

MINUTES OF THE NORTHWEST LOUISIANA
GAME AND FISH PRESERVE COMMISSION

Meeting held on October 6, 2015

Present were Commissioners Brown, Lonadier, Bedgood, Hubbard and Wilson.

Chairman Arthur Brown, Jr. welcomed Wildlife & Fisheries Biologist Jason Brancamp.

On motion by Lonadier and seconded by Wilson the minutes were accepted as written.

Durwood Wilson then gave a report on the boat ramps. He said the hump that was created to control erosion at Sandy Point needed some additional work. He was going to haul SB-2 and spread it so that the hump would not be as noticeable. He also said some gravel might have to be brought in and perhaps some winn rock. He will monitor the boat ramp and make the changes as necessary.

Jason Brancamp of the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries then gave a report on the lake. He said the lake looked very good and spraying of aquatic vegetation was continuing. The Commission advised him of some aquatic growth located in the northern part of the lake. He agreed to check.

There was then a report on the recreation area. It is in good shape as well.

No report from the Black Lake Citizen's Committee.


In new business Shane Hubbard was accepted as a Commissioner on motion by Lonadier and seconded by Bedgood.
