1 (BOARD MEETING COMMENCED AT 1:15 P.M.)

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Meeting of the Board of
3 Certification and Training for Solid Waste Management
4 Operators will come to order. The date is October
5 27th, 2015, 1:15 p.m. Ms. Bordelon, could you call
6 roll please?

7 MS. BORDELON: Sure. Troy Barber?

8 MR. BARBER: Here.

9 MS. BORDELON: Jon Fourrier?

10 MR. FOURRIER: Here.

11 MR. BORDELON: Mia Townsel?

12 MS. TOWNSEL: Here.

13 MS. BORDELON: Lindsey Turtle?

14 MS. TURTLE: Here.

15 MS. BORDELON: Connie Henry?

16 MS. HENRY: Here.

17 MS. BORDELON: Fred Williams?

18 MR. WILLIAMS: Here.

19 MS. BORDELON: Bo LaGrange?

20 MR. LAGRANGE: Here.

21 MS. BORDELON: Gary Bonvillain?

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Here.

23 MS. BORDELON: Bubba Wynne?

24 (NO RESPONSE FROM MR. WYNNE)

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. We do have a

1 quorum. I would like to introduce at this time our
2 new board member, Ms. Connie Henry. I think she's
3 pretty well known to most everybody on the board.
4 Connie, welcome.

5 MS. HENRY: Thank you.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: Review of the July 14,
7 2015 minutes. You all received a copy of that through
8 fax.

9 MS. BORDELON: Are you skipping that?

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: Oh, I sure did. I'm
11 sorry. Go back up to number 2, Election of Vice
12 Chairman. In our last meeting we elected the
13 chairman. We decided to hold off on the election of
14 the vice chairman so all our new members would be able
15 to vote, so I'll open the floor to nominations for
16 vice chairman. I think currently our vice chairman is
17 Jonathan Fourrier.

18 MR. LAGRANGE: I move to nominate
19 Jonathan Fourrier.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: All right. Any other
21 nominations?

22 MR. BARBER: Second.

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Got a second to
24 the nomination. Any other nominations? Hear a motion
25 to close the nominations?

1 MR. WILLIAMS: I so move.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: All right. It's been
3 moved to close the nominations. A second for that?

4 MR. BARBER: Second.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay, seconded it.

6 Moved by Mr. Williams, seconded by Troy Barber. All
7 in favor -- excuse me. Rather than that, any
8 objections to the motion? Hearing no objections, the
9 motion has passed. Mr. Fourrier is our vice chairman
10 again. Congratulations, Jonathan.

11 MR. FOURRIER: Thank you.

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. A review of the
13 July 14, 2015 minutes. You've all received a copy of
14 that. Does anybody have any corrections, additions,
15 deletions?

16 MR. LAGRANGE: I move to adopt,
17 Mr. Chairman.

18 MR. WILLIAMS: Second.

19 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Motion by
20 Mr. LaGrange, second by Mr. Williams. We approve the
21 minutes as presented. Any objections to the motion?
22 Hearing none, the motion passes. Consideration of
23 Operator Certifications. The first one up is Ricky
24 Brown, Landfill, Level B. Any questions or problems
25 with that?

1 (No Response)

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Next is Robert Buckner,
3 Transfer Station, Level A. Next is Ashley Cable,
4 Landfill, Level B.

5 MR. BARBER: I have a question on it.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay.

7 MR. BARBER: On the experience -- now,
8 this is a Landfill, Level B, and it looks like he was
9 employed at his current job from March of 2014 to
10 present which is 16 months, 17, 18 months, somewhere
11 along in there, so that's not enough. Now, is there
12 something I'm missing?

13 MR. FOURRIER: He's got construction
14 experience for four years. So B, he needs one year of
15 landfill, two years construction.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: Also at the Shaw E&I,
17 Excavation of municipal solid waste for placement of
18 HDPE pipe for methane collection, fusing and fitting
19 HDPE pipe drilling and setting of methane wells.

20 MR. FOURRIER: Yes.

21 MR. BARBER: So you think that's enough
22 to --

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: I do.

24 MR. BARBER: All right. I'm good.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Roger Cornish, Landfill,

1 Level B. Elwyn DeVille, Incinerator, Level A.

2 MR. FOURRIER: That was for regular
3 certification?

4 MR. BARBER: Yes.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Yes.

6 MR. FOURRIER: Because they checked on
7 number 8 they're applying for conditional. They --

8 MS. BORDELON: Well, a lot of times
9 they just check it.

10 MR. FOURRIER: Just because.

11 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

12 MR. FOURRIER: Yeah. I mean, I thought
13 had enough for regular.

14 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

15 MR. BARBER: Yeah.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: A lot of times they just
17 don't understand the form.

18 MS. BORDELON: Right. Because even --
19 a lot of times even the supervisor will sign it.

20 MR. FOURRIER: I saw the supervisor
21 sent him as Level A.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: I mean, it's not a
23 complicated form, but they don't understand it.

24 MS. BORDELON: Ladarrin.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Ladarrin Folsie, Transfer

1 Station, Level B.

2 MR. BARBER: Is that the same situation
3 there where he checked the conditional?

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

5 MS. BORDELON: Right. Well, originally
6 I believe all three -- he was asking for conditionals
7 for all three of the people from American Recovery,
8 but I put them in regular certification because I
9 thought that they did qualify.

10 MR. BARBER: Got you.

11 MR. FOURRIER: I agree.

12 MS. BORDELON: I just figured if they
13 didn't, we'd ask for conditionals.

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Michael Gonzales,
15 Landfill, Level B.

16 MR. FOURRIER: I had a question on this
17 one.

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay.

19 MR. FOURRIER: He's got almost a year
20 at the landfill, but his previous experience wasn't
21 with construction.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Yeah, he's got
23 experience with Rain for Rent, and I'm not satisfied
24 with that experience requirement. I don't know how
25 anybody else feels.

1 MS. BORDELON: Troy, I think that's the
2 one I emailed you.

3 MR. BARBER: Oh, okay. So he didn't --

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. So would you like
5 to make a motion to deny that --

6 MR. FOURRIER: Motion to deny.

7 MR. BARBER: I second.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Motion by
9 Mr. Fourrier, second by Mr. Williams. The application
10 for Michael Gonzales be denied due to lack of
11 experience. Any objections to the motion? Hearing
12 none, the motion passes. Jamie Troy Gradney,
13 Incinerator, Level A. Keith Guidry, Transfer Station,
14 Level B.

15 MS. BORDELON: The agenda packet that I
16 handed y'all today has some additional experience
17 requirements for Mr. Guidry on the back. It's
18 construction experience.

19 MR. CHAIRMAN: He's got one year
20 experience at his current facility, and then the
21 question is on the additional handout that you were
22 given did you consider that experience as comparable
23 construction experience?

24 MR. BARBER: I'm good with it.

25 MR. FOURRIER: He's applying for --

1 MS. BORDELON: B.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: B, Level B. Now,
3 doesn't that construction experience have to be
4 supervisory construction experience?

5 MS. BORDELON: Uh-huh. (Affirmative)

6 MR. FOURRIER: I thought he was a
7 supervisor.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: It says his supervisor
9 is George Lambo or whatever that is.

10 MR. FOURRIER: I think that would fall
11 in line with the transfer station experience though,
12 the type of work he was doing, tearing down houses,
13 segregating debris, sending it to different places. I
14 think it's suitable for Transfer Station, Level B.

15 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Any more comments
16 on Mr. Guidry? Everybody is okay with his experience?

17 MS. TOWNSEND: I don't know if y'all
18 are a stickler about signing forms, but he didn't sign
19 it.

20 MS. BORDELON: Oh, he did. Yeah.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Calvin Johnson,
22 Landfill, Level B. Lisa Joiner, Landfill, Level B.
23 Darien Kelly, Landfill, Level B.

24 MR. FOURRIER: Is he working in the
25 landfill?

1 MS. TURTLE: Yeah.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: According to this, he's
3 a truck driver.

4 MR. FOURRIER: He was a truck driver
5 before that.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: I really don't see where
7 he's got actual solid waste experience other than
8 driving truck.

9 MS. TURTLE: Huh-uh. (Negative)

10 MR. WILLIAMS: No.

11 MR. LAGRANGE: Based on that,
12 Mr. Chairman, I move to deny.

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Motion by
14 Mr. LaGrange.

15 MR. FOURRIER: Second.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by Mr. Fourrier
17 to deny the application for Darien Kelly for lack of
18 proper experience. Any objections to the motion?
19 Hearing none, the motion passes. Brandi Mallett,
20 Landfill, Level C. Cheryl Mclaughlin, Transfer
21 Station, Level A.

22 MR. FOURRIER: I had a question about
23 this.

24 MS. BORDELON: Cheryl had a conditional
25 level, Transfer station, Level A. Then she applied

1 for regular Level B which she was awarded, and she's
2 held a Level B certification for one year now.

3 MR. CHAIRMAN: Not yet.

4 MS. BORDELON: Well --

5 MR. FOURRIER: In December.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: Not until December.

7 MS. BORDELON: Well, December, yeah.

8 MR. FOURRIER: She needs two years as a
9 B or three years experience.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: She's held a Level B for
11 one year and that experience wise qualifies her for
12 Level A.

13 MR. FOURRIER: For two years, or you
14 hold it for one year?

15 MS. BORDELON: For one year.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: You need the two years
17 experience to get the B, and then you have another
18 year as a Level B that qualifies you for the Level A,
19 but that wouldn't apply until December.

20 MR. WILLIAMS: That will give her three
21 years in December.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Yeah. Would somebody
23 like to make a motion to approve that one effective in
24 December?

25 MR. BARBER: So moved.

1 MR. WILLIAMS: Second.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Barber,
3 seconded by Mr. Williams to approve Cheryl
4 Mclaughlin's application for Level A effective in
5 December of 2015. Any objections to the motion?
6 Hearing none, the motion passes. Bukar Mohammed,
7 Transfer Station, Level B.

8 MR. FOURRIER: I think we've -- hasn't
9 he applied before?

10 MS. BORDELON: He has. He was denied
11 by this board in March of 2014 for lack of experience.

12 MR. FOURRIER: I think we have the same
13 situation.

14 MS. BORDELON: But hasn't he been
15 working in that? He's at the compactor station.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: Looks like he's been
17 doing a lot of work at the compactor station.

18 MS. BORDELON: So he started there in
19 January and he had originally come to the board in
20 March of 2014.

21 (Mr. Williams exits room to answer a call)

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Louis Sanchez, Transfer
23 Station, Level A. And this is one they had indicated
24 a conditional, but his experience qualifies for a
25 regular operator. Jesse Schexnayder, Landfill, Level

1 C.

2 MR. FOURRIER: Actually had a couple
3 C's this time.

4 MS. BORDELON: Uh-huh. (Affirmative)
5 But none of them showed up to test.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: Chris St. Alexandre,
7 Landfill, Level B. I notice his supervisor did not
8 date his signature. Curry White, Landfill, Level B.
9 Okay. Who was the first one we denied?

10 MS. BORDELON: Michael Gonzales.

11 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Do I hear a
12 motion to approve all the certifications with the
13 exception of Michael Gonzales and Darien Kelly who
14 we've already denied and Cheryl Mclaughlin who was
15 taken care of at a separate motion?

16 MR. LAGRANGE: I move, Mr. Chairman.

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Moved by
18 Mr. LaGrange.

19 MR. BARBER: Second.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by
21 Mr. Barber to approve all of the applications with the
22 exception of Michael Gonzales, Darien Kelly and Cheryl
23 Mclaughlin. Any objection to the motion? Hearing
24 none, the motion passes. Next is the request to
25 extend conditional certificates. These all -- well,

1 two for Stericycle and one for Southern Disposal.
2 Joshua Jackson. Ms. Bordelon, he's made his
3 requirement to attend the session and pass the test?

4 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Joshua Hank Morris --

6 MR. BARBER: Joseph Jackson.

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: Huh?

8 MR. BARBER: Joseph Jackson.

9 MS. BORDELON: Joseph Jackson.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: What did I say?

11 MS. BORDELON: Joshua.

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Oh, okay, I'm sorry.

13 Joseph Jackson. Joshua Morris. Southern Disposal,
14 second extension request. He's taken the test and he
15 passed the test and taken the class?

16 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. And Dustin
18 Valentine, Stericycle, first extension request?

19 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

20 MR. BARBER: Yes, he has.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Do I hear a
22 motion to grant the conditional certificates to these
23 three individuals?

24 MR. BARBER: So moved.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Barber.

1 MR. FOURRIER: Second.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by Mr. Fourrier
3 to grant the conditional extension requests to Joseph
4 Jackson, Joshua Morris and Dustin Valentine. Do I
5 hear a motion to --

6 (Off-the-record discussion)

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: Do I hear a motion to
8 extend --

9 MR. BARBER: So moved.

10 MR. FOURRIER: Second.

11 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by
12 Mr. Fourrier. Any objection to the motion? Hearing
13 none, the motion passes. Okay. Conditional request
14 for Gretchen Tullier, Choctaw Road Landfill, Landfill,
15 Level B, replacing Vicki Crane who was terminated
16 5/15/15.

17 MR. LAGRANGE: I move, Mr. Chairman.

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: Move by Mr. LaGrange.

19 MR. FOURRIER: Second.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by Mr. Fourrier
21 to grant the conditional for Ms. Gretchen Tullier.
22 Any objections to the motion? Hearing none, the
23 motion passes. Okay. Recertification applications.
24 The following individuals have completed all of their
25 training requirements for recertification. Evan

1 Billiot, Landfill B, Coast Guard Road Landfill; Donald
2 Colona, Landfill, Level A, Tangipahoa Parish Regional
3 Solid Waste Facility; John Cortez, Landfill, Level A,
4 Jefferson Parish Landfill; Barney Fontenot, Landfill,
5 Level A, North Landfill; Ray Morgan, Jr., C & D, Level
6 A, Morgan Roofing C & D; Wilfred Thomas, Landfill,
7 Level B, St. Landry Parish Landfill; and Stanley
8 Watts, Landfill B, Woodside Landfill. Do I hear a
9 motion to approve the recertifications?

10 MS. TOWNSEL: I move.

11 MR. CHAIRMAN: Move by Ms. Townsel.

12 MR. WILLIAMS: Second.

13 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by Mr. Williams.

14 Any objection to the motion? Hearing none, the motion
15 passes. Okay. Incomplete recertification
16 applications. Russell Duncan, Landfill, Level A,
17 Woodside Landfill; Wade Scott, C & D, Level A, KV
18 Landfill. We'll take those two before we go to the
19 last one. Connie, are these two individuals, Russell
20 Duncan and Wade Scott, in attendance at the seminar?

21 MS. HENRY: I can find out in about two
22 seconds. I think they are. Just approve them
23 pending --

24 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Do I hear a
25 motion approving recertification for these two

1 individuals pending proof of attendance at the
2 Shreveport conference?

3 MR. WILLIAMS: So moved.

4 MR. LAGRANGE: Second.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Williams,
6 seconded by Mr. LaGrange. Any objection to the
7 motion? Hearing none, the motion passes. The next
8 recertification is Hugh Till, Jr, Landfill, Level A
9 Surface Impoundment, Level A, Landfarm, Level A,
10 Incinerator, Level A, Refuse-Derived Facility, Level
11 A, Transfer Station, Level A, C & D, Level A,
12 Composting, Level A, and Separation, Level A. And his
13 is dependent on us approving his request for hours for
14 attendance at his session in Texas.

15 MR. BARBER: You know, while everybody
16 is looking, I don't have to look to make my mind up
17 about this. If I remember right, we granted him 30
18 hours for the last conference that he attended, and I
19 have -- I know this is one of those cases that he has
20 a -- what do we call it? A lifetime --

21 MS. BORDELON: Membership?

22 MR. BARBER: -- certification.

23 MS. BORDELON: Certification.

24 MR. BARBER: And I don't think there
25 was any specifications put on that, but in my opinion,

1 if we're going to grant the guy a lifetime providing
2 he attends training, I think that training needs to be
3 in the state of Louisiana. That's just my opinion.

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: Well, there's no
5 requirement either in the resolution that was passed
6 granting him lifetime or in any of the regs that the
7 training had to be in Louisiana. It had to be
8 training approved by the board.

9 MR. BARBER: Well, we're a board in
10 Louisiana, and we're granting him this training, and I
11 just think it needs to be training that's within -- I
12 don't know what the resolution says. I don't know if
13 there's a way that we can change the wording of that
14 resolution and what that would entail, but that's my
15 opinion. I don't intend as a board member to continue
16 granting this guy hours for training that he
17 supposedly is doing in Texas and we have no way of
18 verifying that other than maybe a piece of paper. I
19 would rather have it where we can verify it right here
20 in our own state.

21 MR. WILLIAMS: Well, I'm trying to
22 figure out what the difference between that is and if
23 we do reciprocity for someone else that's looking for
24 some type of certification, you know, and I don't
25 really know what the difference is. I don't really

1 see that there's a difference. If it were not for
2 that individual, just on one who was say for instance
3 moving from Texas or Alabama to Louisiana and they had
4 the certification from that other state and we were
5 going to grant reciprocity, I really don't see any
6 difference in that, but that's just my opinion.

7 MR. BARBER: We would verify that.

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Of course.

9 MR. BARBER: In this case -- and I kind
10 of see what you're talking about, but in this case,
11 apparently he has a certification in the state of
12 Texas in order to be operating there.

13 MR. WILLIAMS: Yes.

14 MR. BARBER: So it's not a case where
15 he's trying to get a certification or keep a
16 certification to operate as a solid waste operator.
17 It's a case where he's trying to hang on to a
18 certification in the state of Louisiana, and I just
19 don't think Texas training is good enough. I mean,
20 I'm sorry, I just don't. I think it needs to be in
21 Louisiana. If he wants to keep his certification in
22 Louisiana, he needs to attend training in Louisiana.

23 MR. WILLIAMS: Well, if he has a
24 lifetime certification --

25 MR. BARBER: He still has to get

1 hours --

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: The lifetime
3 certification requires though that you do your
4 continuing education.

5 MR. WILLIAMS: In Louisiana?

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: No, there's no
7 requirement that it has to be in Louisiana. Just
8 requires that you continue --

9 MR. BARBER: Is there anything saying
10 this board can't make that a requirement?

11 MR. CHAIRMAN: You can because as a
12 matter of fact, the lifetime certification is
13 something that the board did that's not specified in
14 the regulations. So if you want to put that as a
15 stipulation going forward, that's something that the
16 board can do if it so chooses, but we can't
17 retroactively apply that in this case because that was
18 never said.

19 MR. WILLIAMS: That was not
20 retroactive --

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Right. Because that was
22 never said that you have to have your training in
23 Louisiana.

24 MR. WILLIAMS: Right.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Now, if the board wants

1 to take up the issue say going forward and then all
2 these people are notified, then the board can do that,
3 but for the present time, we're dealing with this
4 issue with this one individual and whether or not you
5 think the training that he has from this Texas course
6 qualifies as continuing education to meet our
7 requirements.

8 MR. WILLIAMS: Well, personally I don't
9 have a problem with the training that they receive in
10 Texas. I used to go to Texas myself before -- Mike
11 Strong made me to go to Texas before we had the
12 training that we have now here in Louisiana, and
13 they've got excellent training in Texas. I know
14 because I've witnessed it. I've been a part of it.

15 MR. BARBER: It's not that I have a
16 problem with the training in Texas. He's trying to
17 keep a certification in the state of Louisiana.

18 MR. WILLIAMS: No, but you made a
19 statement that the training in Texas was not --

20 MR. BARBER: Well, it's not -- it's not
21 good enough for the state of Louisiana. This is the
22 state of Louisiana certification.

23 MR. WILLIAMS: I understand what you're
24 saying.

25 MR. CHAIRMAN: Garbage is garbage.

1 MR. BARBER: I agree.

2 MR. WILLIAMS: And like Gary said, if
3 we want to do something going forward, but, you know,
4 I don't think that that would apply to this particular
5 case.

6 MS. HENRY: Is there something that --
7 I know like in a little while Terrance will bring
8 forward our agenda and our board will either say it's
9 okay for 10 hours or say it's not okay. Is there
10 something that he has from the state of Texas stating
11 that they approve this agenda for 30 hours? I mean,
12 it's handwritten, but like from their board is there
13 something that he has --

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Well, this sheet here
15 says 30 hours is what they recognize it for.

16 MS. HENRY: It's the handwritten part I
17 guess that bothers me. And if we can go backwards on
18 the two guys, Russell Duncan and Wade Scott,
19 Mr. Duncan is here and Mr. Scott is not.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Well, the motion
21 was, you know, pending their attendance, so we're
22 covered.

23 MS. HENRY: Okay.

24 MR. CHAIRMAN: Do I hear a motion on
25 Mr. Till?

1 MR. LAGRANGE: I move, Mr. Chairman.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: Move what?

3 MR. LAGRANGE: I move to approve the
4 requested continuing education hours. How many hours
5 is it --

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: 30 hours.

7 MR. WILLIAMS: 30 hours.

8 MR. LAGRANGE: I move to approve.

9 MR. WILLIAMS: I second.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: And to issue the
11 recertification.

12 MR. LAGRANGE: And issue
13 recertification.

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Move by
15 Mr. LaGrange to approve the 30 hours of continuing
16 education from the Texas course and to approve the
17 recertification seconded by Mr. Williams. Any further
18 discussion? Okay. Any objection to the motion?

19 MR. BARBER: (Raises hand)

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. We'll have a role
21 call vote please.

22 MS. BORDELON: Troy Barber?

23 MR. WILLIAMS: Excuse me just a minute.

24 A -- specified what a certain type vote means, a yea
25 vote or a nay vote --

1 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Well, a yea vote
2 says you're approving the credit for the hours and the
3 recertification. A nay vote says you're not.

4 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay, just to be clear
5 for everybody.

6 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Ms. Bordelon.

7 MS. BORDELON: Troy Barber?

8 MR. BARBER: Nay.

9 MS. BORDELON: Jon Fourrier?

10 MR. FOURRIER: Yes.

11 MS. BORDELON: Lindsey Turtle?

12 MS. TURTLE: Yes.

13 MS. BORDELON: Connie Henry?

14 MS. HENRY: Yes.

15 MS. BORDELON: Fred Williams?

16 MR. WILLIAMS: Yes.

17 MS. BORDELON: Bo LaGrange?

18 MR. LAGRANGE: Yes.

19 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. One, two, three,
20 four, five yea's and one nay. The motion carries.

21 Okay. The issuance of operator certificates.

22 Ms. Bordelon, would you read off the list please?

23 MS. BORDELON: Yes. Ricky D. Brown,
24 Landfill, Level B; Robert K. Buckner, Transfer
25 Station, Level A; Ashley B. Cable, Landfill, Level B;

1 Roger F. Cornish, Landfill, Level B; Elwyn G. DeVille,
2 Incinerator, Level A; Ladarrin S. Folsie, Transfer
3 Station, Level B; James T, Gradney, Incinerator, Level
4 A; Keith G. Guidry, Transfer Station, Level B; Calvin
5 D. Johnson, Landfill, Level B; Bukar Mohammed,
6 Transfer Station, Level B; Louis Sanchez, Transfer
7 Station, Level A; Chris St. Alexandre, Landfill, Level
8 B; Curry White, Landfill, Level -- no. Sorry, not
9 Curry White. He failed. That's it.

10 MR. CHAIRMAN: That's it. Okay. Do I
11 hear a motion to approve the certificates as announced
12 by Ms. Bordelon?

13 MR. BARBER: So moved.

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Barber.

15 MR. FOURRIER: Second.

16 MR. CHAIRMAN: Seconded by
17 Mr. Fourrier. Any objections to the motion? Hearing
18 none, the motion passes. Committee reports.

19 Awards -- since we don't have anybody as chairman of
20 that committee, there will be no report. Do I hear --

21 MS. BORDELON: Do we want to nominate
22 somebody for that committee?

23 MR. CHAIRMAN: Well, I'm fixing to ask
24 for volunteers for that committee. If not, I will
25 appoint somebody. Ms. Turtle, would you like to

1 volunteer for that as chairman of the awards
2 committee?

3 MS. TURTLE: Yes.

4 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Ms. Bordelon will
5 work with you on that. Very good. Testing. How many
6 took the test today?

7 MS. BORDELON: Nine.

8 MR. CHAIRMAN: Nine tested today; eight
9 passed and one failed. Mr. LaGrange, would you care
10 to take over the testing committee going forward?.

11 MR. LAGRANGE: Sure.

12 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Continuing
13 education, Troy.

14 MR. BARBER: I think this closes out
15 our workshops for the year, and we'll be starting
16 brand spanking new in 2016 in Lafayette.

17 MS. BORDELON: Correct.

18 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Nominating
19 committee, Mr. Williams.

20 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay. We have
21 basically -- Jonathan's first term has expired and
22 we're going into a second term. I believe a letter
23 has been submitted --

24 MS. BORDELON: Yes, correct.

25 MR. WILLIAMS: -- but it hadn't been

1 signed.

2 MS. BORDELON: That is correct.

3 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay. Obviously that's
4 forthcoming because he's the vice chairman. It's
5 going to be approved. And the other one is the LMA,
6 Crystal Perkins. I don't think we've ever gotten
7 anything from the LMA to replace her, so that's the
8 one that's still vacant and we need to connect LMA to
9 get them to --

10 MS. BORDELON: LMA has been contacted.
11 A letter was initially sent to them asking for a
12 nomination in February.

13 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay.

14 MS. BORDELON: Two follow-up emails
15 have been sent to them requesting a nomination and
16 we've received nothing.

17 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay. Well, what I'll
18 do is I'll make a phone call and see if we can get
19 that taken care of. Other than that, that's all that
20 I have to report, Mr. Chairman.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. Other business,
22 review request from Hugh Till, we've already taken
23 care of that. Let's see. We have Mr. Terrance
24 Stewart with the LSWA, but I notice he's not on the
25 agenda. Do I hear a motion --

1 MR. WILLIAMS: Mr. Chairman, I'd like
2 to make a motion to that.

3 MR. CHAIRMAN: Okay. A motion to add
4 Mr. Terrance Stewart in reference to the Lafayette
5 conference. Do I hear a second to that?

6 MR. LAGRANGE: Second.

7 MR. CHAIRMAN: A second by
8 Mr. LaGrange. Any objection to the motion? Okay.
9 Hearing none, the motion passes. Mr. Stewart is going
10 to give us information on the Lafayette conference.

11 MR. STEWART: Yeah. What I have here
12 is the agenda for the Lafayette conference. We have
13 the topics. We have the hours beside the different
14 topics, and at this time, LSWA is requesting that the
15 board review the agenda for approval for the Lafayette
16 conference. Does everybody have one?

17 MR. CHAIRMAN: Give everybody a few
18 minutes to go ahead and review.

19 MR. STEWART: Just a little side note
20 as well, the LEHA is a separate group and they're
21 planning on their own agenda as is regulatory
22 compliance DEQ will submit when the new regs are
23 complete. But if you'll look out to your right side,
24 the hours, the topics with the time given is there.

25 MR. WILLIAMS: So without adding all

1 those numbers up, does that add the 10 hours in?

2 MR. STEWART: Yes, it does. Yes, it
3 accumulates 10 hours.

4 MR. WILLIAMS: Terrance?

5 MR. STEWART: Sir?

6 MR. WILLIAMS: I'm sorry. Mr. Stewart.

7 MR. STEWART: Thank you.

8 MR. WILLIAMS: The only thing I see on
9 here that I'm not familiar with is the CCR update.

10 MR. STEWART: Okay. That's the coal
11 combustion residuals rules.

12 MR. WILLIAMS: Okay. So that wouldn't
13 apply to landfill I don't guess. No. Okay. All
14 right. That clears that up.

15 MR. STEWART: Okay.

16 MR. WILLIAMS: Were you on the steering
17 committee?

18 MR. STEWART: I was.

19 MR. WILLIAMS: Oh, okay.

20 MR. STEWART: I sure was.

21 MR. CHAIRMAN: Any questions of
22 Mr. Stewart?

23 MR. BARBER: Regulatory compliance will
24 be on -- just on the solid waste regs?

25 MR. STEWART: Yes. And as I said, DEQ

1 will submit their agenda when the regs are complete.

2 MR. CHAIRMAN: So presumably that whole
3 session would be solid waste related?

4 MR. BARBER: Right.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: That's why I was asking,
6 because as Mr. Williams said, the CCR may not
7 necessarily be related to solid waste.

8 MS. TOWNSEL: It's related to solid
9 waste, just not to the landfills.

10 MR. WILLIAMS: Not to landfills.

11 MR. BARBER: Okay.

12 MR. WILLIAMS: That's what I said, not
13 to landfill. Yeah, that's what I said.

14 MR. CHAIRMAN: Of course at the same
15 time, you have compliance monitoring strategy which
16 would apply to all the sections of solid waste, solid
17 water and everything else. Okay. Do I hear a motion
18 to approve the agenda for 10 hours of credit?

19 MR. WILLIAMS: So moved.

20 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Williams.

21 MS. TURTLE: Second.

22 MR. CHAIRMAN: Second by Ms. Turtle.

23 Any more discussion? Any objection to the motion?

24 Hearing none, the motion passes.

25 MR. STEWART: Thank you.

1 MR. CHAIRMAN: Thank you, Mr. Stewart.
2 Any public comments? Do I hear a motion to adjourn?

3 MR. WILLIAMS: So moved.

4 MR. BARBER: Seconded.

5 MR. CHAIRMAN: Moved by Mr. Williams,
6 seconded by Mr. Barber. Any objection to the motion?
7 Hearing none, the motion passes.




