Considering past rulings of the Commission regarding the usage of certain words and terms in potential licensees and licensees names which would or could be violations of the advertising rules and the Law, the Executive Director asked the Commission Members for direction regarding a potential licensee use of the term "Monthly Auto Clearance" in their name.
