

MINUTES OF THE NORTHWEST LOUISIANA
GAME AND FISH PRESERVE COMMISSION

Meeting held on February 2, 2016

Present were Commissioners Wilson, Self, Lonadier and Hubbard with Lonadier acting as Chairman in the absence of Arthur Brown, Jr.

On motion by Self and seconded by Hubbard the meeting was called to order.

On motion by Self and seconded by Wilson the Commission dispensed with the reading of the minutes.

Acting Chairman Lonadier then recognized Wildlife & Fisheries Biologist Jason Brancamp.

Durwood Wilson gave a report on the boat ramps. He would check the parking lot at Dickson.

He said C.D. Baker boat ramp was in good shape and there was one more coat of paint needed but everything else looked good. On motion by Self and seconded by Hubbard, Commissioner Wilson was authorized to have a cover created for the catch basin.

Commissioner Wilson also advised that Westwind could use a load of rock.

Biologist Jason Brancamp of the Department of Wildlife & Fisheries then gave a report on the lake. He said they sprayed the vegetation occurring at the C.D. Baker boat launch. There was about 100 acres of vegetation and after breaking it up about 60 acres remained which was sprayed. Ernest Self then advised of some thick vegetation in the lake south of the tressel. The Commissioners did report various pockets of vegetation occurring throughout the lake, including Prairie Lake.

The recreation pier appeared to be in good shape.

The Commissioners were advised that the trailer on the North side of the fishing pier had been removed.

The Black Lake Citizen's Committee had no report.

Concerning new business the invoices for reimbursement submitted by Commissioner Wilson were approved on motion by Self and seconded by Hubbard. On motion by Self and seconded by Hubbard the payment to Roger Williams was ratified.

There was then discussion concerning a cooperative endeavor agreement with the Police Jury concerning the spreading of rock. The agreement was tabled for the time being.

On motion by Hubbard and seconded by Self the invoice submitted in the amount of \$310.00 for boat ramp work was approved.

On motion by Hubbard and seconded by Self the meeting did adjourn.
