Mr. Roesel explained the purpose of this project is to analyze proposed and forecast industrial developments on the west bank of Jefferson Parish in support of a larger planning effort that includes multi-modal transportation, land use, utility and other infrastructure evaluations, and to identify strategic transportation investments that will complement and enhance planned development in the area.

There being no questions or objections, the Chairman call for a motion to approve the Consultant Selection: Westbank Transportation Road and Rail Sub-area, Analysis Jefferson Parish Stage 0 Feasibility (RPC Task A-3.21JP; FY 21 UPWP) in the amount of \$105,000.00 with Alliance Transportation Group, Inc. (ATG). It was so moved by Parish President Matt Jewel, seconded by Mayor Bob Zabbia and approved unanimously by the Transportation Policy members in attendance, as noted by the Chairman.
