- Working with IPG on the \$60,000 CEA with us; went before the council again last night for approval and we should be receiving the CEA for review shortly.

Mr. Tarantino continued onto his economic development update.

- ARA moving forward with plans for new firehouse; old firehouse will be used for office space expansion
- Mr. Pontiff remarked on the Loren Scott event that he attended yesterday in which the ARA and the POI each had a couple of slides; both received exceptional assessment
- Review of the L&G event in Lake Charles recently attended
- O&G continues to go up and down; hovering around \$50/barrel
- Sales tax collections are up the last couple of months
