Chairman Brandt welcomed Mr. Robert "Bob" Israel, President of Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association, to the meeting. Mr. Israel addressed the Commission Members regarding the 2010 legislative session. Mr. Israel stated LADA was diligently working on a "model buyers order" to comply with the mandates of:

- Act 1046 which requires that a certain notice be given to a prospective buyer prior to the purchase of a motor vehicle.
- · Act 936 which requires motor vehicle dealers to disclose, in writing, the nature of certain fees charged upon the sale of a vehicle.

Mr. Israel stated once the "model buyers order" was completed, a sample would be provided to the Commission.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence from Kristina Pence-Dunow, President of Double K, Inc., dated July 30, 2010, requesting waiver of the million-dollar bond pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a):

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hargroder made a motion to grant the waiver of the bond, pursuant to LSA-R.S. 32:1254D(6)(a) for Double K, Inc. Commissioner Tarver seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

At this time, the Executive Director addressed the Commission regarding the termination of GMC medium duty truck line by General Motors Corporation on October 31, 2010, and the need for consumers to continue to receive warranty work on these big trucks. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members General Motors had come up with a medium duty service center concept wherein they would enter into an agreement with the former (as of October 31, 2010) medium duty truck dealers who would continue in business with other medium duty lines, such as Volvo White, etc., allowing these dealer to continue to provide warranty service for the next five years. The Executive Director explained the medium duty service requirements are unique given the size of the vehicles, the service bays and lifts they require, as well as, the specialized tools needed to keep these vehicles on the road. The Executive Director stated the statute, LSA-R.S. 32:1261(1) (t) only allows for a satellite warranty and repair center if a dealer has a full sales and service agreement and there will be no such agreement effective November 1, 2010. Counselor McCrainie suggested adopting the following as an emergency rule for GMC medium truck warranty service issue.

"B. At the termination the license issued by the commission may remain in effect or be renewed at the discretion of the commission as a service center to perform warranty repairs on the vehicle under the following circumstances:

- 1. The dealer shall remain a dealer licensed by the commission.
- 2. The manufacturer, distributor or factory branch must enter into an agreement authorizing the dealer to perform warranty repairs on the terminated vehicle which agreement will comply with all provisions of R.S. 32:1251 et seq. and the rules and regulations adopted pursuant to this Chapter with regard to warranty work. The agreement must be approved upon execution and annually upon renewal of the dealer's license by the commission.

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hargroder made a motion to take the necessary steps to promulgate the emergency rule pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act. Commissioner Guidry seconded this motion.

The Executive Director reported to the Commission Member a meeting concerning the selling of FEMA trailers at auctions was held at the Chairman's recommendation, on August 11, 2010, in the Commission offices. In attending were Commissioner Westbrook, Commissioner Bent, Commissioner Hicks, the Executive Director, Commission Counselor Reggie, Ingya Cattle, Assistant Executive Director, and representing the Used Motor Vehicle Commission were: Used Commissioner Poteet, Executive Director Derek Parnell, and its Counselor, Robert Hallack. The Executive Director advised the Commission Members some of the issues discussed were the selling of the FEMA trailers without the disclosure to the consumers about propane, black water, formaldehyde, etc.; temporary selling locations; established place of business; and the possible need to adopt a joint emergency rule to address the issues. Counselor Reggie stated the Used Motor Vehicle Commission delegation would discuss the matter with the Used Motor Vehicle Commission at their next regularly scheduled meeting and report back to the LMVC. After a lengthy discussion, Commissioner Bent made a motion to draft an emergency rule to require dealers who sell trailers to obtain propane licenses. Commissioner Westbrook seconded this motion. In addition, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to authorized the Executive Director and Counselor Reggie to discuss this issue with the appropriate Louisiana officials. Commissioner Hargroder seconded this motion. The Executive Director thanked the three Commissioners for participating in the meeting with the Used Motor Vehicle Commission.

Chapter 15. Recreational Product Shows

- §1501. Authorization for Recreational Product Show
 - A. The commission may authorize or prohibit recreational product shows at offsite locations.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1503. Application for Show Permit

- A. The promoter of a recreational product show shall be required to obtain a license for the show from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:
- the application shall be on a form prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;
 - 2 a license fee of \$500;
 - the license shall be for the recreational product show subject of the application.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1505. Show Requirements

- A. The application must be submitted to the commission no less than 60 days prior to the opening date of the event.
- B. Only licensed recreational product dealers may conduct sales of recreational products at such sales and shows.
- C. All licensed recreational product dealers within the show's geographical area must be offered the opportunity to participate in the show.
- E. Each respective manufacturer shall grant authority to the respective dealers participating to conduct the sale or show of recreational products at the proposed offsite location.
- F. Not less than 30 days prior to the opening day of the show the commission must receive a list of all participating licensed recreational product dealers together with the consent of each respective manufacturer.
- G. Participation by a licensed recreational product dealer shall include display of vehicles and presence of dealer personnel

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1506. Definitions

Display Permit—a license issued to a nonresident exhibitor to display recreational products at a show. The permit issued shall be for the duration of the show only and shall not exceed 14 days.

Nonresident Exhibitor—a nonresident recreational product dealer, manufacturer or distributor who holds a current license in another state and whose Louisiana business is limited to participation in recreational product shows in this state.

Promoter—any person who alone or with others assumes the financial responsibility of a recreational products show in which recreational products are displayed by licensed dealers, manufacturers or distributors, or non resident exhibitors.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1507. License Fees and Applications

A. Promoters shall obtain a license from the commission and its request for a license shall consist of the following:

- the application for license shall be on forms prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;
 - 2. a license fee of \$500;
 - 3. a promoter's license shall expire on December 31.
 - P. Norresident exhibitors shall obtain a display permit from the commission and its request for a display

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1509. Invitations and Priority

The promoter shall contact and invite potential participants to a recreational products show as follows:

- 1. The promoter shall first contact all recreational product dealers who sell the type of vehicle to be displayed at the recreational product show whose location is within a 30 mile radius of the show. Dealers who accept the invitation to attend the show shall exclude all other dealers from displaying or showing the particular line of recreational products sold by them and displayed at the recreational products show.
- 2. The promoter may invite, but shall accept any request from a recreational product dealer, not excluded by 1, above, whose business is conducted beyond the thirty mile radius.
- 3. The promoter may then invite any nonresident exhibitor to attend the recreational products show to display and show any recreational product not displayed or shown by a recreational product dealer. The nonresident exhibitor shall not be allowed to offer for sale any recreational product.
- 4. The promoter shall maintain all records of invited, participating and declining dealers and shall furnish these records to the commission 10 days prior to the opening of the recreational products show.
- 5. A recreational vehicle manufacturer or distributor may exhibit its recreational products at a show only through a recreational products dealer.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

§1511. Off-Site Displays of Recreational Products

- A. The executive director must approve all off-site displays of all recreational products. A request for an off-site display must be received and approved by the executive director 10 days prior to the commencement of the display.
 - B. The location of any off-site display must be within the dealer's area of responsibility.
 - C. An off-site display of recreational products is limited to a single dealer and shall not exceed 9 days.
- D. A recreational products dealer may have only 4 off-site displays per calendar year and at the same location only once each 6 months.
- E. The number of vehicles at any off-site display of recreational products will be left to the discretion of the executive director, with a maximum of 20 vehicles.
- F. The presence of any sales personnel, business cards, brochures, pricing sheets and other points of sales devices will be allowed to answer consumer questions. However, recreational products cannot be delivered from the off-site display location.

AUTHORITY NOTE: Promulgated in accordance with R.S. 32:1253(E).

HISTORICAL NOTE: Promulgated by the Office of the Governor, Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, LR 36:

A lengthy discussion ensued. Mr. Bart Caple of BAC Productions and Mr. Bob DelGiorno of the Louisiana Sportsmen's Show expressed their positions regarding the rule changes and issues regarding Promoter licensing. In response to a question, Counselor McCranie outlined the rule making process as set forth in the Administrative Procedures Act, paying specific attention to the facts:

- The proposed rule has to be submitted as a Notice of Intent to the Louisiana Registers for publication.
- Once published there is a time frame for public comment and/or public hearings.
- The Commission then has to summarize the testimony at the public hearing if one is held or summarize the
 comments received and prepare a response to the comments, along with a statement of tentative/proposed
 action on oral/written comments received
- The Commission then must submitted to the Louisiana Register for publication the revised proposed Rule or a statement that no changes have been made to the rule as submitted in the Notice of Intent, along with a concise statement or reasons for/against adoption/amendment of changes suggested.
- If after the public comment and/or public hearing, the Commission decides to make substantive changes to the proposed rule it must then hold a hearing on the substantive changes and that hearing date must be advertised in the Louisiana Register.

Counselor McCranie stated the rule making process takes at the minimum 120 days and the first step in the process
