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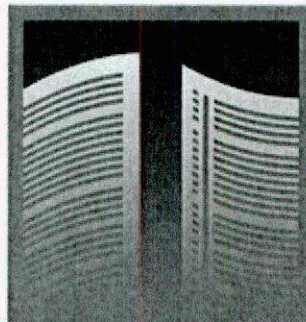



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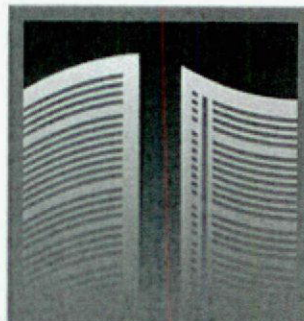

25 Okay. Any other discussion? I hear

1 none. The motion passed.

2 The next is a consideration of
3 operator certifications. First one is the
4 review applications for certification. We
5 have a long list. We're going one by one
6 with those.

7 So let's start with Brock Anderson.
8 He's applying for a C&D, Level B,
9 Temporary Level B certification. He works
10 at Ronaldson Field. He passed both exams
11 in December 9th, 2021. You have a chance
12 to review. You guys have any comments,
13 please speak up.

14 MR. WYNN: Are we going to make a
15 motion on each of one of these or are you
16 going to do --

17 MS. BORDELON: Let's -- yeah, let's
18 just go down the list; and then if anybody
19 has input, we'll do one motion at the end.

20 DR. ABREU: Yes, we can do that.

21 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

22 MR. WYNN: That will speed it up a
23 bit.

24 DR. ABREU: All right. We can do
25 that. All right. Second is David Barber,

1 Landfill, Level B, Choctaw Road Landfill.
2 If you or anyone has any comments, please
3 let me -- don't be shy. Speak up.

4 Okay. And I'm going to move to the
5 next one. Jean Bourg with Landfill,
6 Level A, the Harold J. "Babe" Landry
7 Landfill.

8 Okay. Next is Marcus Breaux,
9 Landfill, Level A, Vermilion Parish
10 Landfill. And he has Level B issued in
11 2016. He is applying now for a Level A.

12 Okay. Next is Milas Davidson,
13 Landfill, Level A, Union Parish Landfill.
14 He is -- he has held Level B since
15 October 2019.

16 Okay. Next is James Dickerson,
17 Transfer Station, Level A, Liquid
18 Environmental Solutions. He passed the
19 test March 2019, conditional denied due to
20 lack of experience.

21 MR. WYNN: He's got his time in now?

22 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

23 MR. WYNN: Okay.

24 DR. ABREU: He has been working with
25 Liquid Environmental Solutions since 2018,

1 October 2018, so he has the experience.

2 MR. WYNN: Okay.

3 DR. ABREU: Okay. Next is
4 Derrick Ducantel, Transfer Station,
5 Level B with Waste Connections.

6 Justin Echols is next, Landfill,
7 Level B with the Union Parish Landfill.

8 MR. WYNN: Did he pass his test?

9 MS. BORDELON: Justin?

10 MR. WYNN: Yeah.

11 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

12 DR. ABREU: Next is Steve Haik,
13 Incinerator, Level A with Med Geaux. He
14 was issued a Level B in December 2019.

15 Next is Antonio Harris, Transfer
16 Station, level -- what level?

17 MS. BORDELON: He is actually an A.

18 DR. ABREU: A? With Whited
19 Environmental.

20 Next is Ryan Henry. He is applying
21 for a Landfill, Level B with Vermilion
22 Parish Landfill.

23 Next is Jeremy Hines, Transfer
24 Station, Level A with Liquid Environmental
25 Solutions. He passed the test on

1 January 3, 2022.

2 Do we have any comments or questions
3 regarding any applications so far?

4 MR. CREEL: This one in particular,
5 there's no supervising employees anywhere.
6 Requesting a Level A, I think that's part
7 of the requirement.

8 DR. ABREU: That's for Jeremy Hines?

9 MR. CREEL: Oh, I see. It's on a
10 separate sheet. I don't see the sheet.

11 MS. BORDELON: They don't have to
12 supervise employees.

13 MR. CREEL: They don't?

14 MS. BORDELON: No. The only time they
15 have to supervise employees is if they're
16 substituting experience for Level Bs. If
17 they're substituting their construction
18 experience, that has to be in a
19 supervisory position.

20 MR. WYNN: Well, I just note it says
21 on his application he has not got a
22 supervisor signature.

23 MS. BORDELON: Oh. He -- I don't know
24 if it was on your copy, but he sent me
25 another copy later with a signature.

1 MR. WYNN: Okay.

2 MR. HYLTON: Does an A have to have
3 three years' experience?

4 MS. BORDELON: Yes.

5 MR. HYLTON: Well, I don't think he
6 made it yet.

7 MR. CREEL: That's right. He's not
8 there.

9 MS. BORDELON: All right. What did I
10 have -- let me see what I have on my
11 notes. Yeah, he'll have the three years
12 in June.

13 DR. ABREU: June?

14 MR. WYNN: Well, then on this one I
15 think we'd have to deny or either give him
16 a conditional until June.

17 MS. BORDELON: Or a B.

18 MR. WYNN: Yeah. We could give him a
19 B level and then in June automatically
20 redo his certification to an A level. Can
21 we do that?

22 MS. BORDELON: Yeah. He would just
23 have to pay for two certificates.

24 MR. WYNN: Right.

25 MS. BORDELON: He would have to pay

1 for a conditional now, and then he can get
2 the A in June. It can be issued in June.

3 MR. WYNN: Right, right.

4 MS. BORDELON: Or get a B now and he
5 can get the A whenever.

6 MR. WYNN: If I was him, I'd take the
7 B now and --

8 MS. BORDELON: Yeah, either way.

9 MR. WYNN: But after June he is
10 qualified to have an A level.

11 MS. BORDELON: You want to make that
12 motion?

13 MR. WYNN: Yes. I make that motion.

14 DR. ABREU: So I hear a motion from
15 Mr. Bubba Wynn to have Jeremy Hines to
16 receive a conditional --

17 MR. WYNN: No, a regular certification
18 B level right now.

19 DR. ABREU: No, no. I --

20 MR. WYNN: Would it have to be a
21 conditional?

22 MS. BORDELON: Well, would you
23 consider -- would y'all consider doing a
24 Conditional A? Because I believe he's the
25 only operator at this facility.

1 MR. WYNN: I would, yes, give him a
2 Conditional A until June and then June
3 automatically give him his regular
4 certifications.

5 DR. ABREU: Okay.

6 MR. HYLTON: Does a conditional have
7 to replace someone?

8 MR. WYNN: In this situation, I don't
9 think so since there's no other certified
10 operators there.

11 MR. HYLTON: Isn't the requirement to
12 be for a conditional you have to replace
13 someone?

14 MS. BORDELON: Well, it is -- it is in
15 the regulations; but then when we have
16 requests like this or, you know,
17 situations like this, then it's up to the
18 board's discretion to take them on a case
19 by case --

20 MR. HYLTON: Okay.

21 MS. BORDELON: -- depending on the
22 needs of the facility.

23 DR. ABREU: I just want to make a note
24 here that James Dickerson is also from
25 that facility, if I'm not mistaken. And

1 he is applying for a Level A.

2 MS. BORDELON: There's two
3 different -- there's two from Liquid
4 Environmental. I mean, there's two
5 facilities. They're different addresses.

6 DR. ABREU: Different facilities?

7 MS. BORDELON: I think they're
8 different facilities. I think the
9 addresses are different.

10 DR. ABREU: Okay.

11 MR. HYLTON: Well, if we can do that,
12 let's just give him a Conditional A now.

13 MS. BORDELON: That's what I'm saying.
14 Give him a conditional for three months or
15 less than three months.

16 DR. ABREU: So anyone want to make the
17 motion to give Mr. Jeremy Hines a Level A
18 conditional certification?

19 MR. WYNN: I make the motion.

20 DR. ABREU: Motion -- and then give
21 him a permanent Level A certification by
22 June 2022 as -- when he completes three
23 years' of experience?

24 MR. WYNN: That's right. I made that
25 motion.

1 DR. ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn.

2 MR. DRISKILL: I second it.

3 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Driskill.

4 Any comments? Okay. I hear none. The
5 motion passes.

6 So next is William Ladner, Landfill,
7 Level B with Choctaw Road Landfill.

8 Okay. Next is Preston Lemaire,
9 Landfill, Level C with Vermilion Parish
10 Landfill.

11 MR. WYNN: Were they asking for a
12 conditional?

13 MS. BORDELON: Did we skip
14 Joel Lejeune?

15 DR. ABREU: Who?

16 MS. BORDELON: Do y'all not have
17 Joel Lejeune?

18 MR. HYLTON: We don't have the
19 application. He's on the list, but I
20 never saw the application.

21 MR. WYNN: He tested last week.

22 MS. BORDELON: Okay. I'm sorry. We
23 have a Joel Lejeune is applying for a
24 Landfill, Level B at Republic Services.
25 He will have -- let's see -- two years at

1 that facility in July. Oversee day-to-day
2 operations, inspect loads coming in,
3 inspect landfill for faults and fix them,
4 make sure storm water is going out where
5 it needs to, maintain equipment, check for
6 erosion, gas leaks, recheck brakes, and
7 contain and fix the issues.

8 He also has previous employment at
9 Citgo R&R construction where he ran
10 equipment to make sure drainage was good
11 on site. He was a supervisor there from
12 2015 to 2020.

13 And then he had other employment at
14 Texas RDI Foundation & Drilling where he
15 had use of heavy equipment. He was also a
16 supervisor there from 2009 to 2015.

17 MR. HYLTON: He works at our facility.
18 I think he's qualified.

19 MS. BORDELON: Okay. Well, why didn't
20 you just say something?

21 MR. HYLTON: Since you were talking --

22 MR. WYNN: But the thing about it is
23 you say he does not have his time until
24 July?

25 MS. BORDELON: But he's got

1 construction experience to substitute.

2 MR. WYNN: Okay. Okay.

3 DR. ABREU: Okay. Does anyone want to
4 see the application?

5 MS. BORDELON: Yeah. Does anybody
6 want to see it?

7 MR. WYNN: No.

8 DR. ABREU: Next is John Lofton IV.

9 MR. WYNN: What happened to the other
10 one?

11 MS. BORDELON: Oh, yeah.
12 Preston Lemaire.

13 DR. ABREU: Preston Lemaire. I'm
14 sorry. He's applying to a Landfill,
15 Level C, Vermilion Parish Landfill.

16 MR. WYNN: Yeah, a Level C. And who
17 he is replacing for the B?

18 MS. BORDELON: He doesn't have to
19 replace anyone.

20 MR. WYNN: Just to get a Level C?
21 Okay. I think this is the first time I've
22 ever had a Level C. I didn't know it
23 existed.

24 MR. HYLTON: He's got the experience.
25 Why not a B?

1 MR. CREEL: That's what I was looking
2 at.

3 MS. BORDELON: Well, I didn't know.
4 He actually didn't even pass the Level C
5 test.

6 MR. HYLTON: It's immaterial.

7 MS. BORDELON: I know but --

8 MR. WYNN: Well, he should have said
9 that. Then we wouldn't have to vote.

10 MS. BORDELON: Well, y'all can still
11 approved his application because he can
12 always come back and test.

13 MR. WYNN: Okay.

14 MS. BORDELON: Then you don't have to
15 approve the application again.

16 MR. WYNN: There you go. Okay.

17 DR. ABREU: Okay. Any other comments
18 on him?

19 MR. WYNN: So this one will get his
20 certification -- once he comes back and
21 passes the test, he'll get a C level
22 certification?

23 MS. BORDELON: Right.

24 MR. WYNN: Okay.

25 DR. ABREU: Next is John Lofton IV,

1 Incinerator, Level B with Trilogy
2 MedWaste.

3 MR. LOFTON: Can I say something?

4 MS. BORDELON: Yes. This is
5 John Lofton that's actually here.

6 MR. WYNN: Yeah.

7 MR. LOFTON: It was supposed to be a
8 B.

9 MS. BORDELON: It is a B.

10 MR. LOFTON: Okay.

11 DR. ABREU: It is a B. I'm sorry.
12 Incinerator, Level B.

13 MS. BORDELON: Yeah, I think you did
14 say C. Yeah, it's a B.

15 DR. ABREU: I did say C? Yeah.

16 MS. BORDELON: It's a B.

17 DR. ABREU: Andrea Manuel, C&D, Level
18 B with Brandt Pederson Construction.

19 Next is Lynwood Martin, C&D, Level B,
20 Vernon Parish Police Jury.

21 Next is Robert Mayeaux with Transfer
22 Station, Level B, Waste Connections.

23 Next is Debra Rhodes with Transfer
24 Station, Level A with Omega Waste
25 Management. And she is retesting in lieu

1 of CEUs.

2 Next is John Roofner, C&D, Level B
3 with Moss Bluff Disposal. He previously
4 held a Level B, expired in 2020 but passed
5 the exam in February 9th, 2022.

6 MR. WYNN: Does he even need a
7 conditional now?

8 MS. BORDELON: John Roofner?

9 MR. WYNN: Yeah.

10 MS. BORDELON: He's not asking for a
11 conditional.

12 MR. WYNN: Well, I have a note here
13 "no need for conditional."

14 MR. HYLTON: Well, he checked the box.
15 **A lot of people do that.**

16 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

17 MR. WYNN: Okay. Okay.

18 DR. ABREU: Any other comments? Next
19 is Rodley Roy, Landfill, Level A, with
20 Vermilion Parish Landfill. He has a
21 Level B issued in 2016 and now is applying
22 for a Level A.

23 Okay. Next is Seth Rushing, Landfill,
24 Level B with Waste Connections.

25 All right. Next is

1 Heather Schamerhorn, C&D, Level B with
2 Schamerhorn C&D, previous Level B expired,
3 she will retest.

4 Next is Tammy Schamerhorn C&D, Level B
5 with Schamerhorn C&D. Also had a previous
6 Level B expired and now will retest.

7 Next is Wilmer Stewart, C&D, Level B,
8 Schamerhorn C&D.

9 MR. WYNN: They need to put somebody
10 in there to keep up with the hours, don't
11 they? But all three of these, once they
12 -- there's no need for them to come back
13 before the board or anything?

14 MS. BORDELON: Well, I'd like to put
15 that in the form of a motion for all of
16 these that are being approved that haven't
17 tested when we finish.

18 MR. WYNN: Okay. Okay.

19 DR. ABREU: Um-hum. Okay. Next is
20 James Vincent, C&D, Level A, with Brandt
21 Pederson Construction. Did I skip
22 someone?

23 MS. BORDELON: James Vincent is a
24 Level A.

25 DR. ABREU: C&D, Level A, yes. He has

1 a Level B issued July 2020. Now he is
2 applying for a Level A.

3 Next is Christian Warren, Landfill,
4 Level B with Choctaw Road Landfill.

5 Then we have Robert White, C&D,
6 Level A, Separation Level A, Ronaldson
7 Field, has held both certifications since
8 2000, both expired in 2020. He retested
9 on December 9th, 2021, and passed.

10 And lastly on my list is
11 Jamaal Williams, Landfill, Level B with
12 River Birch.

13 Okay. We went through all the lists.
14 Should I make a motion -- I ask someone to
15 make a motion to accept all the
16 applications for certification in the list
17 except the one that --

18 MS. BORDELON: James Hines.

19 DR. ABREU: Janes Hines.

20 MR. WYNN: I make the motion.

21 DR. ABREU: So I hear a motion from
22 Mr. Wynn.

23 MR. DRISKILL: I'll second it.

24 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Driskill.

25 Any comments?

1 MR. WYNN: Is this the time to do it?

2 MS. BORDELON: We can, yes.

3 MR. WYNN: I make a motion that all
4 the ones that have expired and have to
5 retest again to get their certifications
6 back, they do not have to come before the
7 board again. They're automatically issued
8 once they pass the test.

9 DR. ABREU: Okay. I hear a motion by
10 Mr. Wynn.

11 MR. CREEL: I'll second it.

12 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Creel.
13 Any comments? I hear none. The motion
14 passes.

15 Okay. Next in the list, in the agenda
16 list is review request for conditional
17 certification. Let's do the same thing.
18 Let's go through the list one by one.

19 So I have Jeremy Alexander,
20 Incinerator, Level B with Trilogy
21 MedWaste. He's replacing Heath Clark, and
22 he passed the exam on March 9th, 2022.

23 MR. WYNN: I do not have this showing;
24 but if you would, let us know if they're
25 trying to replace a conditional with a

1 conditional.

2 MS. BORDELON: I'll let you know that.

3 MR. WYNN: Okay.

4 MS. BORDELON: Well, we wouldn't allow
5 that so --

6 MR. WYNN: Well, I know it. That's
7 why I'm saying it.

8 MS. BORDELON: Okay. But, no, he's
9 replacing a regular operator.

10 MR. WYNN: Okay.

11 DR. ABREU: Next is Randall Bentz,
12 Landfill, Level B, Union Parish Landfill.

13 MS. BORDELON: Randall Bentz is
14 replacing -- where is it? -- oh,
15 Richard Phelps, who retired in December of
16 2021.

17 DR. ABREU: Next is Austin Bouligny,
18 Transfer Station, Level A with Liquid
19 Environmental Solutions, passed the exam
20 on February 9th, 2022.

21 MR. HYLTON: I don't see where he is
22 replacing anyone.

23 MS. BORDELON: Yeah, this one is not;
24 so he has a cover letter. Do y'all need
25 me to read the cover letter, Bubba?

1 MR. WYNN: Pardon?

2 MS. BORDELON: Do you need me to read
3 this cover letter? This guy is not
4 replacing anyone.

5 MR. WYNN: Yes.

6 MS. BORDELON: He's requesting a
7 conditional.

8 MR. CREEL: Mr. Bentz?

9 MS. BORDELON: No, this is
10 Austin Bouligny.

11 MR. WYNN: Yes, please read it.

12 MS. BORDELON: Okay. This is from his
13 supervisor. My name is James Dickerson.
14 I work for Liquid Environmental. I manage
15 a Type II A processing facility in Kenner.
16 I am writing you on behalf of Austin who
17 has been employed here since August of
18 2020. He's been recently promoted to lead
19 operator. Since he is not replacing or
20 succeeding a certified operator and does
21 not meet the work history requirements for
22 a certified operator, I'd like for your
23 approval to certify him as a conditional
24 operator Level A should he pass the exam.
25 In the event that I receive certification,

1 we need him to attain his certification so
2 we can meet the minimum certified
3 operators at this facility.

4 MR. WYNN: What is his time period
5 for --

6 MS. BORDELON: He's been there since
7 August of 2020, so about a year and a
8 half.

9 MR. WYNN: Okay. I would have to deny
10 this one until he gets his time in or
11 replaces another operator.

12 MR. CREEL: Is that a motion?

13 DR. ABREU: You want to make a motion?

14 MR. WYNN: I make that motion.

15 MR. CREEL: I second it.

16 DR. ABREU: I hear a motion by
17 Mr. Wynn to deny Austin Bouligny and
18 seconded by Mr. Creel. Any other
19 comments? Any other discussions? Hearing
20 none, the motion passes.

21 Next one is Jared Daigle, Incinerator,
22 Level B with Trilogy MedWaste. He is
23 replacing Steve Haik, passed the exam in
24 March 2022.

25 Okay. Next is James Holman, Landfill,

1 Level B with Sabine Parish Landfill. He
2 is replacing Janet Chreene. He would also
3 like for application to be approved for
4 regular certification upon passing the
5 exam and submittal of the certification
6 fee.

7 MS. BORDELON: Right, because he -- I
8 felt like he qualified for a regular
9 certification, but he couldn't be here to
10 test; so he was requesting a conditional
11 in the meantime until he is able to come
12 and test. And he would like to be issued
13 a regular.

14 MR. WYNN: As long as they pay the
15 fees for the conditional and the regular
16 certification.

17 MS. BORDELON: Correct. He's been at
18 Sabine Parish since April of 2019.

19 MR. WYNN: Okay.

20 DR. ABREU: Okay. And the last one on
21 the list is Terry Pleasant, Landfill,
22 Level B, Sabine Parish Landfill replacing
23 Mark Heater. Would also like for
24 application to be approved for a regular
25 certification upon passing the exam and

1 submittal of the certification fee.

2 MS. BORDELON: Same deal with this
3 one. He's been there since November of
4 2019 as the lead operator.

5 MR. HYLTON: But he does want
6 conditional?

7 MS. BORDELON: Yes, until he comes and
8 tests.

9 MR. HYLTON: This application -- well,
10 never mind.

11 MS. BORDELON: I know this is an old
12 application. Believe me, I've emailed
13 them another one so -- but people are
14 still using the old application.

15 MR. WYNN: But he is replacing
16 Janet Chreene?

17 MS. BORDELON: This one is replacing
18 Mark Heater. The previous one is
19 replacing Janet Chreene. You know she
20 passed away; right?

21 MR. WYNN: No, I did not know.

22 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

23 MR. WYNN: Pete's wife?

24 MS. BORDELON: Yeah. I'll tell you
25 later.

1 DR. ABREU: Okay. So first I'm going
2 to just have the ones -- ask for a motion
3 to approve the three ones that don't
4 require any testing: Jeremy Alexander,
5 Randall Bentz, and Jared Daigle. Do I
6 hear a motion to approve the application
7 for these three candidates, these three
8 applicants?

9 MR. DRISKILL: I'll make a motion.

10 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Driskill.
11 Do I hear a second?

12 MR. WYNN: Second.

13 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Wynn. Now
14 I want -- let's go over James Holman and
15 Terry Pleasant to give them a conditional
16 Level B certification and upon approval
17 from the test, issue a regular landfill
18 Level B certification for these two
19 applicants. Do I hear a motion?

20 MR. CREEL: I make a motion.

21 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Creel.
22 Second by? Mr. Hylton. Any discussion?
23 Any comments? Hearing none, the motion
24 passes.

25 Next, the review requests for

1 conditional certification extensions. I
2 have one here, Kyle Plouhar, Incinerator,
3 Level B with Medical Waste Management.
4 That's the first extension. Will have two
5 years at the facility in July.

6 MR. WYNN: I'll make a motion.

7 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Wynn to
8 approve the applicant. Do I hear a
9 second?

10 MR. DRISKILL: I'll second it.

11 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Creel.
12 Any discussion and comments?

13 MR. DRISKILL: I seconded it,
14 Driskill.

15 DR. ABREU: I'm sorry. It was not
16 seconded by Mr. Creel. It was seconded by
17 Mr. Driskill. I'm sorry about that. Any
18 discussion? Comments? Hearing none, the
19 motion passes?

20 Next on the agenda is the review
21 request from Bryant Whittington for
22 certification by reciprocity. He's
23 applying for a Landfill, Level A with
24 Waste Connections, Timberland Landfill.
25 He holds a Class A MSW operator

1 certificate from Texas TCEQ. And we have
2 a note here that we have issued reciprocal
3 certifications with Texas before.

4 MR. WYNN: I make a motion.

5 DR. ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn to
6 approve the application by
7 Mr. Bryant Whittington for Landfill,
8 Level A. Do I hear a second?

9 MR. CREEL: Second.

10 MR. HYLTON: Second. Oh, give it to
11 Jason.

12 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Creel and
13 Mr. Hylton. Okay?

14 MR. CREEL: Same thing so --

15 DR. ABREU: Any discussion? Hearing
16 none, the motion passes.

17 Okay. So now is the review
18 application for recertification. I don't
19 have a list.

20 MS. BORDELON: Okay. Here. You can
21 use mine.

22 DR. ABREU: So I have my list here.
23 I'm going to say the names. Sean Day,
24 C&D, Level A from Acadiana Landfill;
25 Jonathan Faulk, Landfill, Level B, Harold

1 J. "Babe" Landry Landfill;
2 Keith Frederick, Landfill, Level A,
3 Vermilion Parish Landfill; Justin Jones,
4 Landfill, Level A, Choctaw Landfill;
5 Malisa Laffitte, Landfill, Level A with
6 Mundy Landfill; Daria Ransome, C&D,
7 Level A Separation, Level A, with Gator
8 Environmental; Jess Schexnayder, Landfill,
9 Level B with Acadiana Parish Landfill;
10 Denny Smith, C&D, Level A, Separation
11 Level A with Mikeebo Landfill;
12 Chad Soileau, Landfill, Level A with River
13 Birch; and Chayland Trabeau, C&D, Level B,
14 with Gator Environmental.

15 And do I hear a motion to approve
16 recertification for all the names that I
17 just said?

18 MR. HYLTON: I move.

19 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Hylton. Do
20 I hear a second?

21 MR. WYNN: Second.

22 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Wynn. Any
23 comments or discussions? Hearing none,
24 the motion passes.

25 MS. BORDELON: So then we have

1 three -- we have just a few that have
2 30 hours and are intending to get their
3 last 10 hours at this conference this
4 week; so upon them submitting their
5 certification or upon me getting that --

6 DR. ABREU: They've attended --

7 MS. BORDELON: Yeah, that they did
8 attend this conference, that we can issue
9 their recertification upon confirmation of
10 their attendance at this conference.

11 DR. ABREU: Okay. I'll read the
12 names. Jessica Bonstaff, Paul Bordelon,
13 Ronald Buterbaugh, James Cortex,
14 Ronald Pellerin, and Jada Steib. Do I
15 hear a motion to approve the applications
16 upon completion of the 40 hours for this
17 conference?

18 MR. DRISKILL: I make a motion.

19 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Driskill.
20 Do I hear a second?

21 MR. WYNN: Second.

22 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Wynn. Any
23 discussion or comments? Hearing none, the
24 motion carries.

25 Okay. So next is the issue of

1 operator certificates. Want to go through
2 the list?

3 MS. BORDELON: Yes. Okay. These are
4 applications that have been approved
5 either at today's meeting or at a prior
6 meeting and those that have passed the
7 test either today or have come into the
8 office and taken the test and passed.

9 We have Brock Anderson, C&D, Level B
10 and Separation Level B; David Barber,
11 Level B, Landfill Level B; Jean Bourg,
12 Landfill, Level A; Milas Davidson,
13 Landfill, Level A; James Dickerson,
14 Transfer Station, Level A;
15 Derrick Duncantel, Transfer Station,
16 Level B; Justin Echols, Landfill, Level B;
17 Tracy Grant, C&D, Level B; Antonio Harris,
18 Transfer Station, Level A; Ryan Henry,
19 Landfill, Level B; Joel Lejeune, Landfill,
20 Level B; John Lofton IV, Incinerator,
21 Level B; Lynwood Martin, C&D, Level B;
22 Robert Mayeaux, Transfer Station, Level B;
23 Debra Rhodes, Transfer Station, Level A;
24 John Roofner, C&D, Level B; Seth Rushing,
25 Landfill, Level B; James Vincent, C&D,

1 Level A; Christian Warren, Landfill,
2 Level B; Robert White, C&D and Separation
3 Level A; Daniel Young, Separation Level B;
4 and Lewis Sanchez, Landfill, Level A.

5 DR. ABREU: Okay. Do I hear a motion
6 to issue the operator certification to all
7 these applicants that we just heard from
8 Ms. Bordelon?

9 MR. HYLTON: Question first?

10 DR. ABREU: Yes.

11 MR. HYLTON: A couple of these names
12 are not on the list.

13 MS. BORDELON: Right, because those
14 are the ones that had been approved at a
15 previous meeting.

16 MR. HYLTON: Okay.

17 MS. BORDELON: But they just tested
18 yesterday or Wednesday.

19 MR. HYLTON: Gotcha.

20 DR. ABREU: Do I hear a motion to
21 approve?

22 MR. HYLTON: I'll make the motion.

23 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Hylton.
24 Seconded? Seconded by Mr. Creel. Any
25 other discussion? Any comments? Hearing

1 none, the motion carries.

2 So the next agenda item is the
3 committee reports. I just have Mr. Hylton
4 here, so on awards?

5 MR. HYLTON: I'm here, and I know we
6 just gave out some awards. I don't know
7 how we got there, so someone else --

8 MS. BORDELON: The awards that were
9 given out during the luncheon yesterday
10 were for our operator of the year Level A
11 and Level B. Those nominations were sent
12 out in 2019 and the board had already
13 chosen those two recipients, so we
14 continued -- we went ahead with issuing
15 those awards at the conference yesterday.

16 So the awards, I guess, will continue
17 in 2023 with operator of the year from
18 2022.

19 DR. ABREU: Okay.

20 MS. BORDELON: And then we -- of
21 course, then every year we issue a Bently
22 Mackey Award. And off the top of my head,
23 I don't remember exactly what the criteria
24 is for that, but that one is voted on.

25 Those nominations are submitted just

1 by this board and voted on by this board;
2 whereas, the others are voted -- the
3 nominations come from any certified
4 operator can nominate a Level A or a
5 Level B.

6 DR. ABREU: Okay. Thank you,
7 Ms. Bordelon. I don't have Bubba here or
8 Connie or David Greene, so I'm going to
9 defer to the next --

10 MS. BORDELON: Hold on. I can tell
11 you that. I was counting right now.

12 DR. ABREU: Oh, okay.

13 MS. BORDELON: So testing, we had 30
14 -- I had probably about 25 that tested on
15 Wednesday; but since we met last, we've
16 had -- I've had 36 total tests. And on
17 Wednesday we had 6 fail, 6 of those.

18 DR. ABREU: Okay. All right. So
19 let's go to the next item of the agenda --
20 oh, no. Just -- just in time.

21 MR. WYNN: Testing?

22 DR. ABREU: Yeah.

23 MS. BORDELON: I took care of it,
24 Bubba.

25 MR. WYNN: Thank you.

1 DR. ABREU: Any comments, Mr. Wynn, on
2 the testing other than what Suzanne just
3 told us?

4 MR. WYNN: No, but I think it was a
5 remarkable amount of people testing.

6 DR. ABREU: Um-hum, yes. I have a
7 question for the board with regard to
8 testing since we're talking about that. I
9 had the comment yesterday asking me why we
10 have to retest people that let expired the
11 certification. Any reason for that we
12 should still --

13 MR. WYNN: It's in the regulations.

14 DR. ABREU: The regulations?

15 MR. HYLTON: Yeah. I had one for
16 20 years and forgot to renew it, and I had
17 retest.

18 DR. ABREU: Right. But if you could
19 change the regulations on that, why would
20 we retest someone that already had the
21 testing on it?

22 MR. WYNN: Well, you would have to go
23 back through the State to have that
24 changed.

25 DR. ABREU: That's correct, but what

1 would be the reason that we'd keep that?

2 MS. BORDELON: What would be an
3 alternative in lieu of testing again?
4 Like, could they pay a penalty, an
5 additional penalty instead of them having
6 to retest?

7 MR. WYNN: No, but the board's going
8 to have to follow what the regulations
9 says.

10 MS. BORDELON: I know, but he's saying
11 if any event that we could change the
12 rules.

13 DR. ABREU: The regulation.

14 MR. WYNN: You know, I'd be for that
15 if you could get it changed through the
16 legislature.

17 DR. ABREU: Because I see the other
18 professional boards like, for example,
19 engineering, if I test once, even if I
20 have let it expire, I don't need to retest
21 again.

22 MR. WYNN: Right.

23 DR. ABREU: And I think the testing is
24 just to see the person is qualified for
25 that position. After the person passes

1 the test, I think that he's qualified for
2 life except that he still has to do the
3 CEUs.

4 MR. WYNN: Right.

5 DR. ABREU: So I don't see really an
6 advantage of having the person retest and
7 go through that burden again if we deem
8 that he was qualified by the testing, you
9 know.

10 MR. WYNN: Well, I definitely agree;
11 but like I said, you'd have to go through
12 the legislature. And I would not even
13 know who I would have to talk to to do
14 that.

15 DR. ABREU: Yes.

16 MR. HYLTON: A politician to get it
17 started.

18 MR. WYNN: Well, we happen to have
19 one. Rodney Schamerhorn is in there, and
20 I'm sure that he would love to bring that
21 up.

22 MS. BORDELON: Oh, I'm sure he would.

23 MR. HYLTON: He likes to talk. The
24 only comment I have is that you put a time
25 frame on it like if -- you know, if you're

1 a year late, well, you're just late. If
2 you let it expire for ten years and go
3 work somewhere else in a different
4 industry and come back, should you take it
5 again or?

6 MR. WYNN: Well, you know, you're
7 really right. I agree with that. I think
8 it should be a time period that you could
9 do it.

10 MR. HYLTON: I agree.

11 MR. WYNN: Say within a year if you
12 pay a fine and/or a penalty within that
13 year, but then after that year you're
14 going to come back to take a test.

15 DR. ABREU: But what would the reason
16 to take the test again if you already --
17 I'm just throwing it out there just for
18 discussion's sake.

19 MR. HYLTON: Technology advances and,
20 you know, this business is different than
21 what it used to be.

22 MR. DRISKILL: It could change daily
23 it seems like, you know.

24 MR. WYNN: Right.

25 MS. BORDELON: That's true.

1 MR. WYNN: But here's another thing:
2 If you know you'd have to come back and
3 take the test, you'd make sure to pay the
4 fine.

5 MR. DRISKILL: Yeah.

6 MS. BORDELON: Or stay on top of it.

7 DR. ABREU: Well, this is something
8 for you guys to think, for everybody to
9 think. We can go back and discuss that.
10 If you think -- if we think that is
11 adequate to change, we can go through that
12 process, of course.

13 And if we do that, I would like to
14 take the opportunity also to -- for
15 everybody in this board to take a reading
16 of the regulations, anything that we
17 wanted to change we would do at once. We
18 think that's -- that you like to see that
19 the way be done differently, I know.

20 MS. BORDELON: Yeah. I know I would
21 be involved; but I think one thing that
22 definitely would be need to be taken a
23 look at is the conditional certifications.

24 DR. ABREU: Yes.

25 MR. WYNN: Right. More on a

1 base-to-base issue.

2 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

3 MR. HYLTON: That's kind of what we're
4 doing now. You regulate one thing --

5 MS. BORDELON: We need something -- we
6 need something --

7 DR. ABREU: Different?

8 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

9 DR. ABREU: More structure.

10 MR. WYNN: Something to give the board
11 more of --

12 MR. HYLTON: More leeway or authority
13 or something?

14 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

15 MR. HYLTON: Because we just -- right
16 now we just change it.

17 DR. ABREU: So, yeah, let's have more
18 discussion on that; but if you don't mind,
19 go through the regulations maybe before
20 the next meeting. We can talk again on
21 things that we can change to make it
22 better, easier, not for us but for the
23 applicants and operators too, you know.

24 MR. WYNN: Well, one thing that I
25 would not change, though, is you will not

1 put a request for a conditional to replace
2 a conditional. I will not do that.

3 MS. BORDELON: No.

4 DR. ABREU: Um-hum. Like I said, we
5 can discuss before the previous meeting
6 then and make it -- if everyone agrees
7 with that, we can start to work on that as
8 well, make everybody's life better.

9 MR. WYNN: There you go.

10 DR. ABREU: Okay. So I just think I
11 started already other business, but anyone
12 has --

13 MS. BORDELON: Yes, actually, I do.
14 So everybody knows in two weeks I'll be
15 retiring. So right now we're not -- I'm
16 not sure what exactly is going to take
17 place at the department. Right now it's
18 in the works for Kristin -- I want
19 everybody to meet Kristin East.

20 Kristin is set to take my place so
21 she's here just kind of shadowing today
22 just to see how things are run. So
23 Kristin will be your contact for now.

24 DR. ABREU: Um-hum.

25 MS. BORDELON: And then also we have

1 our newest ex-officio member, Rob, who
2 took Mia's place since Mia retired in
3 January. Rob Thomas is the manager of the
4 waste permits division and works under
5 Yolanda.

6 MR. THOMAS: Happy to be here.

7 MR. WYNN: I'm glad to see you. I'm
8 really glad to see you.

9 DR. ABREU: Yes.

10 MS. BORDELON: And, also, as we've
11 done in the past with all new board
12 members, we issue all classes of
13 certifications to our newest board member.

14 DR. ABREU: Um-hum.

15 MS. BORDELON: So we'd like to do that
16 for Rob as well.

17 MR. WYNN: But does she know to make
18 sure to keep up with our hours too?

19 MS. BORDELON: Yeah, they're in my
20 notes. So I have a list we can go down so
21 we can -- I want to -- so we can issue all
22 the classes and levels -- or classes of
23 certifications at Level A to Rob Thomas.

24 MR. WYNN: I make the motion.

25 DR. ABREU: I hear a motion by

1 Mr. Wynn. Seconded by Mr. Creel. Any

2 questions or comments or discussion?

3 Hearing none, the motion carries.

4 Congratulations, Mr. Thomas.

5 MR. THOMAS: Thank you.

6 DR. ABREU: Okay. Any other business?

7 MR. HYLTON: I would like to thank
8 Suzanne for keeping us out of trouble for
9 all these years. You've done a great job.

10 MS. BORDELON: Thank you.

11 MR. WYNN: For many years.

12 MR. DRISKILL: Yeah.

13 DR. ABREU: As chairman I would like
14 to commend your work as being fantastic.

15 MS. BORDELON: Thank you.

16 DR. ABREU: I mean, I can't imagine a
17 person doing better, you know. And I
18 really enjoy this time. I think I speak
19 for all the board that you've been -- if
20 you were not here, I don't know how we're
21 going to do this, go through this. Thank
22 you so much.

23 MS. BORDELON: You're welcome.

24 DR. ABREU: I would like to welcome
25 you.

1 MS. BORDELON: Kristin.

2 DR. ABREU: And welcome Rob Thomas.

3 If any of you need anything, please don't
4 hesitate to call me or contact me. I would
5 like that. If you don't have my email
6 address and my phone number, I would like
7 to give it to both of you. Okay?

8 MR. THOMAS: Sure. On behalf of the
9 department, I'd like to thank Suzanne too.
10 I mean, you know, probably been
11 under-appreciated, all the work that
12 you've, you know, you've done. There's a
13 lot of folks in the department that have
14 no idea. It's a lot -- a lot of work.
15 And everyone appreciates -- I appreciate
16 you. I've been knowing you, all these
17 years. And I just wanted to thank you and
18 I don't know who could have done a better
19 job than Suzanne has done.

20 MS. BORDELON: Well, thanks.

21 MR. WYNN: So you got a lot of shoes
22 to fill; right?

23 MS. EAST: Yes, sir.

24 MR. THOMAS: Welcome, Kristin. I work
25 with Kristin. She is really sharp and

1 happy to see you here. And, you know, it
2 may be some other folks involved to help
3 as I understand but --

4 MS. BORDELON: Yeah.

5 MS. EAST: I'll do my best.

6 DR. ABREU: All right. Any other
7 business? Okay.

8 MR. DRISKILL: I would like to keep
9 this right here like that. I'm over Beau.

10 MS. BORDELON: Yeah. Did you get a
11 picture of that?

12 MR. DRISKILL: Yeah, I did.

13 MS. BORDELON: Take a picture.

14 DR. ABREU: Public comments? We don't
15 have anyone from the public; so I'd like
16 to hear a motion to adjourn this meeting.

17 MR. WYNN: Make the motion.

18 DR. ABREU: Motion by Mr. Wynn.
19 Second?

20 MR. DRISKILL: Second.


21 DR. ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Driskill.
22 Thank you everybody. The meeting is
23 adjourned.
