Consideration of Authority to Award Design Contract/1North Adventure Trails/Phase 1D/Multi-Use Trails/Project No. 24-07/Contract No. RRW-842: By motion of Commissioner Clark, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved award of the design contract to KSA Engineers, Inc. for design and administration of the project and authorized the Executive Director to execute the contract and to reserve \$1,900,000.00 in the 2025 budget.

<u>Multi-Use Trails/Project No. 24-07/Contract No. RRW-843:</u> By motion of Commissioner Clark, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved authorizing staff to advertise for construction bids.

Consideration of Construction Bids/Seawall Rehabilitation/Red Oak and Bishop Point/Project No. 24-02/Contract No. RRW-830: By motion of Commissioner Clark, seconded by Commissioner Lattier, the Commission unanimously approved award of construction bid to Synergen Construction in the amount of \$406.819.00

<u>Consideration of Request for Right of Entry/Central Louisiana Regional Port/Hudson Realignment/60</u>
<u>Acres:</u> By motion of Commissioner Deville, seconded by Commissioner Crutchfield, the Commission unanimously approved the Right of Entry Permit for the Central Louisiana Regional Port to enter and perform soil borings on land owned by the Commission.

Consideration of Approval of Land Sale to U.S. Army Corps of Engineers/INorth Adventure Trails Mitigation Property/432.712 Acres: By motion of Commissioner Deville, seconded by Commissioner Clark, the Commission unanimously approved the deed and resolution for the sale of the 432.172 acre INorth Adventure Trails mitigation property to the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for \$2,845,000.00. The Resolution, as follows, was read aloud: Be it resolved, that the District, by and through the Executive Director of the Commission, Colin S. Brown, is hereby authorized to sell on behalf of the District the immovable property described on Exhibit "A-1" attached hereto, for a price and sum of \$2,845,000.00 to the United States of America. Be it further resolved, that Colin S. Brown, Executive Director of the Commission, is hereby authorized and empowered in the name of and on behalf of the District to execute any Act of Sale, affidavits, certifications, settlement statement, receipt, checks, and any other documents necessary to carry out the intentions set forth above, and such other documents containing provisions which he may deem necessary and proper.
