NONVERBATIM MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES, SHERIFFS' PENSION & RELIEF FUND, HELD AT THE LOUISIANA SHERIFFS' PENSION FUND OFFICE IN BATON ROUGE, LOUISIANA AT 9:15 AM ON THURSDAY, OCTOBER 26, 2023.

The meeting was called to order, and everyone was welcomed by Sheriff Willy Martin, President. Ronnie Morse offered an invocation and Sheriff Victor Jones led the pledge to the American Flag. Roll was called and those in attendance represented a quorum.

Others in attendance for the meeting included Bob Klausner, Attorney, Klausner, Kaufman, Jensen & Levinson; Greg Curran, Actuary, G.S. Curran & Co.; Joey David, Legislative Analyst, House Retirement Committee; Jason Windham, Shobe Financial; several parish representatives and Pension Fund staff members Chris DeWitt and Katie Thiebaud.

The President and Director gave special recognition to long-time Board member, Retired Sheriff Jeff Wiley. Wiley was elected as a State Representative, and therefore would be stepping down from his position as a member of the Board of Trustees. He was presented with a crystal award as a token of appreciation for his 18 years of service to the Sheriffs' Pension Fund. Wiley thanked everyone for the recognition and commended the Board, Director, and Legal Counsel Bob Klausner for their significant progress over the years.

Next, Paul Eitleman, Russell Senior Investment Strategist, North America Division, joined the Board meeting through conference call to give a global economic and market outlook update. These discussions assist the Board in planning investment strategies for the future.

For the next agenda item, Director McGee and Assistant Director Chris DeWitt gave a performance report and asset allocation update and included reasons for optimism and causes for concern going forward. The following estimated returns were reported:

- Fiscal Year End (Net of Fees) 6/30/2023 = 9.6%
- Market Value Assets at 6/30/2023 = \$4,559,907,062.53
- Estimated Benefits Paid for Fiscal Year 2023 = \$244,349,911
- 1st quarter Fiscal Year 2024 (Net of Fees) = (2.2)%
- Fiscal Year to Date (Net of Fees) (October 24th) = (4.6)%

Both the Director and Assistant Director stated that the current plan looking ahead was to:

- 1. Maintain the strong liquidity position of the Fund.
- 2. Continue to monitor the well diversified portfolio and perform any necessary rebalancing. This would be based on changes foreseen in the global markets and how the portfolio should look over the next 6-12 months and other intervals, and
- 3. With an ever-changing investment landscape, the staff and consultant would research and review new asset classes and strategies for possible additions to the portfolio.
  - a. Education has been focused on private markets and certain low vol strategies.
  - b. Enhancing portfolio risk analysis with Russell consultant
- 4. Planning an Investment Committee meeting

Moving on to the next agenda item, Don Rittenberry made a motion to approve Dr. Brian Gremillion as the new medical disability Board physician, as researched and recommended by the Executive Director as well as the Fund's current physician, Dr. D.J. Scimeca, who scaled back his practice to no longer conduct in-person examinations. Sheriff Russell seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.<sup>1</sup>

Next was a Legislative Discussion. First, Joey David, Legislative Analyst for the House Retirement Committee, presented to the Board details about legislative filing and advertising requirements for retirement legislation for the upcoming General Session which will be from March  $11^{\rm th}$  through June  $3^{\rm rd}$  of 2024.

Next, the Board president appointed a Legislative Committee to study change requests for Sheriffs and report back to the Board of Trustees for decisions on potential legislation. The Legislative Committee was appointed as follows:

Next, Actuary Greg Curran gave a report and referenced a letter to the Board dated October 24, 2023, on transfer out calculations. The Director made a decision in consultation with legal counsel to go forward with the actuary's recommendation. The Board concurred with this decision, and Ronnie Morse made a motion to ratify the decision of the Executive Director. Joe Seymour seconded, and the motion passed unanimously.<sup>2</sup>

### Information and Discussion Items:

- The Director briefed the board on the gratitude they have received from retirees for the PBI that was passed by the Board at the last meeting in April. Thank you cards, messages and phone calls have been received by the office.
- Director McGee explained that, as part of the annual audit, the Fund's inhouse audit team will be going out to 3 parishes for census data testing. The Director informed the Board that this year's parishes were St.

- Bernard, Plaquemine, and Winn.
- Finally, Director McGee informed the Board that the Fund would be undergoing landscaping updates after the extreme summer heat damaged much of the existing landscaping.

Legal Counsel Bob Klausner stated that there was no need for an executive session.

Debbie McBeth made a motion to approve the April 18, 2023 Board meeting minutes. Joe Seymour seconded, and the motion passed. $^3$ 

For the final order of business, Ronnie Morse made a motion to approve the applications for reciprocal recognition of service and transfers, as well as applications for retirement, BackDROP, disability, and survivor benefits. Don Rittenberry seconded, and the motion passed. $^4$
