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Also, in attendance were Henric Ekehed, President of Canons Park Equipment Management Inc.; Roy D'Aquila, Esq., Richard Ellis, President, and Charles Barber, Vice President, of Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc.; and Commission staff: Ingya Cattle, Assistant Executive Director; Art Quick, Administrative Supervisor; Administrative Coordinators Jonathon Hurley and Valarie Hill; and Commission Investigators, Bill Horaist, Perry Sponge, Wayne Lee, and Amy Lawson.

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The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence from Henric Ekehed, President of Canons Park Equipment Management Inc. requesting waiver of the million-dollar bond pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a).

"We kindly ask to have our request to waive the surety bond to be put on the commission agenda during the June 14 meeting."

At this time, the Chairman opened the floor for Mr. Ekehed to address the Commission Members regarding Canons Park Equipment Management's sales and financial situation. Mr. Ekehed stated Canons Park Equipment was founded in Sweden in 1991 and has been doing business with a factory in China for two and half years wherein the chassis is built in China but the vehicle is assembled in Conroe, Texas. Mr. Ekehed stated Canons currently sells golf carts in Louisiana with five dealers, however, they are applying for a manufacturer's license for low speed vehicles. Mr. Ekehed stated their intentions would be to have their five dealers sell four LSV vehicles per month each. After a brief discussion and review of the financial information submitted, Commissioner Tarver made a motion to grant the waiver of the bond for the license period ending December 31, 2010, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) and any future waiver of the bond requirement to be reconsidered prior to the renewal license being granted.. Commissioner Hocevar seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

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The Executive Director announced the next order of business would be Hearing #2010-027, Magnolia Wrecker Sales, Inc., Hearing #2010-028, Dallas Ft. Worth Truck & Equipment, Hearing #2010-029, Texas Wrecker Sales, Inc. However, Counselor Reggie advised the Commission Members he had met with counsel representing the entities which are the subjects of these hearings and it was agreed that the hearings would be continued without date and pre-hearing conferences would be held this afternoon at 1:00 p.m. to try and resolve the issue without the necessity of formal hearings. A court reporter was in attendance to record the transcript of the hearings and made

a transcript of this portion of the meeting, which will be made a permanent part of the Commission's files.

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The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence from Roy M. D'Aquila, attorney for Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc. requesting waiver of the million-dollar bond pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a).

"Please be advised that I represent Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc. of Seminary, Mississippi. On April 30, 2010, we filed with your office an Application for Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc. To be approved by the Commission as a Converter or Secondary Manufacturer and as a Specialty Vehicle Dealer.

Deep South Fire Trucks, Inc. retrofit fire trucks and sells them to various Parishes and Municipalities in the State of Louisiana. In order to do this, they must be licensed as a Converter and Specialty Vehicle Dealer.

We are hereby requesting waiver of the \$1,000,000.00 Surety Bond required as a Converter or Secondary manufacturer and the \$20,000.00 Surety Bond as required by a Specialty Vehicle Dealer. Accordingly, we are requesting that we be placed on the Agenda of the next meeting at the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission in order that the Commission can consider our request for waiver of both of these Bonds.

It is my understanding that the next meeting of the Commission will be June 14, 2010.

If any additional information or documentation is needed in order to place this on the Agenda for the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, please contact me."

At this time, the Chairman opened the floor for Roy D'Aquila, Richard Ellis and Charles Barber to address the Commission Members regarding Deep South Fire Trucks' sales and financial situation. The Chairman requested a copy of their balance sheet which was faxed to this office shortly. The Commission advised the Deep South Fire Trucks' delegation the law does not permit the waiving of the \$20,000.00 Surety Bond of a Specialty Vehicle Dealer required in LSA-R.S. 32:1254 L(8). After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to grant the waiver of the bond required for the converter license only for the license period ending December 31, 2010, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) and any future waiver of the bond requirement to be reconsidered prior to the renewal license being granted.. Commissioner Duhon seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

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The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members e-mail correspondence dated June 14, 2010, from Marty Field, Marketing Development Manager-Central Market of Ford Motor Company:

"I was recently notified that Ford Motor Company is a presenting sponsor of the upcoming Essence Music Festival in New Orleans - June 29 through July 5. As part of our sponsorship package, we will be allowed to have vehicles on display during this time. We have elected to bring on 13 vehicles (listed below) which are all owned and managed by Ford Motor Company. There will not be any display unites coming from dealer inventories and we will not have any dealer participation.

I wanted to notify the LMVC that we will have these 13 unites on display at the Essence Music Festival from 6/29 - 7/5. Because the units are Ford Motor Company vehicles, I wanted to notify the LMVC as a courtesy and not seek formal approval. Please advise if different."

Marty Field also forwarded the Executive Director the following e-mail correspondence from Robert Bell, Account Director, UniWorld Group, Inc. to Mr. Fields on June 10, 2010 outlining the displayed vehicles information:

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


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The Executive Director reported on routine matters being handled by the staff and not requiring action by the Commission at this time.
