All right. Review of the minutes.

3 MR. LEBOUF:
4 I'll second that, sir.
5 MR. WYNN:
6 Nickey Poirier.
7 MR. LEBOUF:
8 I'll make the motion, accept.
9 MR. BRANCAMP:
10 I second.
11 MR. WYNN:
12 Curtis Bradley Roller.
13 MR. DRISKILL:
14 I move we accept.
15 MR. BRANCAMP:
16 I'll ~~second.~~
17 MR. LEBOUF:
18 I have a question.
19 MR. WYNN:
20 Yes.
21 MR. LEBOUF:
22 8/20. Oh, hang on. 8/20 -- 8/20 -- my
23 apologies. 8/21 -- oh, I'm sorry. My apologies. The issue
24 -- it's B -- but yeah, my apologies. I got the dates wrong.
25 MR. WYNN:

1 Any other questions? He's been approved
2 and accepted. Clatter Polidore.

3 MS. ROBINS:

4 He does need the test.

5 MR. LEBOUF:

6 And he's asking for -- for condition.

7 Am I correct?

8 MS. ROBINS:

9 Yes.

10 MR. LEBOUF:

11 Yeah, I'll make that motion.

12 MR. WYNN:

13 Who is he replacing?

14 MR. DRISKILL:

15 Me.

18 MR. LEBOUF:

19 Mr. Driskill was taking offense, sir.

20 MR. BRANCAMP:

21 I'll second.

22 MR. WYNN:

23 All right. He's approved. As far as
24 his certification, it will not be given to
25 him till he passes the test. Tyler Cline?

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MS. ROBINS:

Same thing. He needs to test.

MR. WYNN:

Do we approve that case --

MR. DRISKILL:

Not questioning his experience --

MR. LEBOUF:

Yeah, that's where I'm at right now with it, Donovan. 23 to 24. I -- I -- I -- everything stands as is -- either employment -- 23.

MR. DRISKILL:

Yeah.

MR. LEBOUF:

Concrete crushing.

MR. DRISKILL:

Yeah.

MR. LEBOUF:

I make a motion we deny.

MR. WYNN:

Well, I -- here -- here's one thing is you, look at his seven-year experience that he's got listed. He operated excavator loading, concrete crushers, and separated chain concrete. He -- he does have some construction experience, but it's not anything to do with

1 grading and stuff like that.

2 MR. DRISKILL:

3 Yeah.

4 MR. WYNN:

5 So his application has been denied
6 because of the experience.

7 MR. COLONA:

8 Unless he applies for a conditional
9 until he gets there.

10 MR. LEBOUF:

11 Correct.

12 MR. WYNN:

13 Yes. But it -- would he be replacing
14 somebody? That's something you need to find out. It has
15 been denied because of the experience, but now he could get
16 a conditional if he was replacing another operator.

17 MS. ROBINS:

18 And if he's not replacing another
19 operator?

20 MR. WYNN:

21 He's just going to have to wait until he
22 gets his experience.

23 MS. ROBINS:

24 Okay. So I need to call him. Okay.

25 MR. WYNN:

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Gary D. Jackson.

MR. LEBOUF:

Everything looks good. I'll make that motion, sir.

MR. DRISKILL:

I'll second it.

MR. WYNN:

Renee R. LeGleu -- LeGleu.

MS. ROBINS:

LeGleu.

MR. WYNN:

LeGleu.

MR. DRISKILL:

I make that motion.

MR. LEBOUF:

Yeah, I'll second that, sir.

MR. WYNN:

All right. That's the applications being reviewed except for request for conditional certification. And that would be Jimmy S. Williams?

MR. LEBOUF:

Which one's that?

MR. WYNN:

Jimmy Williams.

MR. LEBOUF:

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Okay.

MR. WYNN:

Was he replacing somebody?

MS. ROBINS:

No. I think -- he put on here -- he --
oh, I -- he's a new -- it's a new site, so he's not
replacing anyone.

MR. WYNN:

But he's -- he's needing it for the --

MS. ROBINS:

The new site.

MR. WYNN:

-- the new site.

MS. ROBINS:

Uh-huh. Yeah.

MR. WYNN:

To be in compliance.

MS. ROBINS:

Yes.

MR. WYNN:

Did y'all understand that? Do I have a
motion?

MR. LEBOUF:

Yes. I'll make that motion.

MR. DRISKILL:

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I second.

MR. LEBOUF:

Just on the basis of, because it's a new site, correct?

MR. WYNN:

Correct.

MS. ROBINS:

Uh-huh. Approved conditional?

MR. WYNN:

Yes.

MS. ROBINS:

Okay.

MR. DRISKILL:

All right. The next one is request for certification by reciprocity. Kano Canute ~~Galindo~~ Galindo. I guess that's how you pronounce it. He has taken the MOLO test and that's about as hard as you get.

MR. DRISKILL:

Yeah. I move we approve.

UNKNOWN SPEAKER:

Yeah.

MR. LEBOUF:

I second that, sir.

MR. WYNN:

1 All right. So if you would, all the
2 applications for certification have been
3 approved except for one. Now, let's go to
4 the recertifications. Boy, there was a
5 bunch of them too. All right. The
6 recertifications. I'll tell you what I'll
7 do is, I'll just go through and name them and
8 if there's any discussion on any of them,
9 Shirley can let us know if they've got all
10 the hours and we'll just approve them all at
11 the end of it: Peggy L. Manuel, Jonathan
12 Fourrier, Susan E. Elmer, Timothy L.
13 Merriman, Christopher G. Wooton, Dennis
14 Gibson, Joseph Richard, Larry C. Musgrove,
15 Johnna Cortes, Jeffrey Stallion, David Mason,
16 Damian Patterson, and Peggy L. Loss or Ross.
17 Have all of these got their hours?

18 MS. ROBINS:

19 Yes.

20 MR. WYNN:

21 And --

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 Yes. Everyone you just named have the
24 hours.

25 MR. WYNN:

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Okay. And they've all paid for the recertification?

MR. LEBOUF:

Yes. I make that motion, sir.

MR. DRISKILL:

I'll second.

MR. WYNN:

All right. The incomplete recertification applications. Nature Frycka. She lacks 10 hours of credit. When was the last class she went to, or is she attending this class to get her 10 hours?

MS. ROBINS:

Can't remember if she told me she was coming to this one, but the last one she did attend was ~~July of~~ last year. July of '24.

MR. WYNN:

Okay.

MS. ROBINS:

2024.

MR. WYNN:

So what is the period of time we got before -- is it a -- a three-month period or a six-month period, you remember?

MR. DRISKILL:

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Think it's six months.

MR. LEBOUF:

She's got 23 missing, correct?

MS. ROBINS:

She got 10 --

MR. WYNN:

She's got 10 hours.

MS. ROBINS:

-- she got 10 hours missing.

MR. LEBOUF:

Yeah. The year '23 is what I'm saying. Her year '23, she has missing.

MS. ROBINS:

Oh, yes.

MR. LEBOUF:

'21, ~~'23,~~ '24.

MS. ROBINS:

She has '23 missing. 2023.

MR. COLONA:

We don't know if she's here -- to this -- tomorrow.

MS. ROBINS:

No.

MS. MEYERS:

(Inaudible) can ask Connie if she

1 registered --

2 MR. LEBOUF:

3 We just could make (crosstalk) --

4 MS. ROBINS:

5 Yeah. I can ask afterwards, but for
6 right now, I can find out.

7 MR. WYNN:

8 Well, until we find out later, do we
9 need to deny -- deny?

10 MR. DRISKILL:

11 Denied.

12 MR. LEBOUF:

13 That's what I say if you -- 10 I was
14 missing.

15 MR. DRISKILL:

16 Can we maybe --

17 MS. MEYERS:

18 Ask Connie?

19 MR. WYNN:

20 She -- she still would have six months
21 to be able to submit continuing education
22 that one?

23 MR. DRISKILL:

24 License expired in November.

25 MR. LEBOUF:

1 Yeah. It expired November.

2 MR. WYNN:

3 Oh, it expired in November?

4 MR. DRISKILL:

5 It expired in November of last year.

6 MR. WYNN:

7 Okay.

8 MS. ROBINS:

9 Okay.

10 MR. WYNN:

LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY BOARD MEETING

11 Well, she would have to retest.

12 MS. ROBINS:

13 Okay.

14 MR. LEBOUF:

15 She paid \$200 on the late -- late

16 recertification.

17 MS. ROBINS:

18 Mm-hmm

19 MR. LEBOUF:

20 Is that -- is that within that six-month

21 window, right?

22 MS. ROBINS:

23 Yes.

24 MR. WYNN:

25 If she would be here to this.

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MS. ROBINS:

Yes. If she -- if she's at this conference, yes.

MR. WYNN:

So do we have a motion?

MR. LEBOUF:

And the motion would be for what?

MR. WYNN:

To give her -- her recertification if she attends this conference.

MR. LEBOUF:

Right. I'll make that motion.

Absolutely.

MR. DRISKILL:

I'll second that.

MR. LEBOUF:

Correct. Yes, sir.

MS. ROBINS:

And if she's not?

MR. WYNN:

Then she'll have to retest.

MR. DRISKILL:

She has to retest.

MR. WYNN:

Patricia Richard, you say -- I'm

1 pronouncing that right?

2 --

3 MR. LEBOUF:

4 I must say.

5 MS. ROBINS:

6 Ms. Richard did say she will be
7 attending this conference?

8 MR. DRISKILL:

9 But she has four.

10 MR. LEBOUF:

LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY BOARD MEETING

11 She has four.

12 MS. ROBINS:

13 Yeah, she has four. But her --

14 MR. LEBOUF:

15 The last one was in March.

16 MS. ROBINS:

17 Yeah. One of the first one was before
18 her certification.

19 MR. WYNN:

20 Was she on conditional?

21 MS. ROBINS:

22 No.

23 MR. LEBOUF:

24 Yeah, she had '21, '22, '23.

25 MS. ROBINS:

1 I think that '21 came at -- before her
2 certificate started.

3 MR. DRISKILL:

4 It was issued on May 18th. Okay, I can
5 see.

6 MR. WYNN:

7 But she is --

8 MR. LEBOUF:

9 It doesn't say -- I'm sorry.

10 MR. WYNN:

LOUISIANA DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY BOARD MEMBERS

11 -- She is going to be at this meeting?

12 MS. ROBINS:

13 Yeah, that's what she told me. Yeah.

14 MR. LEBOUF:

15 Her --

16 MS. ROBINS:

17 I made a note to that.

18 MR. LEBOUF:

19 -- Her certification B was issued May
20 18th of '21. Certificate number 2276.

21 MR. DRISKILL:

22 Okay. But her first -- what she's
23 saying is that her certificate of attendance
24 is from the 12th day of --

25 MR. LEBOUF:

1 Okay. I got you.

2 MS. ROBINS:

3 Yeah. It was before.

4 MR. DRISKILL:

5 So it's before she had her license.

6 MS. ROBINS:

7 Uh-huh.

8 MR. LEBOUF:

9 All right. So technically she's staying
10 out short.

11 MR. DRISKILL:

12 Yes.

13 MS. ROBINS:

14 Yes.

15 MR. LEBOUF:

16 All right. I'll make the same motion we
17 get the last one, Mr. Chair.

18 MR. DRISKILL:

19 I'll second that.

20 MR. LEBOUF:

21 Provided she's here.

22 MR. WYNN:

23 Right.

24 MR. LEBOUF:

25 If not, denied.

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MR. WYNN:

Any other comments?

MS. ROBINS:

That's all.

MR. WYNN:

All right. Review for CEU courses for recertification application. Ashly Whitney?

MS. ROBINS:

Hers was -- she had SWANA and she -- no, his, I'm sorry, is a he -- he had SWANA and he wanted to know what did that count towards his hours he was missing. He was missing 20 hours.

MR. WYNN:

What was the classes in?

MS. ROBINS:

They didn't put --

MR. LEBOUF:

But -- I don't mean to interrupt, Ms. Shirley, but she's asked 22 missing that SWANA was in 25.

MR. WYNN:

Yeah, but the top SWANA was 20 hours certification. And I don't know if you meant to send it, but you sent something and it

1 turned out to be a book.

2 MS. ROBINS:

3 That was with the reciprocity.

4 MR. DRISKILL:

5 Yeah.

6 MS. ROBINS:

7 Oh, okay. That was his -- his -- the --
8 the thread.

9 MR. WYNN:

10 I was printing that off and that printer
11 kept going.

12 MS. ROBINS:

13 Yes. Well, I didn't expect y'all to
14 print that. I just wanted to send it with
15 the reciprocity application.

16 MR. LEBOUF

17 We killed the tree when that thing
18 started off.

19 MS. ROBINS:

20 I'm sorry.

21 MR. LEBOUF:

22 I love it.

23 MS. ROBINS:

24 Because I know they're supposed to turn
25 it in with the application.

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MR. WYNN:

Okay. If -- of -- so you -- you don't know what the classes were --

MS. ROBINS:

No, not --

MR. WYNN:

-- that was taken?

MS. ROBINS:

Let's see.

MS. MEYERS:

That's --

MS. ROBINS:

That's the courses.

MR. LEBOUF:

Yeah, she --

MS. MEYERS:

That's what they are asking.

MS. ROBINS:

Oh, my bad. So I don't --

MS. MEYERS:

Not sure.

MS. ROBINS: It should be attached to y'all appli -- his application. So, I guess, if I'm looking at it right, the date, October 15, 2024? That's the right --

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MR. LEBOUF:

Which one? Ashly?

MS. ROBINS:

Yes. Ashly. That's when it started.
The first date.

MR. WYNN:

But it lists all the classes.

MS. ROBINS:

Yes.

MR. LEBOUF:

Right.

MS. ROBINS:

October 15th, 16th, 17th. This is for
-- he had more courses he completed in March
of '24, and then he went back to October of
'23.

MR. LEBOUF:

Right.

MS. ROBINS:

Yeah. And then April of '23, that's
October. Yeah.

MR. DRISKILL:

He's also MOLO certified.

MR. LEBOUF:

Right.

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MS. ROBINS:

What?

MR. LEBOUF:

MOLO certified.

MS. ROBINS:

Oh.

MR. WYNN:

Do I have a recommendation?

MR. DRISKILL:

I move we approve.

MR. LEBOUF:

I second that.

MR. WYNN:

So we -- we approve the SWANA courses
that he has taken?

MR. LEBOUF:

Right.

MR. WYNN:

And he can use that for his CEUs --

MS. ROBINS:

Okay.

MR. WYNN:

-- for his certification.

MS. ROBINS:

So he's approved?

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MR. WYNN:

He is approved. So do we -- do I have a motion for the issuance of the operator certification?

MR. LEBOUF:

I move.

MR. DRISKILL:

But for the note, the Francesco-whatever is not registered.

MR. WYNN:

What?

MR. COLONA:

County said the (inaudible) --

MR. WYNN:

Yeah.

MR. COLONA:

-- is not registered.

MR. WYNN:

Okay. So if -- if she's not registered, she -- she'll --

MR. COLONA:

She'll have to retest.

MR. WYNN:

Yeah, she'll have to retest. Yeah.

MS. ROBINS:

1 Nature is not registered? Okay.
2 MR. LEBOUCEF:
3 Not registered.
4 MS. ROBINS:
5 So she's denied. Needs to retest.
6 MR. WYNN:
7 If she does happen to register tomorrow,
8 you just need to let us know.
9 MS. ROBINS:
10 Okay. I'll check with Connie.
11 MR. WYNN:
12 All right. The committee reports. Did
13 we have a motion and a second on the issuance
14 of the operator certification?
15 MR. DRISKILL:
16 I second it.
17 MR. WYNN:
18 Okay. All right. Committee
19 Reports/Awards, Richard LeBouef -- LeBouef.
20 MR. LEBOUCEF:
21 Yes, sir.
22 MR. WYNN:
23 LeBouef.
24 MR. LEBOUCEF:
25 All right. On the -- let me see what I

1 got over here. We should put that. All
2 right. The award winners are as follows: On
3 the Level Eight, operator is going to be
4 Ms. Tammy O'Neil; Level B be Ms. Angel
5 Darley; and 2024, Bentley MacKey.

6 MR. WYNN:

7 Mackey.

8 MS. ROBINS:

9 Mackey.

10 MR. LEBOUUEF:

11 I'm sorry. Thank -- thank you for
12 putting that out there -- left
13 field there. Appreciate that.

14 MR. WYNN:

15 That's some hard Louisiana --

16 MR. LEBOUUEF:

17 Is going to be Mr. Henry Bo LeBonj(ph).

18 MR. WYNN:

19 Yeah.

20 MR. LEBOUUEF:

21 All right. And I'm trying to find one
22 that she just sent on the other two. Lord
23 have mercy. iPad is such a wonderful thing.
24 And, I guess, you ain't coming back to me on
25 that one, right? Hey, I'm sorry, I'm trying.

1 I just got a update from the governor.

2 MS. ROBINS:

3 What?

4 MR. WYNN:

5 We've got two more awards to make.

6 MS. ROBINS:

7 Oh, okay.

8 MR. LEBOUF:

9 She -- and she -- that she just sent i
10 to me. I'd be doing it if I could find it.

11 I'm sorry.

12 MS. ROBINS:

13 No, that's nice. He just named the one
14 by.

15 MR. WYNN:

16 Oh, never mind. LSWA does that.

17 MS. ROBINS:

18 Yeah, I'm --

19 MR. LEBOUF:

20 Okay. Good.

21 MR. WYNN:

22 Board does not do that. You'll just
23 present them at the same time.

24 MR. LEBOUF:

25 That's all I have, ladies and gentlemen.

1 Yeah, I've got to do all those together. But
2 anyhow, yeah. So what is --
3 that's all happened, Mr. Chairman. Thank
4 you.

5 MR. WYNN:

6 Okay. Testing, I will ask Shirley, if
7 she would, to let us know how many was
8 tested.

9 MS. ROBINS:

10 You have five tests and five passed.
11 All of them passed.

12 MR. WYNN:

13 That's good. Continuing education.
14 Donovan?

15 MR. DRISKILL:

16 We got ~~this~~ conference. Sorry. We had
17 this conference. Here it is, lovely
18 conference.

19 MR. LEBOUF:

20 Oh, my God. Amazing.

21 MR. WYNN:

22 Nominating. Donnie?

23 MR. COLONA:

24 I don't know. Have we found anybody
25 yet? I -- I don't have --

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MR. WYNN:

As far as the LMA and all that? Yes, we have. We -- and they have been submitted.

MR. DRISKILL:

Waiting on (inaudible) -- yeah, approval.

MR. WYNN:

No, we're just waiting on approval. Just like John Fourier. I mean, he -- he hasn't been approved yet and his was sent in in October.

MR. BRANCAMP:

October. Right. He -- I mean, he was at the November meeting with us.

MR. WYNN:

Right.

MR. BRANCAMP:

That's correct.

MS. ROBINS:

And we only have one from that was submitted form LMA. Remember the other two we discussed that they didn't --

MR. WYNN:

Well, no, but there's been two more nominated, also, that the --

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MS. ROBINS:

I didn't get that one.

MR. WYNN:

-- what's his name? The mayor?

MR. DRISKILL:

My mayor?

MR. WYNN:

No, the other mayor.

MR. DRISKILL:

Oh, Rick Allen.

MR. WYNN:

Yeah, Rick Allen.

MS. ROBINS:

Oh, well, that's the person we --

MR. WYNN:

No, ~~but he~~ submitted two more. He might have sent them to his office.

MS. ROBINS:

Oh, Allen is the -- the president, right?

MR. WYNN:

Yes.

MS. ROBINS:

The president.

MR. WYNN:

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Yes.

MS. ROBINS:

I only got one. Yeah, we only have one.

MR. WYNN:

I guess we need to check back.

MS. ROBINS:

Yeah.

MS. MEYERS:

Darryl Pratt --

MR. WYNN:

Yeah.

MS. MEYERS:

-- is the only one we have.

MR. WYNN:

Yeah, well there's two more that's been submitted also.

MS. ROBINS:

Okay. Yeah. We don't have that one.

MR. DRISKILL:

Supposedly.

MR. WYNN:

Yeah. And Mr. Bogaline(ph) happens to be one of them --

MS. ROBINS:

Okay.

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MR. WYNN:

The mayor from --

MR. DRISKILL:

Sunset.

MR. WYNN:

-- Sunset.

MS. ROBINS:

Okay. Don't have it.

MS. ROBINS:

And you don't know the other name?

MR. WYNN:

No, not right offhand.

MR. COLONA:

All right.

MR. DRISKILL:

What's his last name?

MR. WYNN:

Bogaline?

MR. LEBOUF:

Close but no cigar.

MR. WYNN:

Bobaline. All right. Any other business? There is one thing that I would like to bring up: Next year when we do these awards and send them out for all the

1 operators to vote on somebody, we are going
2 to change the date from November to February.

3 MS. ROBINS:

4 Okay.

5 MR. WYNN:

6 February 14th. Valentine's day sounds
7 good to me. But that way because right
8 after, you know, the holidays coming up and
9 everything, nobody's thinking about it. And
10 then we get to tend to forget --

11 MS. ROBINS:

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
