1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 Okay. The Louisiana DEQ Board of
3 Certification meeting comes to order. This is
4 July the 14th. It is 10:01 -- or 11:01.

5 Could we have a roll call, please?

6 MS. ROBINS:

7 Mr. John Bubba Wynn?

8 THE CHAIRMAN:

9 Here.

10 MS. ROBINS:

11 Richard LeBouef?

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 Here.

14 MS. ROBINS:

15 Donovan Driskill?

16 MR. DRISKILL:

17 Here.

18 MS. ROBINS:

19 Donnie Colona?

20 MR. COLONA:

21 Here.

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 Jonathan Fourrier?

24 MR. FOURRIER:

25 Here.

1 MS. ROBINS:

2 Darryl Platt?

3 MR. PLATT:

4 Here.

5 MS. ROBINS:

6 And Robert Thomas?

7 MR. THOMAS:

8 Here.

9 MR. ROBINS:

10 And also have myself, Shirley
11 Robins, and Karen Myers.

12 THE CHAIRMAN:

13 We got a review for the minutes for
14 the March 19, 2025. Do I have a motion?

15 MR. LeBOUEF:

16 I move we accept.

17 MR. DRISKILL:

18 Second.

19 THE CHAIRMAN:

20 All right. We got the consideration
21 of operator certifications.

22 And let's go through each one of
23 them.

24 Very first one is John Lawrence.

25 MR. LeBOUEF:

1 Mr. Chairman, I got an issue with
2 that one. Me and Mr. Driskill were addressing
3 that earlier. The gentleman has two and a
4 half years expired, only three years of
5 continuing education. And I think as Greg
6 said, any operator who's still going to be
7 expired for more than three months shall be
8 treated as a new applicant.

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 Any other comments?

11 Do I hear a motion?

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 I move a motion to deny.

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 I second.

16 THE CHAIRMAN:

17 So John Lawrence has been denied.

18 All right. Carl McAlister.

19 MR. DRISKILL:

20 I move to approve.

21 MR. LeBOUEF:

22 I second.

23 THE CHAIRMAN:

24 Any other comments?

25 He is approved.

1 Daniel Mitchell. There's one thing
2 on his application and I did make a little
3 ditto about it was he is applying for a Type 2
4 certification. It's no Type 1 certification.

5 MR. DRISKILL:

6 I move we approve.

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 I second.

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 It has been approved.

11 Jeanette Fontenot.

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 I move to approve.

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 Second.

16 THE CHAIRMAN:

17 Any any other comments?

18 Jeanette has been approved.

19 David Vidrine.

20 MR. COLONA:

21 Does he have any experience with
22 incinerators is what I have a note of.

23 THE CHAIRMAN:

24 Right.

25 Do I have a motion?

1 MR. DRISKILL:

2 I move we approve.

3 MR. COLONA:

4 I second.

5 THE CHAIRMAN:

6 It's been approved and seconded.

7 Any other comments?

8 David Vidrine is approved.

9 Marcus White.

10 MR. LeBOUEF:

11 He's applying for two level Bs,
12 construction and separation. I just got a
13 question.

14 THE CHAIRMAN:

15 What's your question?

16 MR. LeBOUEF:

17 No, what I'm saying, that was my
18 question mark. I mean, any input from the
19 board?

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 Well, we got two different
22 certifications, two different permits.

23 MR. LeBOUEF:

24 I move to approve.

25 MR. COLONA:

1 Second.

2 THE CHAIRMAN:

3 Any other comments?

4 Damien Metoyer.

5 MR. DRISKILL:

6 I move to approve.

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 Second.

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 He's been moved and approved,
11 seconded. So he got his.

12 Michael Dick.

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 All right. I've got a question,
15 Chairman. Not quite one year in this
16 facility, and employer number two has him
17 laying out lines for fracking transfer.

18 MR. COLONA:

19 Not enough working experience.

20 MR. LeBOUEF:

21 I move to deny.

22 THE CHAIRMAN:

23 Do we have a second?

24 MR. DRISKILL:

25 I second the deny.

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 Any other comments?

3 Michael Dick has been denied.

4 Rudy Garcia. Do we have a motion?

5 MR. LeBOUEF:

6 I move to approve.

7 MR. COLONA:

8 Second.

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 It's been approved.

11 Darren Perio.

12 MR. DRISKILL:

13 I move to approve.

14 MR. LeBOUEF:

15 I'll second that.

16 THE CHAIRMAN:

17 It has been approved.

18 All right. Now, is the request for
19 conditional certifications.

20 Justin Taylor. He's asking for a
21 condition. Is he replacing somebody?

22 MR. COLONA:

23 It says it's a new site waiting on
24 permits.

25 MR. DRISKILL:

1 It's a new site waiting on permits,
2 so he has no one to replace it.

3 THE CHAIRMAN:

4 Let's get back up to the regular
5 applications. I did not see those, or I
6 didn't receive them.

7 We've got Anthony Drain. I don't
8 have those.

9 MR. DRISKILL:

10 He's okay. I move it to approve.

11 THE CHAIRMAN:

12 Do I have a second?

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 I second.

15 THE CHAIRMAN:

16 Anthony is approved.

17 Devin Dykes.

18 MR. LeBOUEF:

19 He has plenty of experience. 17 and
20 present. I move.

21 MR. DRISKILL:

22 I second.

23 THE CHAIRMAN:

24 He's been accepted.

25 Erika Booker.

1 MR. DRISKILL:

2 I move to approve.

3 MR. COLONA:

4 I second.

5 THE CHAIRMAN:

6 Any other comments?

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 October should have five years --
9 four years.

10 THE CHAIRMAN:

11 Have we got a second on Erika?

12 MR. COLONA:

13 I second.

14 THE CHAIRMAN:

15 She's been approved.

16 Marques Williams.

17 MR. DRISKILL:

18 I move to approve.

19 MR. LeBOUEF:

20 I second.

21 THE CHAIRMAN:

22 It's been approved.

23 Devan Roberts.

24 MR. COLONA:

25 I move to approve.

1 MR. DRISKILL:

2 I second it.

3 THE CHAIRMAN:

4 It's been approved.

5 All right. Let's go back to the
6 conditional certifications.

7 Justin Taylor. Let's go back to
8 this one. They are -- it is in -- the board
9 can decide and give approval to some of the
10 bills, especially on new facilities. And I
11 thank him for going ahead and trying to get
12 his done before he got his permit. So that's
13 in y'all's consideration. Would approve?

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 I mean, if we can approve it like
16 that, I'm fine with that. I mean, he's trying
17 to do the right thing.

18 MR. COLONA:

19 I move to approve.

20 MR. DRISKILL:

21 I second.

22 THE CHAIRMAN:

23 All right. Justin Taylor got in.

24 Dawn Naquin.

25 MR. LeBOUEF:

1 On the application, does it say
2 here? Pay and past test. This application
3 doesn't have it.

4 THE CHAIRMAN:

5 Are they replacing somebody?

6 MR. LeBOUEF:

7 Yes. I move to accept.

8 MR. DRISKILL:

9 I'll second that.

10 THE CHAIRMAN:

11 It's been seconded and approved.

12 Joseph David.

13 MR. DRISKILL:

14 I'm move we approve it.

15 THE CHAIRMAN:

16 I've got a question on this one. If
17 you go back and look at the experience, he's
18 got five years. Why give him a condition when
19 he can get a regular certification?

20 MR. DRISKILL:

21 I agree with that.

22 MR. LeBOUEF:

23 I agree with that myself.

24 If that's a motion, I'll second it.

25 MR. DRISKILL:

1 I'll move to approve for a regular
2 certificate.

3 MR. LeBOUEF:

4 And I'll second it.

5 THE CHAIRMAN:

6 It's been approved for regular
7 certification instead of a condition.

8 All right. Anton Belei. If I'm not
9 mistaken, I've looked at this one.

10 MR. DRISKILL:

11 It's also regular, yeah.

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 Let's do the same thing.

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 I'll move to approve regular
16 certification.

17 MR. LeBOUEF:

18 And I'll second that, sir.

19 THE CHAIRMAN:

20 It's been approved and seconded for
21 regular certification.

22 Josephine Jordan.

23 MR. DRISKILL:

24 I move to approve.

25 THE CHAIRMAN:

1 Are they taking the place of
2 somebody?

3 MR. DRISKILL:

4 Yes, Luis Sanchez.

5 MR. LeBOUEF:

6 I second that.

7 THE CHAIRMAN:

8 It's been approved and seconded.

9 Any other comments?

10 This next one you cut off the
11 first -- of the first name. Aristed Sanders.

12 MR. DRISKILL:

13 I move to approve.

14 MR. LeBOUEF:

15 I second.

16 MR. DRISKILL:

17 On conditional.

18 THE CHAIRMAN:

19 Moved and approved for conditional.

20 Anthony Green.

21 MR. LeBOUEF:

22 I don't see the replacement. Am I
23 missing that?

24 MR. DRISKILL:

25 Yeah, I got a note here. They're

1 not replacing anyone trying to add a second
2 landfill operator. Make sure someone's
3 certified there at all times.

4 MR. FOURRIER:

5 What landfill is that for?

6 THE CHAIRMAN:

7 City of Pineville.

8 What kind of time period is his
9 experience?

10 MR. LeBOUEF:

11 A year and a couple of months -- two
12 years and a couple of months.

13 THE CHAIRMAN:

14 All you have to have on a B level is
15 two years.

16 MR. LeBOUEF:

17 That's correct. I think he can pass
18 the test if approve a standard B, not a
19 conditional.

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 Do I have a second on that?

22 Well, first of all, let's go back to
23 the conditional.

24 MR. DRISKILL:

25 Yeah, we have to deny this.

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 You have to deny the conditional,
3 but if they pass the test, y'all can vote them
4 back in in October.

5 MR. DRISKILL:

6 Yeah, you'll have two years.

7 MS. ROBINS:

8 He passed the test on --

9 MR. DRISKILL:

10 He passed the A test. He'S only got
11 a year and he's not replacing anybody.

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 He's got two years and a couple of
14 months.

15 MR. DRISKILL:

16 So what we're talking about is
17 giving them an option is denying the
18 conditional, and then in October, we can
19 approve the B. Am I right?

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 Yes, you are.

22 MR. DRISKILL:

23 So I move we deny.

24 MR. LeBOUEF:

25 I second.

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 It's been denied.

3 MR. DRISKILL:

4 Denied a conditional. But in
5 October, he'll have the two years. He can
6 apply for regular certification. B, level B.

7 MR. FOURRIER:

8 But they won't have a second
9 operator between now and October. Can we give
10 him a conditional?

11 THE CHAIRMAN:

12 Have they got an A level on the
13 site? If they've got an A level on the site,
14 they'd have two levels.

15 MR. FOURRIER:

16 Is he a B now? Or is he trying to
17 get a B conditional?

18 THE CHAIRMAN:

19 He's trying to get a conditional A.

20 MR. DRISKILL:

21 He's not replacing anyone at the
22 site.

23 MR. FOURRIER:

24 Is he a B?

25 MR. DRISKILL:

1 No. He's only got a year and
2 something.

3 THE CHAIRMAN:

4 Two years.

5 I've had a little memo talked in my
6 ear and they said he should be qualified for a
7 conditional B.

8 MR. DRISKILL:

9 Even if he's not replacing with the
10 same condition?

11 THE CHAIRMAN:

12 Same kind, kind of like the same
13 operator.

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 Do we make him resubmit, or do we
16 just go in and do the conditional B?

17 THE CHAIRMAN:

18 Do the conditional B now. But then
19 in October --

20 MR. DRISKILL:

21 He can apply for the regular
22 certification.

23 MR. LeBOUEF:

24 No, he's not eligible for the A
25 unless he's got an engineering degree in two

1 years.

2 MR. DRISKILL:

3 So I move that we approve n
4 conditional B. And then in October, he can
5 apply for regular certification.

6 THE CHAIRMAN:

7 That's for a B level, not an A
8 level.

9 MR. LeBOUEF:

10 He has his two years, doesn't he?

11 MS. ROBINS:

12 In October.

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 Date of employment was 3/13/23. As
15 of right now, he's got two years. So we can
16 give him a B -- standard B now. He's got two
17 years experience. 3/13/23, then I guess to
18 present.

19 MR. FOURRIER:

20 He passed the test?

21 MR. DRISKILL:

22 He passed the A test.

23 MS. ROBINS:

24 I thought the A was higher.

25 MR. FOURRIER:

1 Why did he take the A test when he
2 applied for the B?

3 MS. ROBINS:

4 That's what he applied for.

5 THE CHAIRMAN:

6 He applied for the condition.

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 Can we do that as the board?

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 Yes, you can.

11 MR. LeBOUEF:

12 All right. I move that we give him
13 a standard B, deny the conditional A, and
14 award him the standard B.

15 MS. ROBINS:

16 So he's approved for a regular B?

17 THE CHAIRMAN:

18 A regular B certification.

19 MR. DRISKILL:

20 I second that.

21 MS. ROBINS:

22 So October is out the picture?

23 MR. DRISKILL:

24 October is out the picture.

25 THE CHAIRMAN:

1 He has been approved for a regular B
2 certification.

3 Reviews of recertification
4 applications.

5 John Vice.

6 MR. COLONA:

7 I motion.

8 MR. LeBOUEF:

9 I second.

10 THE CHAIRMAN:

11 Motion made and it was seconded.

12 He's good.

13 Richard LeBouef. I've got a
14 question.

15 MR. LeBOUEF:

16 I don't blame you.

17 MR. COLONA:

18 I move we approve.

19 MR. DRISKILL:

20 Second.

21 THE CHAIRMAN:

22 He has been approved.

23 Ronald Edwards.

24 MR. LeBOUEF:

25 I'll make that motion to approve.

1 MR. COLONA:

2 Second.

3 THE CHAIRMAN:

4 He has been approved and seconded.

5 He's awarded.

6 Michelle Prelow.

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 I've got a note on that for lapse in
9 training hours.

10 MS. ROBINS:

11 She turned them all in.

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 I make that motion to approve.

14 MR. COLONA:

15 Second.

16 THE CHAIRMAN:

17 Motion made and seconded. She's
18 good.

19 Jarachin Guidry.

20 MR. LeBOUEF:

21 I've got a note on there that there
22 is an issue with the education hours. A
23 letter showing research in 2025, but he's
24 missing his 2022. Has that been turned in,
25 too?

1 MS. ROBINS:

2 He should have all of his.

3 MR. DRISKILL:

4 He has three -- four.

5 MS. ROBINS:

6 Yeah, he has four.

7 MR. DRISKILL:

8 I move we approve.

9 MR. LeBOUEF:

10 I second.

11 THE CHAIRMAN:

12 Motion made to approve and seconded.

13 Incomplete recertification
14 application.

15 Edna Stevenson. Did they attend
16 workshop.

17 MS. ROBINS:

18 She's coming in October. She said
19 she won't come to this one.

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 When does she term out?

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 June 1st.

24 MR. DRISKILL:

25 She'll have to pay the late fees.

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 So it's been accepted?

3 MR. DRISKILL:

4 Yeah, I move we accept it if she
5 goes in October.

6 THE CHAIRMAN:

7 And pays the late fee.

8 MR. LeBOUEF:

9 I second that, sir.

10 THE CHAIRMAN:

11 Been approved under conditions.

12 David Jones. I'm sure David has
13 attended all his hours.

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 He turned in three.

16 MR. LeBOUEF:

17 Yeah, that's what I saw.

18 MR. COLONA:

19 I've got four.

20 MS. ROBINS:

21 You got four? That must be the last
22 one.

23 THE CHAIRMAN:

24 He had one of them in Lafayette.

25 MR. LeBOUEF:

1 I make that motion.

2 MS. ROBINS:

3 No, that's not four. That's not it.

4 MR. LeBOUEF:

5 I withdraw that. All I have is
6 three.

7 THE CHAIRMAN:

8 Did he lost one? I've seen him in
9 the Lafayette area.

10 MS. ROBINS:

11 I'm not sure. I only go off on what
12 they send me. We can check.

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 Now, he does have a letter out to
15 Connie.

16 MS. ROBINS:

17 He was there?

18 THE CHAIRMAN:

19 Yeah.

20 MR. LeBOUEF:

21 I make a motion we award pending we
22 get proof.

23 MR. DRISKILL:

24 I second.

25 THE CHAIRMAN:

1 And maybe Connie can come up with
2 that.

3 He has been approved with conditions
4 that he comes up with those last ten hours of
5 workshop training in Lafayette for '25.

6 Paul Bouchereau.

7 MR. LeBOUEF:

8 All I got is three on that one and
9 also a letter to Connie. Same thing again.

10 MR. DRISKILL:

11 Same thing.

12 MR. LeBOUEF:

13 So I'll make that same motion we did
14 the last one. Pending proof.

15 MR. DRISKILL:

16 I'll second it.

17 THE CHAIRMAN:

18 It's been approved and seconded
19 under conditions to show the last ten hours of
20 workshop training.

21 MR. COLONA:

22 Connie has a checkmark on him, so
23 she must know he's got it.

24 THE CHAIRMAN:

25 Christopher Vincent.

1 MR. LeBOUEF:

2 I've got a question. Donovan and I
3 had a conversation earlier. There's no
4 signature from the supervisor, depending he
5 may be the supervisor, but it shows that he
6 attended the Air and Waste Management
7 Association Conference. I have an issue with
8 those things being some kind of qualifications
9 for that.

10 MS. ROBINS:

11 Before you all start, the signature,
12 he said -- he is a supervisor. And he said
13 he's not going to sign it until -- which is
14 crazy -- he said he's not going to sign it
15 because I told him he had to show his other
16 proof and he didn't want to sign it for --
17 because he wanted to see if he's going to get
18 approved first.

19 MR. DRISKILL:

20 He's going to get denied unless he's
21 going to sign.

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 I told him that.

24 MR. DRISKILL:

25 That's easy.

1 MR. LeBOUEF:

2 Again, my issue is with this
3 training.

4 THE CHAIRMAN:

5 I'm going to ask John. John, do you
6 know much about these workshops that he's sent
7 in.

8 MR. FOURRIER:

9 The TCEQ should be equivalent, and
10 then that's Texas' DEQ.

11 THE CHAIRMAN:

12 Right.

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 Whenever I spoke to Dan, I'm sorry.

15 THE CHAIRMAN:

16 But it is showing a lot of error,
17 and it also on the same bill as Solid Waste.

18 MR. FOURRIER:

19 Yeah, I think he needs to give an
20 indication of which particular classes he took
21 while he was there.

22 THE CHAIRMAN:

23 Well, here's another issue that we
24 got and it's something that we really need to
25 start looking at as a board. Air issues is

1 becoming quite strong with Type 2 landfills,
2 especially when you're doing methane gas and
3 the collection systems and everything like
4 that. So that is one thing that we need to
5 start considering really as, you know, air
6 training. Because that is also part of the
7 Solid Waste.

8 MR. FOURRIER:

9 It is. It's a big part of it.

10 So he has the hours. He's just
11 asking for that to be considered to these TCEQ
12 conferences. I don't have an issue with that.

13 MR. LeBOUEF:

14 Speaking with Daniel Cheatham, and
15 Rob knows where I'm at with this, he said it
16 was more specific to air and not site
17 specific. Again, I know that things comingle,
18 but not directed at landfill. I'm going to
19 have to abstain on that one.

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 Well, here's where you go back into
22 the consideration of the air issue with a Type
23 2 landfills.

24 So it's y'all choice. Do we have a
25 motion?

1 MR. FOURRIER:

2 Did he indicate which of these
3 course tracks that he took?

4 MR. LeBOUEF:

5 That's what Bubba was saying. He
6 did not.

7 MR. FOURRIER:

8 He did not.

9 MR. LeBOUEF:

10 And didn't sign it.

11 MR. FOURRIER:

12 Well, we have to deny it because of
13 the signature. Why don't we deny it on that.
14 I motion to deny that, and then ask him to
15 clarify which courses he took.

16 MR. LeBOUEF:

17 I'll second that.

18 THE CHAIRMAN:

19 And bring this back up to the
20 October meeting.

21 MR. LeBOUEF:

22 I second that.

23 MS. ROBINS:

24 So does he need to turn in a new
25 application for October?

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 He just needs to finish the
3 application.

4 MR. LeBOUEF:

5 And be specific on the courses he
6 took at that conference.

7 THE CHAIRMAN:

8 So we're not denying him, we're just
9 asking him to finish up his regular
10 application.

11 MR. FOURRIER:

12 Signature and the courses that he
13 took.

14 THE CHAIRMAN:

15 Nathaniel Evans.

16 MR. LeBOUEF:

17 I'm only showing '21 and '22 for
18 education hours.

19 MS. ROBINS:

20 He turned them in right before.

21 He have all 40.

22 THE CHAIRMAN:

23 Motion has been made. Second?

24 MR. COLONA:

25 I'll second.

1 THE CHAIRMAN:

2 It's been seconded. It's been
3 approved.

4 Shirley, if you would, read off
5 those that have been denied and those that
6 have been accepted.

7 MS. ROBINS:

8 The ones that were approved?

9 THE CHAIRMAN:

10 Approved.

11 MS. ROBINS:

12 Approve list: Carl McAlister,
13 Daniel Mitchell, Jeanette Fontenot, David
14 Vidrine, Marcus Wyatt, Damien Metoyer, Sr.,
15 Rudy Garcia, Darren Perio, Anthony Drain,
16 Devin Dykes, Erika Brooker, Marques Williams,
17 and Devan Roberts, and Joseph David, and Anton
18 Belei. That was all approved for regular.
19 And Anthony Green approved for regular.

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 And the ones that were denied.

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 Denied list John Lawrence, denied.
24 He need a new regular application. Michal
25 Dick, denied. Not enough experience. That

1 was all the denied. Only two.

2 THE CHAIRMAN:

3 And there was one for redoing his
4 application and resubmitting his application.

5 MS. ROBINS:

6 That was John Lawrence.

7 THE CHAIRMAN:

8 Next is committee reports. Awards.
9 Richard LeBouef.

10 MR. LeBOUEF:

11 Nothing at this time, Mr. Chairman.

12 THE CHAIRMAN:

13 Testing.

14 MS. ROBINS:

15 We had three tests today.

16 THE CHAIRMAN:

17 Three test, and did three pass?

18 MS. ROBINS:

19 Yes.

20 THE CHAIRMAN:

21 Continuing education. Donovan?

22 MR. DRISKILL:

23 We have 54 registered for the class.
24 That's about all I have.

25 THE CHAIRMAN:

1 Nominating committee. Donnie.

2 MR. COLONA:

3 Don't have nothing.

4 THE CHAIRMAN:

5 You don't have nothing?

6 MR. COLONA:

7 Don't have nothing.

8 THE CHAIRMAN:
