18	But it really I mean, that's kind of irrelevant because he's
19	retesting. MR. LYONS:
20	And you have no problem testing him in the office?
21	MS. BORDELON: No. In fact, I tested actually nine
22	between December and this conference.
23	MR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Chairman, I move.
24	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: Okay. There's a motion that it be
25	approved contingent upon him passing the test. And it's supported by Mr.

2	Any objection? (No response.)
2	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
	So ordered. All right. All of our
4	certifications are now done, correct?
5	MS. BORDELON: Correct.
6	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: All right. Let's go into our
7	committee reports. Mr. Mize is not here, but I would like to ask that Page 7

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8	we ratify those awards that were presented yesterday at lunch. We
9	had some very fine nominees.
10	We had two for the Bentley Mackey award. The gentleman who won
11	and of course, it's all nominated from the Board. It was six to three
	and
12	MR. WILLIAMS: It was close.
13	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: We had two very, very fine nominees.
14	I would suggest in the future and
15	this is just me that the nominee's application be filled out
16	by us and not by the nominee. That was something that I think
	we need to know the person well
17	enough that we can make a nomination. So it was perhaps a
18	little awkward, I think, at one point.
19	MR. WILLIAMS:
20	Would you like that in the form of a motion?
21	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: I don't know that we need it to be
22	formalized that way. I think it ought to just be understood that we
	control the Bentley Mackey award and
23	that it should be coming from us individually.
24	And traditionally we have looked
25	at people who have rotated off this Board And maybe that's bad, too.
	I wouldn't call it a self-promotion,
	10
1	but there are a few of us who have
2	been on the Board and when we went off, we were honored with that.
3	But I think we're looking for the most outstanding environmental
	solid waste professional in the
4	state. And I think we've got quite a few people out there that we can
5	look to. And may we always have very fine nominees.
6	Is there any objection to the
7	way we're doing it? (No response.)
8	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: We had three very fine winners, I
	think. I'll call on Mr. Mollere for
9	the testing. Yes, we had 15 tests, 12 passed and 3 didn't.
10	Our continuing education, Mr. Berthelot?
11	MR. BERTHELOT:
12	Our next conference is in Marksville in July and then Shreveport in
	October.

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13	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: Okay. We'll have a flow report on
14	that very shortly.
15	Mr. Lewis, do you have a nominating report?
16	MR. LEWIS: I do not.
17	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: Okay. All right. We'll go into
18	other business and I'll call on Ms. Yolanda Righteous to give us
	information on the proposed
19	workshops to be held in Marksville and Shreveport, the dates. And I
20	think she has furnished you with a preliminary copy of the workshop
21	agenda. MS. RI GHTEOUS:
22	Yes. CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
23	Wel come. MS. RI GHTEOUS:
24	Thank you. You have a copy of the
25	agenda. The Marksville workshop is scheduled for July 17th and 18th,
	and the Shreveport is scheduled for
	11
1	October 16th and the 17th. CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
2	That's a Monday and Tuesday in
3	Marksville and a Tuesday and Wednesday in Shreveport?
4	MS. RIGHTEOUS: I believe so.
5	MR. WILLIAMS: I believe it is.
6	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: Okay.
7	MS. RIGHTEOUS: Yes, I believe so.
8	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: And we'll be at the casino in
	Marksville and the Hilton in
9	Shreveport? MS. RIGHTEOUS:
10	Yes. CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
11	Okay. MS. RIGHTEOUS:
12	Yes. Day 1 starts at 10:00 and on Day 1 we have six hours. And on Day
13	2 we have four hours. As you can
14	see, Mr. L.J. Bergeron is going to present two topics, asbestos
15	training and blood-borne pathogens. And then we'll follow up the
16	first day with someone from DEQ. Right now we have Estuardo Silva
17	(spelled phonetically) tentatively scheduled to present a groundwater
	monitoring talk, sort of A to Z on Page 9

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18	groundwater monitoring; why is it necessary, the installation of the
19	wells, and the sampling of the wells.
20	And then we'll have Ms. Peggy
21	Sellers that will present on safety training. And our plan is to tailor that safety training specific to
22	that safety training specific to landfill operators so that it is really relevant to the folks that
23	will be attending the conference. And we always include role
24	playing as part of our certification
25	training. It's you know, we may touch on topics, such as disaster relief, emergency response, landfill
	12
1	communication, and public outreach. So that's a two-hour session that
2	involves role playing. On Day 2 we'll start off with
3	air quality compliance at landfills,
4	and that's going to be presented by John Forrier, Terrance Stewart
5	Honorable Terrance Stewart. MR. WILLIAMS:
6	Oh, my Lord. MS. RIGHTEOUS:
7	The honorable. The honorable. He's going to present back-to-back
8	topics, one on the certification process and equipment maintenance
9	and safety. And then we'll have two talks
10	presented by Melissa Strickland, stormwater pollution intervention
11	plans and spill prevention plans. And she'll talk about the
12	development of these plans, as well as the implementation of these plans at landfills.
13	And then we'll follow up with a
14	roundtable discussion, relevant topics. We'll solicit topics from
15	the attendees when they on Day 1 we'll ask for suggestions. But we
16	have some sort of prepared topics that we think are relevant and that
17	will flow well with the roundtable discussion.
18	So as you can see, we have our ten hours pretty much lined out with
19	Day 1 and Day 2. Any questions? CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
20	Any questions on that? We have six
21	hours the first day and then four hours on Day 2.
22	MR. WILLIAMS: And both of those conferences, Bill, are on Tuesday/Wednesday. Page 10

12	better than you, Terrance. CHAIRMAN MOLLERE:
13	You're it. (OFF THE RECORD)
14	CHAIRMAN MOLLERE: Okay. Do I have a motion?

3	like to do, if you want to, again, approve five hours or just pass.

9	I checked very carefully and looked at all of the hours
10	personally again. I found just over nine hours. Strangely enough, nine
11	and a quarter hours. I don't know what the rest of you found. That's
