#### • LAWLF Interface:

- WLF State Wide Lake Rules & Regulations Per WLF Robby Maxwell Inland Fisheries Technical Advisor sent Notice of Intent draft for review. Draft passive gear bill concerning use of metal to mark stumps was not supported by unknown representative. J. McFarland asked for explanation.
- o Drawdown 2022– Gates opened 5/31/22. Closed 10/3/22 at 7.5 feet below pool.
- o Drawdown 2023– Discussion on no drawdown in 2023.
- Short Term Spraying
  - Salvinia Evaluation / Problem Areas:
    - **PVC** boat access at pipeline boom center needs replacing.
    - Report of lake Salvinia condition North of boom

- Report of lake Salvinia condition South of boom
  - o Salvinia spraying needed:
    - Dam
    - Pipeline
- New Cypress Tree Growth Areas of concern:
  - New cypress growth on flat across from Cedar Bluff.
  - ➤ Oak 1 to Oak 2 in open water
- Buck Brush Growth Areas of concern:
  - ➤ Main Little Lake area
  - ➤ Oak 1 to Oak 2 to be reviewed after drawdown

- Long Range Tree Cutting
  - 2 Bros Resources no movement on project.

## • LADOTD Dam Inspection / Level Gauge- J. Atherton

 Dam Inspection Report 7/13/23 – New inspection report available to Commissioners contained same items from previous reports. DOTA tried to check that the center buoys are connected but couldn't due to Salvinia.

# • Corp of Engineers Vicksburg

- O 2021 drawdown resulted in 2 problematic area of work in the lake bottom. Canal Lane problem is being handled by the Corp of Engineers Enforcement Division inspected August, 2022. Permit will be required. McCartney Camp Road problem inspected by Enforcement Enforcement recommendation to the Corp of Engineers Permit Division is that dirt piled in the lake exceeded the allowable 25CY by 100CY and will have to be removed.
- o Two requests for 2022 permits have not been issued to date by CoE.

## **Duck Blind Permitting Process** – W. Smith

New rules approved for 2023 and being sent out with each permit.

Permitting – Aug 1 – Oct 30.

One deposit made of \$1,300. About 70% of permits out.

Aquatic vegetation management:

Spraying continues and lake appears to be helping as sections of the lake appear to be in pretty good shape
