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1 (The Meeting was called to order and
2 proceeded as follows:)

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 The meeting of the Board of
5 Certification and Training for Solid
6 Waste and Management Operators will
7 come to order. We're in Patterson,
8 Louisiana today, December 11, 2015,
9 10:00 a.m.

10 Ms. Bordelon, could we have the
11 roll call, please?

12 **MS. BORDELON:**

13 Sure. Bubba Wynn.

14 **MR. WYNN:**

15 Here.

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 John Fourrier.

18 **MR. FOURRIER:**

19 Here.

20 **MS. BORDELON:**

21 Troy Barber.

22 **MR. BARBER:**

23 Here.

24 **MS. BORDELON:**

25 Mia Townsel.

1 **MS. TOWNSEL:**

2 Here.

3 **MS. BORDELON:**

4 Connie Henry.

5 **MS. HENRY:**

6 Here.

7 **MS. BORDELON:**

8 Gary Bonvillain.

9 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

10 Here.

11 **MS. BORDELON:**

12 Bo Lagrange. Brad Williams.

13 Lindsey Turtle.

14 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

15 Okay. We do have a forum. The
16 first item on the agenda is the
17 review of the October 27th minutes.
18 We're going to have to pass over
19 that because we still have not
20 received the minutes from the Court
21 Reporter for the October meeting.

22 So we'll just take care of that
23 at the next meeting also.

24 Consideration of Operator
25 Certifications. The first one is

1 Steven Benjamin.

2 **MR. BARBER:**

3 I have a question.

4 **MR. FOURRIER:**

5 There's not much detail on his
6 incinerator experience.

7 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

8 Okay. He says that he oversees
9 that the incinerator is operating
10 properly. I take that to mean that
11 he's kind of the manager or
12 something like of the incinerator.
13 That was my interpretation of it.

14 Suzanne, can you give us any
15 more information on him?

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 I can't.

18 **MR. WYNN:**

19 Is he trying to get a
20 conditional or what?

21 **MS. BORDELON:**

22 No.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 No. He's looking for a regular
25 Level A incinerator. No, he's got

1 incinerator waste handling.

2 **MS. BORDELON:**

3 It's just the way it printed
4 out.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 Yeah, it prints a little quirky.

7 **MS. BORDELON:**

8 Yeah.

9 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

10 Okay. But he's looking for a
11 regular.

12 **MR. WYNN:**

13 It was quirky.

14 **MR. BARBER:**

15 As far as the years, I mean,
16 he's good there.

17 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

18 I mean, we can always request,
19 you know, additional detail on his
20 incinerator experience, if you don't
21 feel comfortable with what you have
22 here.

23 **MR. BARBER:**

24 I will feel more comfortable by
25 having that.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 Okay. Would you like to make a
3 motion to that effect?

4 **MR. BARBER:**

5 I would like to, yes.

6 **MR. FOURRIER:**

7 I second.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Okay. Motion by Mr. Barber.
10 Seconded by Mr. Fourrier that we
11 request additional detail
12 information on Mr. Benjamin's
13 incinerator experience.

14 Is there any objection to the
15 motion? Okay, hearing none, the
16 motion passes.

17 Next up is Michael Harrison.
18 He's applying for a C&D Level A.

19 **MR. BARBER:**

20 I know this was done, but I
21 thought he's supposed to sign the
22 agreement before us?

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 That's cause he is -- I think
25 he's the owner.

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MR. WYNN:

He is.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

He is his own supervisor. But what you might want to do is have him sign also as a supervisor.

MS. BORDELON:

Okay.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

Joe will be kosher on it.

MR. BARBER:

He's already taken the test?

MS. BORDELON:

Yes, he did.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

Okay. Next one, Darien Kelly applying for Landfill Level B.

MR. BARBER:

That's a regular?

MS. BORDELON:

Yes.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

Yes.

MS. BORDELON:

This one was not approved at the

1 October meeting due to not enough
2 experience or detail on his
3 experience, so he added more
4 information to his employment.

5 **MR. BARBER:**

6 Good.

7 (AT THIS TIME MR. HENRY LAGRANGE ARRIVED.)

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Let the Record show that Mr.
10 Henry Lagrange has arrived at the
11 meeting.

12 Next one is Mr. Thomas Phillips,
13 C&D Level B.

14 **MR. BARBER:**

15 I'm looking at the note that's
16 written down here, it appears to be
17 the original certification and date.
18 Apparently, on the last meeting he
19 didn't have enough information; is
20 that correct?

21 **MS. BORDELON:**

22 No. This is the first time we
23 looked at this one.

24 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

25 Does he have a conditional? He

1 says he's got a Level B.

2 **MS. BORDELON:**

3 Right. I think that's correct.

4 Yeah.

5 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

6 And I think that's a

7 conditional; right?

8 **MR. WYNN:**

9 Did they pay the certifications?

10 **MS. BORDELON:**

11 Yes.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Okay. That's all of the regular
14 certificates. Do I hear a motion to
15 approve the applications for Michael
16 Harrison, Darien Kelly, and Thomas
17 Phillips?

18 **MR. BARBER:**

19 So moved.

20 **MR. WYNN:**

21 Second.

22 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

23 Moved by Mr. Barber. Seconded
24 by Mr. Wynn. Any objections to the
25 motion? Hearing none, the motion

1 carries.

2 Okay. Next is the conditional
3 extension request from Nature Fryka.

4 **MR. BARBER:**

5 That's a he or a she?

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 I'm thinking it's a she.

8 **MS. BORDELON:**

9 I think it is a she.

10 **MR. BARBER:**

11 It appears that she has held
12 some certifications, but --

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Conditional certifications.

15 **MR. BARBER:**

16 God knows where it's from.
17 Because I'm looking that she's been
18 in Houston, Texas and Cleveland,
19 Tennessee, Atalanta, Georgia and now
20 Shreveport, Louisiana.

21 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

22 Yeah. She's got the
23 conditional, and we've extended it
24 once before. She's asking for a
25 second extension.

1 **MR. BARBER:**

2 Okay. So this is like a second
3 conditional?

4 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

5 An extension, right.

6 **MS. BORDELON:**

7 A second extension request.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 You know, she's extending it
10 until she meets her experience
11 requirement.

12 **MR. BARBER:**

13 Okay. All right. Sounds good
14 then.

15 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

16 The only issues I had with her
17 is that the conditional that she had
18 actually expired in September. And
19 normally on a regular certificate if
20 it expires, and you put your
21 application in within 60 days or 90
22 days, you can go ahead and get your
23 certificate, but you have to pay
24 additional \$100 fee.

25 And I don't know how you'll feel

1 about that as to whether that fee
2 should be imposed here since she did
3 not --

4 **MR. WYNN:**

5 It'd be the same fee for
6 everybody, so yeah, I think we need
7 to impose it. Because she could've
8 submitted it for the October
9 meeting.

10 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

11 Okay. Would you like to make a
12 motion to grant the extension with
13 the additional \$100 fee?

14 **MR. WYNN:**

15 I make that motion, yes.

16 **MR. BARBER:**

17 I second.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Okay. A motion by Mr. Wynn.
20 Seconded by Mr. Barber that Nature
21 Fryka's conditional be extended an
22 additional six months, and also that
23 the \$100 late filing fee be applied.

24 **MR. BARBER:**

25 And also there's not a signature

1 on the -- Unless they signed it in
2 the wrong place.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Carrie Outley signed it. I have
5 a page with a signature.

6 **MR. WYNN:**

7 I've got a page with a
8 signature. I have a signature, but
9 it's not on the -- It's on the
10 application.

11 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

12 Well, I have the -- Carrie
13 Outley is the supervisor.

14 **MR. BARBER:**

15 I don't know if that's what I
16 have.

17 **MR. WYNN:**

18 There's missing pages.

19 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

20 Yeah, the signature is there.
21 Okay. Any objection to the motion?
22 Okay, hearing none, the motion
23 carries.

24 Okay. Ashunti Wortham. Again,
25 requesting an extension of her

1 conditional.

2 **MS. BORDELON:**

3 His.

4 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

5 His, okay. And he has taken
6 the exam and come to a class?

7 **MS. BORDELON:**

8 Yes, he has.

9 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

10 Okay, so has met the
11 requirements. Do I hear a motion to
12 approve the extension?

13 **MR. WYNN:**

14 I am looking about the signature
15 of the supervisor.

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 Some of these, like I stated in
18 the email, I did not attach the
19 signature page. Just so that those
20 of you-all that print them out, it
21 kind of lessens all the paper and
22 printing time.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Okay. So you do have a
25 signature?

1 **MS. BORDELON:**

2 I do have a signature.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Okay.

5 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

6 I move on that, approve the
7 conditional extension.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Okay. A motion by Mr. Lagrange.

10 **MR. BARBER:**

11 Seconded.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Seconded by Mr. Barber that the
14 Ashunti Wortham's conditional
15 extension be granted for another six
16 months.

17 Any objections to the motion?
18 Hearing none, the motion carries.

19 A request for conditional
20 certificate from William T. Hayes.

21 **MS. BORDELON:**

22 No, scratch that one. I pulled
23 up an old agenda, last year's
24 agenda, and I didn't see that at the
25 bottom.

1 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

2 Okay. We have no applications
3 for re-certification.

4 **MS. BORDELON:**

5 Re-certification, yes, we do.
6 They're in your packet that I handed
7 you.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Oh, okay. Re-certification
10 applications; Wardell Bowie,
11 Landfill, Level A. Raymond Miller,
12 Landfill, Level A. Tharrell Phelps,
13 Landfill, Level B.

14 They've all met their 40-hour
15 requirement?

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 Yes.

18 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

19 Okay. Do I hear a motion to
20 grant the re-certification?

21 **MR. BARBER:**

22 So moved.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Moved by Mr. Barber.

25 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

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Second.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

Seconded by Mr. Lagrange that the above mention re-certification applications be approved.

Any objections to the motion? Hearing none, the motion carriers.

Okay. Issuance of operator certificates.

MS. BORDELON:

We also need to add an addition to Lisa Joiner. We also need to add Michael Harrelson and Darien Kelly.

MR. BONVILLAIN:

For the issuance of certificate? You want to go ahead and call them out so we can get it on the Record?

MS. BORDELON:

Yes. Michael D. Harrelson, C&D, Level A. Darien D. Kelly, Landfill, Level A, and Lisa K. Joiner, Landfill, Level B.

Her application was approved at the October meeting, but she came in the office this past week and

1 tested.

2 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

3 Okay. Do I hear a motion to
4 move the issuance of the
5 certificates?

6 **MR. WYNN:**

7 Yeah, we accept it.

8 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

9 Okay. Motion by Mr. Wynn.

10 **MR. FOURRIER:**

11 Second.

12 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

13 Seconded by Mr. Fourrier that
14 the above named certificates be
15 issued. Any objections to the
16 motion? Hearing none, the motion
17 carries.

18 Committee reports. Awards; Ms.
19 Lindsey Turtle, she's not here.
20 Suzanne, you want to address the
21 award situation?

22 **MS. BORDELON:**

23 Yeah. In your packet that I
24 handed you included the nomination
25 forms of both the Bentley B. Mackay

1 Award, and both the Landfill, Level
2 A and B, C.

3 These are just copies for you
4 as operators to nominate and as a
5 Board to nominate someone within the
6 Mackay and Landfill. As well as you
7 can hand these out to folks at your
8 facility of your certificate
9 operators.

10 I'll be emailing these out next
11 week, cause we're going to have a
12 deadline date of February 12th.

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Okay. Under Bentley Mackay
15 Award again, that's an award that
16 must be nominated by a board member,
17 certification board member. And
18 anybody that wants to submit a
19 nomination, what we will probably
20 end up having to do is a vote by
21 mail if we get more than one
22 nomination.

23 But anybody that wants to submit
24 somebody for this award, please do
25 it as quickly as you can. Go ahead

1 and submit it to Suzanne.

2 **MR. WYNN:**

3 Can we email it?

4 **MS. BORDELON:**

5 Yes.

6 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

7 Yeah. Yeah. And we probably
8 need to set a deadline date on that,
9 so we'd have a chance to review
10 them. You can give them out to
11 everybody.

12 **MS. BORDELON:**

13 February 12th is the deadline for
14 all of them.

15 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

16 Oh, okay. All right. Very
17 good.

18 **MS. BORDELON:**

19 And I know on the other ones for
20 the operator of the year.

21 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

22 Uh-huh (affirmative).

23 **MS. BORDELON:**

24 Normally, the Chairman has
25 gotten the Committee together to

1 review those nominations when they
2 come in.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Okay. Is everybody okay with
5 that procedure to have a Committee
6 review them and make a selection?

7 **MR. LAGRANGE:**

8 I think it was denied, but yes.

9 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

10 Okay. How many people you
11 usually have on that Committee?

12 **MS. BORDELON:**

13 Three. It's usually three.

14 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

15 Three, okay. Mr. Lagrange, --

16 **MS. BORDELON:**

17 Well, you know what, maybe it
18 may not be a good idea to do that
19 now, because I think we can wait
20 until the nominations come in, so
21 that you don't choose somebody that
22 is affiliated with someone.

23 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

24 Okay. All right. Very good
25 idea. Okay, so after February 12th

1 you will let me know who would have
2 a conflict, and then we'll pick a
3 couple of people to join me to
4 select the winner.

5 Okay. Testing. Suzanne called
6 me or emailed me during the week,
7 and asked me who I had appointed as
8 the chairman of the Testing
9 Committee when we had that meeting
10 in Shreveport, and I couldn't
11 remember. And we haven't gotten our
12 minutes yet, so does anybody
13 remember who we appointed?

14 Bubba that wasn't you?

15 **MR. WYNN:**

16 No. I don't remember.

17 **MS. BORDELON:**

18 We'll wait for the transcript.

19 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

20 Yeah, we don't have any testing
21 to report today anyway so. We just
22 had that one that went to the
23 office.

24 Continuing Education. Troy, you
25 have anything to report?

1 **MR. BARBER:**

2 I don't particularly have any
3 statements. Ms. Connie, do you have
4 anything you want to tell us about
5 Lafayette?

6 **MS. HENRY:**

7 The Lafayette Conference is
8 March 16th through 18th in Lafayette,
9 Louisiana at the Cajundome.
10 Registration forms are online for
11 anybody interested.

12 **MR. WYNN:**

13 Hey Gary, I know why I don't
14 remember. I wasn't at the meeting.

15 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

16 Oh, well, I'm pretty sure you
17 were the one that was appointed then
18 if you weren't at the meeting. But
19 we'll verify that when we get the
20 minutes. I don't want to name you
21 if we had already named somebody
22 else.

23 Nominated Mr. Williams is not
24 here. Okay. Do we have any other
25 business to take care of, Suzanne?

1 **MS. BORDELON:**

2 No, I don't believe.

3 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

4 Okay. Public comments. The
5 public want to make any comments?

6 Okay, no public comments.

7 Do I hear the meeting to
8 adjourn.

9 **MR. WYNN:**

10 I move.

11 **MR. BARBER:**

12 Second.

13 **MR. BONVILLAIN:**

14 Moved by Mr. Wynn. Seconded by
15 Mr. Barber. Any objections to the
16 motion?

17 Hearing none, the motion
18 carries. We are adjourned.

19 (The Meeting was concluded at 10:27 a.m.)

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
