APPLICATIONS REVIEWED

<u>Case No. 18-01-01</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$1,000 of her account balance of \$1,597.30 for loss of wages.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$1,000 based on documentation submitted for loss of wages.

<u>Case No. 18-01-02</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$6,553 of her account balance of \$46,009.81 for mortgage payments that are delinquent.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$6,553 based on documentation submitted for mortgage payments.

<u>Case No. 18-01-03</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$900 of her account balance of \$3,415.50 for relocation expenses.

The Hardship Committee did not approve a withdrawal at this time. The committee has requested additional documentation before a decision can be made.

<u>Case No. 18-01-04</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$7,000 of his account balance of \$30,780.41 for loss of wages.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$4,278.57 based on documentation submitted.

<u>Case No. 18-01-05</u>: Participant is requesting a full distribution of his account balance of \$3,787.10 for medical expenses.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$21.03 based on documentation submitted. Due to an administrative error, this case was reconsidered and a full withdrawal of funds was approved by the Hardship Committee.

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<u>Case No. 18-01-06</u>: Participant is requesting a full distribution of her account balance of \$11,325.63 to prevent eviction.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$4,010 based on documentation submitted.

<u>Case No. 18-01-07</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$1,000 of her account balance of \$1,154.56 for home repairs.

The Hardship Committee did not approve a withdrawal at this time. The committee has requested additional documentation before a decision can be made.

<u>Case No. 17-12-156</u>: <u>APPEAL</u>: Participant has submitted an appeal regarding his hardship application in December. Participant has submitted additional documentation that was requested. Participant is requesting a full distribution of his account balance of \$1,404 for mortgage payments that are in default.

The Hardship Committee approved a full withdrawal based on documentation submitted.

<u>Case No. 18-01-08</u>: Participant is requesting a full distribution of her account balance of \$3,173.18 for mortgage payments that are delinquent.

The Hardship Committee approved a full withdrawal based on documentation submitted.

<u>Case No. 18-01-09</u>: Participant is requesting a partial distribution in the amount of \$14,000 of her account balance of \$41,021 for damages her daughter received from Hurricane Harvey flooding on August 23, 2017.

The Hardship Committee approved a partial distribution in the amount of \$14,000 based on the provisions of the TX-2017-09, Tax Relief for Victims of Hurricane Harvey in Texas, Announcement 2017-11, Relief for Victims of Hurricane Harvey. Participant met the guidelines of her daughter living in an affected county.
