- 1. An open rally is conducted with multiple product lines invited to participate.
- 2. An open rally is subject to all provisions of this Chapter related to recreational product shows.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).
HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to approve the proposed changes to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Rules and to direct Commission staff to submit same to the Louisiana Register to begin the rule-making process. Commission Bent seconded this motion.

At this time the Executive Director presented the commission with a packet of legislative bills which if passed would affect the Louisiana Motor Vehicle law and/or be of interest to the Commission.

State Title: To enact R.S.32:1254(A)(19) and (E)(9)(d), 1261(6)(a), and 1262(B)(1) and (4) and to enact R.S. 32:1262(B)(5) through (7), relative to the sale and distribution of motor vehicles; to exclude nonresident exhibitors from licensure by the Motor Vehicle Commission; to exempt recreational products dealers from certain licensure, franchise modification, and warranty requirements under certain circumstances; to provide for certain prohibited acts involving franchise agreements; to provide guidelines for audits of dealer records; and ot provide for related matters.




