Consideration of Minutes from January 11, 2012 Meeting

Minutes were approved by consensus with no corrections.

Review of Program Operation

Joe Fontenot, PMP Manger, presented the following statistical information and provided printouts on all information:

Mr. Fontenot explained that PMP staff has implemented a new enhancement for producing "Unsolicited Letters". Further, he provided a chart illustrating the production of these letters using the new method versus the old method. In summary, PMP staff has cut 38 hours of staff time and significantly increased productivity.

Veterinary Reporting

Joe Fontenot, PMP Manager, reminded the Council that Act 144 of the 2010 Legislature amended LA:R.S.40.4.X-A.§1003.(6) mandating that veterinarians report eligible transactions to the program except for those prescriptions of negligible amounts as identified by rule. Mr. Fontenot further advised the Council that the Louisiana Board of Pharmacy's Regulation Review Committee was requesting input from Council before finalizing the regulations regarding negligible amounts. Fenton Lipscomb, DVM (LVMA) presented the Council with the list of drugs and quantities he presented to the Regulation Review Committee that morning to be considered as ineligible amounts. After reviewing the list Council members asked that the Board's Regulation Review Committee study the matter to obtain a solution.

Delegate Accounts

As requested by Ms. Thania Elliot (LSBME) at the previous Advisory Council meeting on January 11, 2011, PMP staff presented the Council with information regarding PMP Delegate Accounts. The packet provided each state PMP allowing delegate account access along with the licensing

procedure, and disciplinary actions for misuse. Council members agreed that many practitioners are currently delegating the task of querying a patient's PMP history and suggested that allowing delegate accounts would enable staff to track who is actually accessing the profile. Malcolm Broussard, Executive Director (LABP), advised that this would be a statutory change that could not be addressed by the Legislature until next year.

Legislative Report for SB 112

Mr. Malcolm Broussard, Executive Director (LABP) provided an update on SB 112 which allows the PMP to share data with out of state prescribers and dispensers. The status of SB 112 is as follows:
