REPORT OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

PN PROGRAMS STATUS Christina Costanza presented a summary status of all practical nursing programs, reporting on current cohorts, enrollment numbers, graduating classes, and the number of students that have successfully completed the program from each campus. As of March 7, 2022, there are currently 50 schools with 105 ongoing classes and 1859 enrolled students.

PROGRAMS ON INITIAL ACCREDITATION

Programs on initial accreditation include the following:

- 1. Advance Nurse Training, LLC New Orleans, LA STATUS: Advanced Nurse Training remains on initial accreditation. The first graduating class is expected in March of 2022.
- 2. Blue Cliff College Metairie, LA STATUS: The program remains on initial accreditation. The first graduating class is expected in January of 2022.
- Bossier Parish Community College Bossier City, LA STATUS: The program remains on initial accreditation. The first graduating class is expected in July of 2022.

PROGRAM(S) ON PROVISIONAL ACCREDITATION Programs on provisional accreditation include the following:

- Evangeline Campus, SLCC LCTCS STATUS: Noncompliance – NCLEX scores Dec. 2018 – 38.89% failure rate May 2021 – 23.81% failure rate Correction plan received
- 2. Gule Area Campus, SLCC LCTCS
  STATUS: Noncompliance failure to submit
  requested information among other infractions that
  were discovered. Program will remain on provisional
  accreditation until the next graduating class December
  2021 is completed successfully.

- 3. Lacombe Campus, NTCC LCTCS STATUS: Noncompliance-NCLEX scores May 2021 28.57% failure rate for the program's first graduating class. Program is on provisional accreditation awaiting the scores of the second graduating class in December 2022.
- 4. Natchitoches Campus, CLTCC LCTCS STATUS: Noncompliance-NCLEX scores May 2021 21.74% failure rate May 2019 21.05% failure rate The correction plan was received.
- 5. Walker Camus, NTCC LCTCS
  STATUS: Noncompliance NCLEX scores
  May 2021 NCLEX failure rate of 27.27% for the
  program's first graduating class. The program is on
  provisional accreditation awaiting the scores of the
  second graduating class.
- Ward H. Nash Campus, CLTCC LCTCS STATUS: Noncompliance-NCLEX scores May 2020 – 33.33% failure rate May 2021 – 33.33% failure rate The correction plan was received.
