I. Call to order/Roll Call: Meeting was called to order by President Dawn Hebert at 6:04pm. After roll call by Admin Secretary Claire White, we had a quorum.

II. Introduction of Special Guest(s): none

III. Review & approval of agenda: Comm. Washington made a motion to accept the agenda; Comm. Sanders seconded the motion. After the vote, the motion passed without any objections.

IV. Review & approval of minutes from April 8: Comm. Celestand made a motion to accept the minutes; Comm. McWilliams seconded the motion. After the vote, the motion passed without any objections.

V. Review & approval of Treasurer's Report: Comm. Sanders reported the finances for the month of April for both ENONAC and East New Orleans Foundation (ENOF). Comm. Weaver made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report; Comm. McWilliams seconded the motion. After the vote, the motion passed without any objections.

VI. PRESENTATIONS:

A. Summer Camp at YEP – Jerome Jupiter, COO at YEP and Amanda Lindsay, Director of Programs explained what YEP (Youth Empowerment Program) is and how it works. It is free education programs for youth and young at heart. Attached flyer lists all programs. All programs are FREE. No transportation is provided except for field trips however bus tickets are available.

B. Hurricane Prep – NOLA Ready: Ms. Anna made a presentation on how to be hurricane prepared. Prizes were given out for correct answers.

Pres. explained that many items on the agenda were self-explanatory but this item needs to be discussed and voted on.

Lincoln Beach Milestone Meeting. It was attended by many CAB members. Pres. said that there is supposed to be a presentation of a Master Plan for Lincoln Beach made at a CPC meeting coming up, but it is not on the agenda yet, so that if comments are to be made there is no reference. But some things are moving forward, CMAR (Construction Mgmt. at Risk) without following procedures and the law; i.e., community input, etc. ENONAC's Housing Land Use and Zoning (HLUZ) committee met and discussed this then drew up a Resolution that addresses that the CMAR Request for Qualification (RFQ) be paused until several action be taken (listed in the Resolution). After the entire Resolution was read by CAB members, a roll call vote was taken and all Commissioners present voted in favor of the Resolution except 2 Commissioners.

Pres. again stated that since we have limited time in this room, other items on the agenda are self-explanatory and will be discussed at the next meeting.
