Mr. Jeff Roesel referred the members to a summary list of the consultant bills on page 13 in the meeting packet, noting that staff had reviewed each of them and favorably recommended them for approval.

There being no questions or objections, the Chairman called for a motion to approve the consultant billings. It was so moved by Councilmember Wanda Alcon, seconded by Mr. Jack Stumpf and approved unanimously by the members of the Regional Planning Commission, as noted by the Chairman.

The Chairman asked if there was any other public comment. There was none.

11. Consideration: Other Matters

The Chairman thanked everyone who attended the meeting and announced that St. Tammany Parish will have a member of FEMA from Region 6 presenting a program tomorrow (June 15, 2022) at the St.

Tammany Council Chambers in Mandeville with regard to Flood Insurance and Risk Rating 2.0. Many of their citizens are experiencing higher flood insurance premiums and have called for a seminar to provide information to provide explanation. It's an in-house meeting at Koop Drive in St. Tammany at the Council Chambers at 3:00p.m. and will be on their public information channel 710 and will be livestreamed on the website at stpgov.org and on their Facebook page and have opened the website for questions to be posed in advance and open to all, he also provided a flyer.

Secondly, the Chairman and members of the Parish Presidents delegation and other stakeholders went to Washington, D.C. for a one day fly in to meet with their local congressional delegation as well as members of the Congress in other parts of the country regarding the RISE Act and how it affects the funding that we received from GOMESA and possibly funding in the future. He asked President Robby Miller to expound on their visit last week.

President Robby Miller explained the GOMESA and how coastal parishes in the state of Louisiana receive revenue sharing of offshore oil and gas leases. Local Elected officials were requesting an expansion of GOMESA and to raise the cap and increase the percentage share of revenues from 37.5% to 50%, consistent with inland production revenue splits. He stated that the second part of the RISE Act modification request was to include revenues from Offshore Wind Energy as part of the revenue sharing agreement. Had wind energy leases been included in revenue sharing agreements where there are leases sold for wind energy offshore or which was done recently on the east coast, and if the RISE Act would have been in place, New Jersey and New York would've shared 2.3 billion of dollars of shared revenue.
