With regard to old business, Chairman Brandt announced the first topic would be consideration of the Buyer's Order that had been deferred at the October 18, 2010 meeting until Commission Counsel and the Commission could study the form and the provisions of law. Chairman Brandt welcomed Mr. Robert "Bob" Israel, President of Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association, to the meeting. Mr. Israel in response to a question posed at the October 18, 2010 meeting advised the Commission Members the buyer's order would not be copy-righted and could be utilized by any dealer. After a brief discussion and legal advise, Commissioner Fabre made a motion to render the following advisory opinion. Commissioner Timmons seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

"At the October 18, 2010 meeting of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission ("Commission"), Mr. Robert Israel for the Louisiana Automobile Dealers Association presented a form Buyer's Order¹ ("Buyer's Order") to the Commission seeking an advisory opinion as to whether the Buyer's Order is in compliance with Acts 2010, No. 936 and Acts 2010, No. 1046 of the Louisiana legislature. This advisory opinion is limited to the regulatory authority of Commission as concerns Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G)) and Acts 2010, No. 1046 (La. R.S. 32:1264.1). No opinion is rendered as to any matter outside of the scope of the Commission's regulatory authority. Additional limitations to this advisory opinion appear in the following discussion of Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G)) and Acts 2010, No. 1046 (La. R.S. 32:1264.1).

Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G))

The following language is printed in the section of the Buyer's Order identified as "Itemization of Sale":

Documentation and Compliance Fee. This fee is authorized by 6:969.18(A)(2). It is not a mandatory state fee. The seller, who may also be an extender of credit, may charge the fee for credit investigation, compliance with federal and state law, preparation of documents necessary to perfect or satisfy a lien upon the objects sold, and any other functions incidental to the titling of the retail sale.

This language appearing in the Buyer's Order refers to the "Documentation and Compliance" fee set forth under, and as a sub-part of, the "LICENSE, TITLE AND OTHER FEES" section of the Buyer's Order. Excluding the phrase "Documentation and Compliance Fee," this language appearing in the Buyer's Order is a *verbatim* recitation of the language appearing in Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G)), the printing of this language on the bill of sale, buyer's order or sales contract being mandated by Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G)). Further, this language appears in the Buyer's Order in a conspicuous type as required by Acts 2010, No. 936 (La. R.S. 6:969.18(G)) as the language appears in bold and is of larger font than the other characters appearing in the "Itemization of Sale" section of the Buyer's Order.

As such, with the appearance of the above recited language in the Buyer's Order in a conspicuous type, and with the appearance of the amount collected for this service(s) being set forth prior the execution of the Buyer's Order, and with the Buyer's Order being signed by the buyer and retained by the buyer and seller, it is the opinion of the Commission that the Buyer's Order as written, when executed in the manner required by law, is in compliance with Acts 2010, No. 936, enacted as La. R.S. 6:969.18(G).²


Acts 2010, No. 1046 (La. R.S. 32:1264.1)

Under the section of the Buyer's Order identified as "Warranty Information," there appears the following language in bold print and contained within a printed box, having signature lines for the buyer(s) and seller appearing immediately underneath this box:

A new motor vehicle may have been subject to a National Highway Traffic Safety Administration required recall which would be repaired in accordance with manufacturer standards approved by the National Highway Safety Administration. If such a repair is a concern before you purchase, please ask for a copy of the recall notice, if applicable, to the vehicle being sold.

This language is a *verbatim* recitation of the language appearing in Acts 2010, No. 1046 (La. R.S. 32:1264.1), the printing of this language on a buyer's order being mandated by Acts 2010, No. 1046 (La. R.S. 32:1264.1). With the appearance of the above recited language in bold print, contained within a box on the Buyer's Order, and having the signatures for the buyer(s) and seller appearing immediately underneath this box, it is the opinion of the Commission that the Buyer's Order as written, when executed in the manner required by law, is in compliance with Acts 2010, No. 1046, enacted as La. R.S. La. R.S. 32:1264.1."

And after hearing the testimony adduced, the receipt of documentary evidence into the record, and for reasons orally assigned, the Commissioners of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission make the following finding of facts and conclusion of law:

Finding of Facts:

Commercial Marine Sales and Service sold marine motors in the state of Louisiana in the year 2010

and did not possess a license from the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission.

Conclusion of Law:

Commercial Marine Sales and Service acted in violation La. R. S. 9:1254(A)(18).

Considering the forgoing and pursuant to the authority vested in the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission as set forth in Louisiana Revised Statutes, Title 9, Sections 1251, et .seq.,

IT IS ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Commercial Marine Sales and Service, 5405 Paris Road, Suite A, Chalmette, Louisiana 70043-8327 be and is hereby assessed a fine in the amount of SIX THOUSAND (\$6,000.00) AND NO/100 DOLLARS payable to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission. FIVE THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED (\$5,400.00) AND NO/100 DOLLARS of this fine is suspended, with such suspension conditioned upon Commercial Marine Sales and Service, 5405 Paris Road, Suite A, Chalmette, Louisiana 70043-8327 successfully completing the probation set forth hereinafter. In the event of a violation during the probationary period, the suspended portion of the fine shall become immediately due and payable in full.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that Commercial Marine Sales and Service, 5405 Paris

Road, Suite A, Chalmette, Louisiana 70043-8327 is placed on one (1) year probation beginning from the date of the signing of this judgment, during which time Commercial Marine Sales and Service, 5405 Paris Road, Suite A, Chalmette, Louisiana 70043-8327 shall act in conformity with the rules and regulations of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission and the state laws within the purview of the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members correspondence dated December 6, 2010, from Bettina Nixon, Market Representative Administrator of Gulf States of Toyota, Inc.:

2011 Bassmaster Classic Angler Weigh In New Orleans Arena 1501 Girod Street New Orleans, LA 70113 February 18-20


GST is also requesting approval of eight (8) vehicles to tow boats and anglers into the arena at the end of the tournament for weigh in. These vehicles are manufacturer vehicles and not dealer vehicles."

After a brief discussion, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to approve Gulf States Toyota's request for eight vehicles to tow boats and anglers at the 2011 Bassmaster Classic Angler Weigh In conditioned upon the Law and the Rules and Regulations promulgated by this Commission being strictly adhered to and all representations made in the request correspondence of December 6, 2010, remaining constant. Commissioner Duhon seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members e-mail correspondence dated November 23, 2010, from D. Beau Sylvester, In-House Counsel for Member Services, Inc.:

"I have attached a pdf file with slides outlining the proposed Wal-Mart Fishing Road Show that we would like to bring to selected stores throughout Louisiana. Wal-Mart in conjunction with its sponsorship of the FLW Outdoor National Fishing Series plans to have these shows on up to 2600 lots across the nation during March and April 2011. The Louisiana lot events would be scheduled from March 17 to March 20. Wal-Mart wants to partner with local boat and/or RV dealers at the stores to display and/or sale inventory from the dealer's lots on these dates. We believe the added traffic to view the merchandise will be extremely successful in aiding Louisiana dealers in a sagging economy. As you can see from the slides the boat displays are only a part of the planned event. Please let me know if you require further information. After reviewing the slide show and speaking with the Commission, please reply and let me know exactly what is and is not allowed so that we can move forward with our plans. I appreciate you taking the time to look into this request for us."



After much discussion and review of the law, as well as, the rules and regulations, the Commissioner Westbrook made a motion there are two scenarios by which a dealer or multiple dealers could participate in your Wal-Mart Fishing Road Show if approved by the Commission.

Sceanario 1: If only one marine dealer is invited, the provisions of Rule 1806 apply:

§1806. Off-Site Displays-Marine Products

- A. The commission must approve all off-site displays of new marine products. A request for an off-site display must be received and approved by the commission seven days prior to the commencement of the display.
- B. The location of any off-site display must be within the dealer's defined area of responsibility or within his manufacturer's contracted agreement for the make and mode to be displayed.
- C. The licensee participating in an off-site display of his product is not required to contract all dealers within a 50 mile radius.
- D. Each off-site display of marine products is limited to:
 - 1. one marine dealer;
- 2. nine days and four displays a year. An off-site display of marine products will be permitted at the same location every six months.
- E. The number of vehicles at any off-site display of marine products will be left to the discretion of the commission, with a maximum of 20 vehicles per licensee, per display.
- F. The presence of any sales personnel, business cards, brochures, pricing sheets and other points of sales devices will be allowed to answer consumer questions. However, marine products cannot be delivered from that off-site display location.
- G. Any licensee participating in an off-site display without the approval of the commission will be in violation of R.S. 32:814(A)(7)(d) and will result in a minimum penalty of \$500 per vehicle, per display for the first offense.
- H. A licensee must furnish a liability insurance binder to the owner of the off-site property. The same liability binder with the off-site property and owner listed must be furnished to the commission with the Off-Site Display Form.
- I. This policy is separate from the rules and regulations pertaining to trade shows.

Scenario 2: However, if it is the intent of Wal-Mart to invite more than one marine dealer and/or to invite both marine and RV dealers to participate in the event, than the provisions of the following would apply:

Chapter 18. Recreational Products Trade Show; Definitions, License Fees and Applications; Violations and Regulation

§1801. Definitions

NOTE: This Section has been moved from LAC 46:V.3001.

Display Permit—a temporary license issued to a nonresident exhibitor, to display recreational products at a trade show or exposition. The permit issued shall be for the duration of the trade show only and shall not exceed 14 days.

Local Trade Show—a trade show in which the promoter's initial invitation is limited to Louisiana-licensed dealers within a 30-mile radius around the show location.

Nonresident Exhibitor—a nonresident dealer or manufacturer of recreational products who holds a current dealer or manufacturer license in another state and whose Louisiana business is limited to participation in trade shows or expositions in this state.

Promoter—any person, firm, association, corporation, partnership, limited liability company or trust, who alone or with others assumes the financial responsibility of a recreational products trade show or exposition in which recreational products are displayed by licensed dealers, manufacturers or distributors, or exhibitors as provided herein.

Recreational Products—any new or used recreational vehicle, motorcycle, ATV, or marine product.

Regional Trade Show—a trade show in which the promoter's initial invitation is only limited to Louisiana licensed dealers and whose subsequent invitations may include any nonresident exhibitor who will display and show any product not displayed or shown by a Louisiana-licensed dealer.

Trade Show—a controlled event in which a promoter charges or barters for booth space and/or charges for spectator entrance in which three or more recreational products dealers exhibit vehicles.

Trade Show Permit—a temporary license issued to a promoter to perform a recreational products trade show.

§1802. License Fees and Applications

NOTE: This Section has been moved from LAC 46:V.3002.

- A. Promoters of recreational products trade shows shall be required to obtain a license from the commission and its request for license shall consist of the following:
- 1. the application for license shall be on forms prescribed by the commission and shall require such information as the commission deems necessary to enable it to determine the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant;

- 2. a license fee of \$100;
- 3. a promoter's license shall be for one calendar year and shall expire on December 31.
- B. A promoter shall also be required to obtain a trade show permit from the commission and its request for a permit shall consist of:
- 1. the identity of at least three participants, the start date, ending date, location of the proposed trade show or exposition, and the type of vehicles to be promoted at the trade show;
- 2. an official designation as to whether the trade show is a regional trade show, with proof supporting that the show facilities have adequate space to host the type of show being permitted;
 - 3. a fee of \$500 per regional trade show;
 - 4. a fee of \$200 per local trade show.
- C. A nonresident exhibitor shall be required to provide the following documents to the commission to obtain a display permit to display recreational products in a trade show:
- an oath or affirmation that the nonresident exhibitor has complied with all registration requirements of the state in which he conducts his business including any requirements pertaining to posting of bond and demonstration of fiscal responsibility;
- a notarized copy of the dealer's or manufacturer's current license issued in the state in which he conducts his business;
- 3. the name, site, and dates of the show or exposition for which a nonresident exhibitor's permit is sought and the name and address of the promoter of that show or exposition;
 - 4. such other pertinent information consistent with the safeguarding of the public interest and public welfare;
 - 5. an application fee of \$100.
- D. A Louisiana-licensed recreational products dealer who participates in a recreational products show or exposition shall not be deemed to have an additional place of business at that show or exposition and shall not be charged any permit fees.
- E. All applications to the commission for display permits received within five days of that start of the trade show or exposition shall be charged a \$50 late processing fee.

§1803. Order of Preference and Priority

NOTE: This Section has been moved from LAC 46:V.3003.

- A. The following order of preference shall be observed by the promoter in arranging a regional trade show.
- 1. The promoter shall first contact all Louisiana licensed dealers who sell the type of vehicles being promoted, and those Louisiana-licensed dealers who accepted the invitation to attend the show shall exclude all nonresident exhibitors from displaying or showing the particular line of recreational products that they are displaying at the show or exposition. The acceptance of an invitation by a Louisiana-licensed dealer shall be expressed as a signed contract for space and accompanied by any deposits required by the show promoter and shall be performed within a reasonable time following the invitation as required by the promoter.
- 2. The promoter may then invite any nonresident exhibitor to attend the show or exposition to display and show any product not displayed or shown by a Louisiana licensed dealer.
- B. The following order of preference shall be observed by the promoter in arranging a local trade show.
- 1. The promoter shall first contact all Louisiana licensed dealers who sell the type of vehicles being promoted, starting within a 30-mile radius of the proposed show or exposition, and those Louisiana-licensed dealers within a 30-mile radius to the show who accepted the invitation to attend the show shall exclude all other dealers from outside of 30 miles from displaying or showing the particular line of recreational products that they are displaying at the show or exposition.
- 2. The promoter may invite but shall accept any requests from a Louisiana-licensed dealer, who is not excluded by the provision above and is beyond 30 miles to attend a show or exposition, and those Louisiana-licensed dealers who attend the show shall exclude all nonresident exhibitors from displaying or showing the particular line of recreational products that they are displaying at the show or exposition.
- 3. The promoter may then invite any nonresident exhibitor to attend the show or exposition to display and show any product not displayed or shown by a Louisiana licensed dealer.

§1804. Violations

NOTE: This Section has been moved from LAC 46:V.3004.

A. It shall be unlawful and shall constitute a violation of this Chapter:

- 1. for a recreational products dealer or a non resident exhibitor to display or show recreational products at any trade show except as allowed in §1803 above;
- 2. for a nonresident exhibitor to display or show recreational products at a trade show without first obtaining a display permit;
 - 3. for a promoter:
- a. to knowingly allow any dealer or nonresident exhibitor to display recreational products in any manner other than what is allowed in §1803 above;
 - b. to knowingly allow any dealer or nonresident exhibitor of recreational vehicles to display or show

any line of recreational vehicles offered by any licensed recreational vehicle dealer whose franchise area includes the location of the trade show, unless the recreational vehicle dealer whose franchise territory includes the location of the trade show consents to the display;

- c. to knowingly allow a nonresident exhibitor to display or show recreational products without having a display permit;
- d. to fail to keep all records of attending dealers and sufficient and reasonable proof of the required invitations to dealers and proof that dealers who have declined to attend a trade show or exposition for a period of three years;
- e. to allow a manufacturer or distributor, other than a nonresident exhibitor, to exhibit vehicles in any manner other than through a licensed dealer;
- f. to fail to provide to the commission 10 days prior to the trade show a complete list of all dealers participating in the trade show;
- 4. for a licensed recreational products dealer or nonresident exhibitor to complete a sales transaction (by accepting the purchase funds, completing the paperwork and/or delivering product) for any recreational products at a trade show. Said restriction shall not apply or extend to sales and price negotiation, accepting deposits, setting closing dates, or completing a buyer's order;
- 5. for a licensed recreational vehicle dealer to knowingly display at a trade show the same line of recreational vehicles as displayed by a licensed recreational vehicle dealer whose franchise territory includes the location of the trade show, unless the recreational vehicle dealer whose franchise territory includes the location of the trade show consents to the display;
- 6. for a licensed recreational vehicle manufacturer or distributor to exhibit recreational vehicles at a trade show in any manner other than through a licensed dealer.

§1805. Miscellaneous Provisions; Enforcement

NOTE: This Section has been moved from LAC 46:V.3005.

- A. If a recreational vehicle trade show is being held in a location where the same line makes or models of recreational vehicles does not have a dealer with a franchise territory, it shall be the manufacturer's responsibility to determine which licensed dealer(s) will represent that same line makes or models at the trade show.
- B. The commission shall have authority to issue any orders necessary to enforce the provisions of this Section, including the entry of a cease and desist order which may be enforced in any proper venue including the parish of East Baton Rouge.
- C. In addition to the enforcement of any necessary orders, the commission may suspend or revoke any license and/or it may impose a penalty in accordance with R.S. 32:788. In such cases, the affected licensee will be given all notices, opportunity to be heard and rights to appeal as conferred in R.S. 32:785.

If Wal-Mart chooses scenario 1, please have the participating dealer contact this agency to seek approval.

If Wal-Mart chooses scenario 2, Wal-Mart would have to obtain a Trade Show Promoter permit, as well as, the appropriate show permits.

Commissioner Hargroder seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

At this time, the Committee formed by the Chairman at the August 16, 2010 meeting to review the rules and regulations presented to the Commission Members for their consideration some suggested changes to the rules as they relate to Trade Shows. Commissioner Bent advised the Commission Members several meetings of the committee had been held, as well as, meetings with Louisiana Recreational dealers and these are the suggestions and/or work in progress from those meetings.

"Shows for new units only – not sure where this comes in play? We do not want used vehicles permitted to be shown at a trade show because it would allow a used RV shown by a dealer who does not have the new product and the protected territory for this product line.

Section 1801. Definitions

Remove the definitions for Local Trade Show and also Regional Trade Show.

Section 1802. License Fees and Applications

Remove B.2. and B4

Change B3 to be B2 and remove regional

C. Non Resident Exhibitor:

We would like to require that the Non Resident Exhibitor provide proof that their dealer manufacturer agreement includes parishes in Louisiana as part of their protected territory/ area of responsibility for the products they wish to display at the Trade Show. The out of state dealer location must be within 30 miles of the Louisiana state line.

Is a non resident exhibitor required to have a non resident dealer license in addition to completing the non resident exhibitor application for \$100? We would like this fee to be 2 times the cost of a resident dealer's license.

Section 1803. Order of Preference and Priority

Remove A 1 & 2

B. remove "local"

Section 1804. Violations

A.5. remove the phrase "unless the recreational vehicle dealer whose franchise territory includes the location of the trader show consents to the display."

Add A.7 for a licensed recreational dealer to display used recreational vehicles at the trade show.

Section 1805. Miscellaneous Provisions; Enforcement

2. replace "it shall be the manufacturer's responsibility to determine which licensed dealer(s) will represent that same line makes or models at the trade show."

with

Proximity to the show location shall determine which dealer has the 1st right of refusal on open territory shows. Proximity is determined by using the shortest land based route. In-state dealers will have first right of refusal, then out of state dealers based on proximity to the show location as long as the out of state dealership location is within 30 miles of the Louisiana state line.

Section 1806. Off-site Displays / RV Rally

We would like to adopt this rule for recreational dealers. We would like to make the following changes to the rule:

A. Change marine products to recreational products

D. Change marine products to recreational products

D.1. change "one marine dealer" to one recreational products dealer.

Add >> D.2. The recreational products dealer may not hold an off-site display more than 50 miles from that dealer's licensed location.

Add >> D.3. A Non-resident dealer is not allowed to hold an off-site display nor participate in any rally.

Commissioner Bent added the following had been discussed, however the majority of the committee did not feel these items were the proper direction for the trade show rules.

No financials required on promoters and no zoning requirements.

Open and Closed Rallies

Closed Rally (Clubs or Manufacturer's Show) - is only one product line.

-need Rally license, no financials or zoning requirements.

-not open to the public.

-no advertising allowed to the general public.

-only in-state dealers allowed to show product.

-no dealer's territory shall be considered.

-new units only.

Open Rally - is multiple product lines.

-no minimum or maximum number of dealers required.

-have to be an in-state dealer.

-every dealer with that product line has to be invited.

-no financials or zoning requirements.

-no advertising to the general public.

-members only.

-new units only.

-selling is allowed"

After a brief discussion, the Chairman thanked the Committee for its work on this project and deferred any action until till the Committee had completed its review and submitted it final suggestions..

With regard to old business, i.e., warranty work being performed by non-licensed persons, the Executive Director reminded at the October 18, 2010 Commission meeting Commissioner Duhon had requested two options to amend the same law be forward to each member for their consideration prior to this meeting. The Executive Director stated this was done by e-mail on October 22, 2010. Commissioner Duhon stated the proposals were both from Commissioner Hocevar and would give the rental car companies the right to perform warranty work. (Proposed language in bold red.)

OPTION 1

LSA-R.S. 32:1261 It shall be a violation of this Chapter:

- (1) For a manufacturer, a distributor, a wholesaler, distributor branch, factory branch, converter or officer, agent, or other representative thereof:
- (t) To operate a satellite warranty and repair center, to authorize a person to perform warranty repairs who is not a motor vehicle dealer, or to authorize a motor vehicle dealer to operate a satellite warranty and repair center within the community or territory of a same line or make motor vehicle dealer. This Subparagraph shall not apply to recreational product manufacturers or manufacturer approved fleet warranty centers.

LSA-R.S. 323252 (30) "Satellite warranty and repair center" means a motor vehicle repair facility, other than at a motor vehicle dealer franchised location, approved by a manufacturer or distributor and authorized to perform warranty and other repairs on motor vehicles.

OPTION 2

"LSA-R.S. 32:1252 (30) "Satellite warranty and repair center" means a motor vehicle repair facility, other than at a motor vehicle dealer franchised location, approved by a manufacturer or distributor and authorized to perform warranty and other repairs on motor vehicles. Daily rental fleet warranty stations approved by the vehicle manufacturer will be eligible to perform warranty repairs on vehicles owned by the rental company. All parts associated with warranty repairs must be purchased through authorized franchised dealers.

LSA-R.S. 32:1261 It shall be a violation of this Chapter:

- (1) For a manufacturer, a distributor, a wholesaler, distributor branch, factory branch, converter or officer, agent, or other representative thereof:
- (t) To operate a satellite warranty and repair center, to authorize a person to perform warranty repairs who is not a motor vehicle dealer, or to authorize a motor vehicle dealer to operate a satellite warranty and repair center within the community or territory of a same line or make motor vehicle dealer. This Subparagraph shall not apply to recreational product manufacturers or manufacturer approved fleet warranty centers.

Commissioner Hocevar suggested allowing rental companies to become licensed as a satellite warranty and repair center for their own fleet of vehicles, not the consuming public, especially at locations such as the airports. Commissioner Hocevar suggested the parts for the warranty repairs would still be shipped to and sold by a local franchised licensed dealer. Commissioner Hocevar stated the amount of vehicles being rented at the airport on a daily basis (2,000 at the New Orleans airport this past Monday), being able to perform their own warranty work would enable the rental companies to get their cars back on the road much faster. After a lengthy discussion regarding all types of fleets and warranty work, Commissioner Hargroder made a motion to forward a cease and desist to all manufacturers from paying anyone other than a franchised licensed new motor vehicle dealer for warranty work. Commissioner Timmons seconded the motion. Commissioner Hocevar voted nay. Commissioner Hargroder withdrew the motion. Further discussion ensued. Commissioner Corley made a motion to have the Executive Director send a letter to all the manufacturers inviting them to come in and discuss this matter with Counselor Reggie and the Executive Director and for Legal Counsel and the Executive Director to report back to the Commissioner Hargroder seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director presented to the Commission Members the Comprehensive Projected Budget for 2011-2012. After a brief discussion regarding the budget, Commissioner Hocevar made a motion to adopt the following resolution:

"To adopt the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission Comprehensive Projected Budget for 2011 - 2012, for submission to the Office of the Legislative Auditor.

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission has reviewed the Comprehensive Projected Budget for 2011 - 2012 and find same to be a complete financial plan for the ensuing year.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission, that the Comprehensive Projected for 2011 - 2012 be adopted.."

Commissioner Hargroder seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.

The Executive Director reported a situation had arisen with the transition of the recreational industry from the Louisiana Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission to the Louisiana Motor Vehicle Commission wherein manufacturers or distributors can no longer operate as both the manufacturer or distributor and a recreational products dealer as they could in the past. After a brief discussion and legal advise, Commissioner Hocevar made

a motion to allow manufacturer or distributors of recreational products to be licensed as a recreational products dealer under the provisions of LSA-R.S. 32:1261(k) until August 15, 2012, allowing the manufacturer or distributor time to find a dealer in Louisiana.

LSA-R.S. 32:1261(k)(i) To sell or offer to sell a new or unused motor vehicle **or recreational product** directly to a consumer except as provided in this Chapter, or to compete with a **licensee** in the **same-line** makes, models, or classifications operating under an agreement or franchise from the aforementioned manufacturer. A manufacturer shall not, however, be deemed to be competing when any one of the following conditions are met:

(aa) Operating a dealership temporarily for a reasonable period, not to exceed two years.

- (bb) Operating a bona fide retail dealership which is for sale to any qualified independent person at a fair and reasonable price, not to exceed two years.
- (cc) Operating in a bona fide relationship in which a person independent of a manufacturer has made a significant investment subject to loss in the dealership, and can reasonably expect to acquire full ownership of such dealership on reasonable terms and conditions.
- (ii) After any of the conditions have been met under Subitems (aa) and (bb) of Item (i) of this Subparagraph, the commission shall allow the manufacturer to compete with licensees of the same-line makes, models, or classifications under an agreement or franchise from said manufacturer for longer than two years when, in the discretion of the commission, the best interest of the manufacturer, consuming public, and licensees are best served.

Commissioner Bent seconded this motion and it was unanimously approved.
