1 DR. DE ABREU: The meeting of the Board of
2 Certification Training for Solid Waste Management
3 will come to order date of November 6th, 2024 and
4 this 9:04 AM. Ms. Robin. Can we have the roll
5 call please?
6 MS. ROBINS: Good morning. We have Mr. Ricardo De
7 Abreau.
8 DR. DE ABREU: Here.
9 MS. ROBINS: John Bubba Wynn.
10 MR. WYNN: Here.
11 MS. ROBINS: Richard LeBouef?
12 MR. LEBOUCEF: Here
13 MS. ROBINS: Donnie Colona, is he on here?
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: He's muted.
16
17 MS. ROBINS: Oh, he's muted.
18
19 MR. WYNN: No, Donnie, Donnie's muted.
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: Donnie.
22
23 MS. ROBINS: Okay, he's on here. Okay, here's
24 here. Donovan Driscoll, is Mr. Donovan on here?
25
26 MR. LEBOUCEF: Yes.
27
28 MS. ROBINS: He's on here too. Jason Brancamp?
29
30 MR. BRANCAMP: Here.

32 MS. ROBINS: And Robert Thomas?

34 MR. THOMAS: Here.

1 DR. DE ABREU: All right, we have a quorum. Do we
2 have anybody who has not received the meetings
3 agenda for today - it's the same meetings agenda
4 for, for last week. I mean were just reusing that
5 and I'm going to put it on the screen right, just a
6 sec. I think everybody can see it.

7 MS. ROBINS: Yes.

8 MR. DRISKILL: Yes.

9 MR. THOMAS: Yep.

10 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, let's skip number two right
11 now. I want to take advantage of that. It's
12 easier to learn the rights than, than the call and
13 we're going to proceed with number four with the

14
15 review agenda for approval of hours for the 2025
16 Louisiana Environmental Conference, and she sent me
17 the, the agenda this morning, so I'm just going to
18 to share with everybody too. Very good, it should
19 be on the screen now. Ms. Yolunda, if you want to
20 go ahead and explain the agenda for us, please.

21 MS. RIGHTEOUS: So thank you to the, to the Board
22 of Certification. I appreciate you all, including
23 me on this morning's agenda. To sort of give you
24 an overview of the agenda for the 2025 Louisiana
25 Environmental Conference and Trade Fair. I

1 appreciate that because we are really targeting
2 some time this month to, to release the agenda. And
3 I'm going to apologize ahead of time. I do see a
4 minor typo on the agenda with respect to that first
5 networking break in the afternoon from 2:20. That
6 should be 2:20 to 2:50, so 2:20, yeah and so with
7 that, I'll kind of walk you through. We'll start at
8 8:30 on Thursday, March 20, 2025, and we will
9 finish up at 5:00 on the first day, and so we'll
10 have our typical plan session. We will do the
11 state of the environment address and what we are
12 anticipating is two or three state agency heads
13 that will come in and participate in a panel

14
15 discussion or some type of roundtable discussion,
16 so that will be the state of the environment, and
17 then we'll have our networking break.

18 And then we'll move into the 10:30 to 11:30
19 time slot where we'll continue with our state of
20 the state update and you'll notice a slight change
21 because what we plan to do is do a slight breakout
22 with the solid waste operators and the UST
23 operators. We're really continuing to make an
24 effort to make this agenda relevant to all of the
25 different groups that we know will be, you know, in

1 attendance, so the state of the state address will
2 be more for the industrial sector or some of the
3 regional managers, the consultants, and then the
4 solid waste operators will have a session that's
5 tailored, you know, for them as well as the UST
6 operators. Then we'll go into lunch where we'll
7 have our award ceremony, followed by a networking
8 break, and another slight change where we plan on
9 doing a field demonstration, sort of like a field
10 trip for the solid waste operators and the UST
11 operators and thanks to Richard LeBoeuf, he's so
12 kindly agreed to allow us to make use of the St.
13 Landry Parish landfill, so we're continuing to, to,
14
15 to work out this this particular area of the agenda
16
17 to again to make the conference more hands-on for
18 the, for the solid waste operators in the UST
19 operators.

18 DR. DE ABREU: great.

19 MS. RIGHTEOUS: So then in the afternoon, we'll go
20 to our breakout sessions. We'll have 5 breakouts.
21 Another thing with the UST operators and the UST
22 operators going on like that off site field trip,
23 that'll free up two rooms upstairs for us to have
24 exhibitor spotlights, where we'll, we will have
25

1 exhibitors also included on the agenda, whether
2 they want to do demos or they want to do
3 presentations or if they want to participate in a
4 panel discussion, so we have our 5 breakouts.
5 Breakout 1 for young professionals, breakout 2
6 landfill management emergent technology, Breakout 3
7 multimedia, industrial, and then four and five is
8 where we will make use on the agenda for the, for
9 our exhibitors and so on Thursday we will finish up
10 at 5:00. I will leave this agenda with Ricardo.
11 You can see we have a variety of topics and so I
12 don't want to necessarily go through each one of
13 these, but I think each breakout gives you some

14
15 idea of the topics that are in each, each session.

16 And then once we go to Friday, we will start at

17 and then we'll end up at 12:30 on Friday.

18 Again, we'll go back to our more traditional sort
19 of agenda where we have breakout one young

20 professionals, breakout 2 landfill management and

21 emerging technology. Breakout 3 is multimedia and

22 industrial, and then four will also be multimedia

23 and industrial, and then we'll have our safety

24 track for our solid waste operators and our UST

25 operators and what we will do on Friday is finish

1 up it with a round table for each one of those
2 tracks from 11:30 to 12:30 we'll have a breakout.
3 What we try to do is, you know, do regulatory
4 update, have a really robust track for, for our
5 young professionals. We did quite a bit of
6 research ahead of sort of putting these topics on
7 the, on paper, looking at other conferences around
8 the country, the big waste conferences and what we
9 tried to do is come up with instead of sort of
10 watering down the agenda, come up with, you know,
11 some really good topics that lend themselves more
12 to a round table or, or a panel discussion, and so
13 that's, that's where we are. Do you all have any

14
15 specific questions? You'll see some regulatory
16 updates. You'll see our ethics for we, you know, we
17 continue to offer the ethics for professionals, the
18 engineers, and the geoscientists. There have been
19 some recent Supreme Court decisions we think that,
20 you know, it's timely to discuss those. We have
21 some remediation related topics and hazardous waste
22 topics, and again, some emergent technology
23 related, related topics.

24 DR. DE ABREU: And Miss Rachel, we have at least 10
25 hours for, for the operators, right, for

1 certification?
2 MS. RIGHTEOUS: Yes, and we had to go back and do a
3 little tweaking, so that's why you see we had to
4 cut down on some of our times without, without
5 breaks, so yes, we do, we do have the 10 hours for
6 the, for the operators, yes.
7 DR. DE ABREU: Does anyone have any questions?
8 Yes, Mr. LeBouef.
9 MR. LEBOUF: Yolanda, I have a question, In
10 the event of inclement weather you want me to have
11 something like a presentation here or maybe and I
12 can maybe get together with Marty and we can do
13 something, just in the event of weather that we're
14
15 not able to go out?
16 MS. RIGHTEOUS: That's correct.
17 MR. LEBOUF: Okay.
18 MS. RIGHTEOUS: That's correct, Marty. Marty will
19 definitely work with you to have a contingency plan
20 because I understand you do have enough space there
21 for the folks. Yeah, yeah.
22 MR. LEBOUF: Yes, ma'am.
23 MR. LEBOUF: Se bon, perfect.
24 DR. DE ABREU: Excellent, thanks.
25 MS. RIGHTEOUS: And we've also been --

1 DR. DE ABREU: Any other questions?
2 MS. RIGHTEOUS: Yeah.
3 DR. DE ABREU: I'm sorry. I'm sorry. I thought
4 you were through.
5 MS. RIGHTEOUS: No, I know you guys don't worry
6 about the UST certification, but I know that those
7 UST guys will be there, Richard and so I'm working
8 with the DEQ, the UST folks to make sure that we
9 also take care of the UST operators.
10 MR. LEBOUF: Perfect.
11 DR. DE ABREU: Any other questions? All right,
12 well thank you so much, Ms. Righteous. I mean
13 we're looking forward again for a great conference.

14
15 Thank you LSWA who put together such a well-rounded
16 agenda for the conference.

17 MS. RIGHTEOUS: Well, we appreciate ---

18 DR. DE ABREU: That's my favorite conference too,
19 and I know that for a lot of people here is too, so
20 we are looking really, really forward for March
21 30th, for March 20th to come

22 MS. RIGHTEOUS: Yes and just to, just to also let
23 the board know that we continue to make safety, you
24 know, we keep that at the, at the center and the
25 core of our of our training for the for the

1 certified operators, so you'll definitely see that
2 that Friday is a heavy emphasis on safety.
3 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, yeah, it sounds, sounds great.
4 It sounds great.. Any questions anyone?
5 MR. WYNN: I'll make the motion we approve it.
6 I'll make a motion we approve it.
7 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, Mr. Wyn, I would just ask
8 since we are doing online this time to state your
9 name before you make a motion or a second so the
10 transcriber --
11 MR. WYNN: John Bubba Wynn, I'll make a motion.
12 DR. DE ABREU: All right, Mr. Wynn.
13 MR. COLONA: Donnie Colona, I'll make a second.
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: Seconded by Mr. Colona, a motion by
16 Mr. Wynn, seconded by Mr. Colona, any comments or
17 questions? Alright, the motion passes. Thanks so
18 much, Miss Yolanda. Thank you.
19 MS. RIGHTEOUS: Thank you. Bye Bye.
20 DR. DE ABREU: All right. OK, let's go back to the
21 agenda. Just a second while check my screen. Very
22 good. Okay, everybody can see, right or maybe
23 not. Everybody can see or not, no? What I'm doing
24 wrong? OK, here it is. Better now.
25 MR. LEBOUF: Yeah.

1 MR. BRANCAMP: Yeah.
2 DR. DE ABREU: All right, good deal, Let's go to
3 number 2, the election of a chairman, vice
4 chairman, so my term has expired as a board
5 member, has expired last month, so we need to elect
6 a new Chairman for, for the board and depending on
7 who is the Chairman, we have to elect a new Vice
8 Chairman too. Let me see. I would like to open the
9 floor for nominations for Chairman. I myself like
10 to make a nomination to nominate Mr. Bubba Wynn as
11 the Chairman for the board.
12 MR. LEBOUF: Dr. de Abreau, Richard Leboeuf. I'd
13 like to 2nd that if he'll accept.
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, I was going to ask if there
16 are any more nominations.
17
18 MR. LEBOUF: I apologize.
19
20 DR. DE ABREU: No, we're, we're good. We're good.
21 I know everybody want like that, so any other
22 nominations? Just or we can make a motion to
23 second. Okay, I make a motion to. to nominate Mr.
24 Wynn to, for the board. Any - Mr. LeBouef, you
25 want to second?

MR. LEBOUF: I will second that. Richard Leboeuf,
I'll second Mr. Wynn's nomination.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Good deal, any comments or
2 questions? Now I have to ask if Mr. Wynn accepts
3 the the position, the new position?
4 MR. WYNN: Yes, I will. Yes, I will.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Okay.
6 MR. WYNN: It's an honor to be able to do it and
7 before we go any further, Ricardo, I just want to
8 let you know it's been a privilege to work with you
9 as the Chairman.
10 DR. DE ABREU: Thank you. It's been a privilege to
11 be on this, this team here. It is a group, a great
12 board. It is a great board. Okay, any comments?
13 So we hear none, the motion carries.
14
15 Congratulations, Mr. Wynn.
16
17 MR. WYNN: Thank you.
18
19 DR. DE ABREU: Now, Mr. Wynn since now are the
20 Chairman would you like me to continue presiding
21 this --
22
23 MR. WYNN: Yes, yes.
24
25 DR. DE ABREU: -- meeting?
26
27 MR. WYNN: Please, please do.
28
29 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, I will. I will. Since Mr.
30 Wynn was the Vice Chairman, now he is the chairman
31 and we have to elect a Vice Chairman for the board.

1 I would like to open the floor for nominations for
2 the Vice Chairman.

3 MR. WYNN: I would like to nominate Richard
4 Leboeuf for the Vice Chairman position.

5 DR. DE ABREU: Do I hear any other nominations?
6 Okay, Mr. LeBoeuf, do you do you accept the
7 nomination?

8 MR. LEBOUF: For my mentor, yes, sir, I do.

9 DR. DE ABREU: All right, any comments or
10 questions? Do we hear a motion to approve Mr.
11 LeBoeuf as the Vice Chairman of the board?

12 MR. COLONA: Donnie Colona, I'll make a motion to
13 approve.

14
15 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Colona; do I hear a
16 second?

17 MR. WYNN: I'll second.

18 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Wynn.

19 MR. WYNN: Well, I made the motion.

20 DR. DE ABREU: Alright, any more comments? I hear
21 none. The motion carries. Congratulations, Mr.
22 LeBoeuf.

23 MR. LEBOUF: I just again kind of like where Bubba
24 was headed again, Doc, I just want to say
25 everyone's got a lot of respect for everyone that's

1 on this board and everyone that serves through DEQ
2 and it it's, it's humbling. Thank you again to
3 all. I appreciate you guys so much.
4 DR. DE ABREU: Thank you, guys. Thank you Mr.
5 LeBouef. All right, next on the agenda is the
6 review of the July 18, 2024 minutes. I believe
7 everybody received the minutes in their packet that
8 Shirley sent everybody. Can I hear I have a motion
9 to approve the July 18, 2024 meeting, our, our last
10 meeting?
11 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make a motion.
12 MR. WYNN: I'll second it.
13 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef, seconded
14
15 by Mr. Wynn. Any comments? Hearing none, the
16 motion carries, so next the agenda is going to be
17 the consideration of operator certifications.
18 Let's go to the list of the review applications for
19 regular certifications. Everybody has the list,
20 okay, so let's go, start going down the applicants.
21 The first one is Brian Smith Landfill Level A with
22 Pivotal Engineering.
23 MR. WYNN: I approve the application, John Wynn,
24 Bubba Wynn.
25 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn to approve the

1 application. Do we hear a second?
2 MR. LEBOUCEF: Richard LeBouef, second.
3 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. LeBouef, any comments?
4 DR. DE ABREUS: The motion carries.
5 MR. LEBOUCEF: May I ask a question?
6 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, Sir.
7 MR. LEBOUCEF: I'm looking at the ones that we have
8 here and again, I don't want to get anything out of
9 order as, as the freshman member, Mr. Fuselier, Mr.
10 Echols, Mr. Mayeaux, those are the ones that need
11 tests. Can we make motions for the ones other than
12 those or we go through each one of them
13 individually, just a question?
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, I think let's go each one
16 individually.
17
18 MR. LEBOUCEF: Perfect.
19
20 DR. DE ABREU: I mean we are and, and we are, we are
21 approving the application regardless of the test.
22
23 MR. LEBOUCEF: That's good.
24
25 DR. DE ABREUS: If they pass the test or maybe
they, someone has not. I don't if everybody had
the test, but we are just approving the application
itself. If they pass the test and these
applications approve it, then he receives the

1 certificate and it's
2 just --
3 MR. LEBOUF: Okay, thank you.
4 DR. DE ABREUS: -- it's just, we are just approving
5 the application, okay. Second, Brian Whittington
6 Transfer Station for Waste Connections. Do we hear
7 a motion to approve it?
8 MR. DRISKILL: I'll make that motion.
9 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. Driskill.
10 MR. WYNN: I'll second it.
11 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Wynn, any comments?
12 Hearing none, the motion carries. Next is Carl
13 McAlister, C&D Level B with L&B Materials
14
15 Management.
16
17 MR. WYNN: And they got the correct amount of time
18 or is it, will it be January before they have the
19 time in?
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: For Mr. McAlister, let's see.
22
23 MR. WYNN: Of course they got Precision Leveling,
24 which is some construction background that could
25 play into this also.
26
27 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, so in the case of the
28 construction, if he was a supervisor, he can count
29 that for sure.

1 MR. LEBOUF: Shows that he was, yeah, shows that
2 he was an operator and truck driver.
3 MR. WYNN: Yeah, but, yeah, but it does not show
4 any supervisory experience.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, for construction, yes.
6 MR. WYNN: And also land clearing is fine, but they
7 do not show any drainage where he had anything to
8 do with any drainage structures. I would say I
9 would make a motion that we send this back to him
10 for some more information. As far as his other
11 experience in construction and see if he is in a
12 supervisory position and also dealt with drainage
13 areas. I would deny the application right now
14
15 without further information with him.
16
17 DR. DE ABREUS: Okay.
18
19 MR. LEBOUF: Put a condition on him, also
20 obtaining a conditional possibly, yeah.
21
22 MR. WYNN: Well, if they need the conditional I
23 mean they need a certified operator. They could
24 also do a conditional, if they were in that
25 position.

DR. DE ABREU: Yeah and he had requested for a
conditional too. That's the other.

MR. LEBOUF: Just ask for more information.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Yeah, so Mr. Wynn, is that a motion
2 to deny the, the application at this time?
3 MR. WYNN: At this time.
4 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, a motion by Mr. Wynn; do I
5 hear a second?
6 MR. DRISKILL: Okay.
7 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Driskill, any comments
8 or questions?
9 MS. ROBINS: So y'all are denying it because he just
10 need more experience, correct?
11 MR. WYNN: Correct.
12 DR. DE ABREU: Or he needs to verify more
13 experience, maybe he has more experience.
14
15 MS. ROBINS: Verify more experience.
16
17 DR. DE ABREU: Maybe he has the experience, but
18 it's not showing on the application itself.
19
20 MS. ROBINS: Okay.
21
22 MR. WYNN: He needs to show - Shirley, he needs to
23 show supervisory experience in the construction
24 industry.
25
26 DR. DE ABREU: Yeah.
27
28 MS. ROBINS: Okay, you say a supervisor and what
29 else?
30
31 MR. WYNN: In the construction area.

1 MS. ROBINS: Okay.
2 MR. WYNN: In his past construction jobs.
3 MS. ROBINS: Okay.
4 DR. DE ABREU: Any other comments? Hearing none,
5 the motion carries. Next is Cary Percle Transfer
6 Station Level A, American Recovery, L.L.C.
7 MR. WYNN: I make the motion to accept it.
8 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make a motion we accept it.
9 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn. Do we hear a
10 second?
11 MR. LEBOUF: Second.
12 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Leboeuf. Any
13 comments, questions? Hearing none the motion
14
15 carries. Next is Christopher Fuselier C&D Level B
16 with BP Disposal, L.L.C.
17
18 MR. WYNN: I make the motion again to accept his
19 application.
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: I'm sorry, you cut, you cut here for
22 me Mr. Wynn. Is the motion to --
23
24 MR. WYNN: I make a motion to accept the
25 application.
26
27 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, a motion to accept the
28 application. Do we hear a second?
29
30 MR. COLONA: I second, Donnie.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Colona, any questions,
2 comments, hearing none, the motion carries. Next
3 is Darryl Perry, Transfer Station, Omega Waste
4 Management.
5 MR. DRISKILL: I make that motion to approve it.
6 DR. DE ABREU: That was Mr. Driskill?
7 MR. DRISKILL: Yes.
8 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Driskill. Do I hear
9 a second?
10 MR. BRANCAMP: This is Jason, I'll 2nd.
11 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Brancamp, any
12 questions? Hearing none the motion carries. Next,
13 Heather Romero, C&D Level B, Terrebonne Parish.
14
15 MR. LEBOUF: I make that motion we accept.
16
17 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Brancamp?
18
19 MR. LEBOUF: LeBouef.
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: Oh, Mr. Leboeuf, I'm sorry. Do I
22 hear a second?
23
24 MR. BRANCAMP: This is Jason, I'll second..
25
26 DR. DE ABREU: Second, by Mr. Brancamp, any
27 comments? Hearing none the motion carriers. Next
28 is Justin Echols, Landfill Level A with Union
29 Parish.
30
31 MR. WYNN: This is the application, Ricardo,

1 this is Mr. Wynn. The, the landfill is - Union
2 Parish Landfill is a Type 2 and Type 3 landfill,
3 and he only marked for a Type 2 application. I
4 would approve his application for a Type 2, but
5 that does not mean that he would be an A Level in a
6 Type 3 landfill without taking the Type 3 landfill
7 test.

8 DR. DE ABREU: I see.

9 MR. WYNN: So I approve the application for a Type
10 2 level A, but again, here we are I'm saying we
11 cannot permit him to be a Type 3 without going
12 through the all the procedures.

13 DR. DE ABREU: Well, he's not asking for a type.
14

15 He's not asking for a Type 3. He's asking for a
16 Type 2 Landfill A, Type 2.

17 MR. WYNN: Yeah, I know it. I know it, but there's
18 a dual permit on the landfill, and so it's a Type 3
19 landfill and a Type 2, so he could not be over the
20 supervisory area of the Type 3 landfill. He could
21 only work in the Type 2 part of the landfill.

22 DR. DE ABREU: Okay and that's the, the part that it
23 gets, how you, I mean there are landfills that
24 receive both, both commingled, you know, move the
25 waste commingled. How you, you divide that, you

1 know.

2 MR. WYNN: Right, but I would just notify him that
3 he is a type or we do approve him for a Type 2
4 landfill, but he does need to get a Type 3 landfill
5 application and test done also.

6 DR. DE ABREU: If he wants to operate the Type 3
7 landfill?

8 MR. WYNN: I mean that that that's the same,
9 that's the same thing we do at the C&D here. We're
10 also a processing facility, and we have to have
11 dual permits or dual certifications.

12 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, well, again, I mean, he's
13 requesting for a Type 2 landfill, that's what we
14
15 have to vote for today, so.

16 MR. WYNN: That's correct but also notify him that
17 he has to take the test to be part of the Type 3,
18 over a Type 3 part of the landfill.

19 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, do I hear a motion to approve
20 his application, for Justin Echols' Landfill Level
21 A Type 2?

22 MR. LEBOUF: I'll second that motion with the
23 stipulations Mr. Wynn said.

24 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, a second, second Mr. LeBouef;
25 do I hear any, any comments or questions? Hearing

1 none, the motion carries. Next is Justin Watson,
2 Transfer Station Level B with Liquid Environmental
3 Solutions.
4 MR. WYNN: I make a motion. We approve it.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. Wynn. Do I hear a
6 second?
7 MR. DRISKILL: I second it.
8 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Driskill, any comments
9 or questions? Hearing none, the motion carries.
10 Next is Ladarrin Folsie, Transfer Station, American
11 Recovery, L.L.C.
12 MR. DRISKILL: I make a motion to approve.
13 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. Driskill, do I hear a
14
15 second?
16 MR. LEBOUF: I'll second that.
17 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Lebouf, any questions
18 or comments? Hearing none, the motion is carried.
19 Next is Latrell Primeaux-Gala Landfill Level B
20 with Arcadia Parish Landfill.
21 MR. WYNN: I make a motion to approve it.
22 DR. DE ABREU: There's a motion by Mr. Wynn to
23 approve the application. Do I hear a second?
24 MR. COLONA: Donnie, I second.
25 DR. DE ABREU: There's a second by Mr. Colona; any

1 comments or questions? Hearing none the motion
2 passes. Next is Louis Sanchez, Transfer Station
3 Level A, American Recovery, L.L.C.
4 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make a motion to approve it.
5 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef to approve
6 it. Do I hear a second?
7 MR. DRISKILL: Driskill, I'll second that.
8 DR. DE ABREU: A second by Mr. Driskill. Any
9 comments or questions here? Hearing none the
10 motion passes. Next is Marcus Chauvin, Transfer
11 Station, Omega Waste Management.
12 MR. DRISKILL: Donnie Driskill, motion to approve .
13 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Driscoll. Do I hear
14
15 a second?
16
17 MR. COLONA: Donnie, I'll second.
18
19 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Colona, any comments
20 or questions; hearing none, the motion carries,
21 next is Monica Matthews, Landfill Level B, Acadia
22 Parish Landfill.
23
24 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make that motion, Doc.
25
26 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef. Do I hear a
27 second?
28
29 MR. DRISKILL: I'll second it.
30
31 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Driskill, any comments
32

1 or questions? Hearing none, the motion carries.
2 Next is Nelson Crader, Landfill Level A, Republic
3 Services, do I hear a motion?
4 MR. WYNN: I'll make a motion.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. Wynn to approve, Mr.
6 Driskill, do we want a second?
7 MR. LEBOUF: I'll second that one.
8 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Leboeuf, any comments
9 or questions; hearing none, the motion carries.
10 Next is Raymond Payne, Landfill Level A, Republic
11 Service, do I hear a motion to approve?
12 MR. WYNN: I've got a problem with the experience
13 I think on this one.
14
15 (INAUDIBLE)
16 MR. LEBOUF: Just since May of 24 and then before
17 that is all field.
18 MR. WYNN: Yeah, exactly.
19 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make a motion to deny the
20 application.
21 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef to deny the
22 application; do we have a second
23 MR WYNN: I'll second.
24 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Wynn, any comments or
25 questions?

1 MS. ROBINS: And he will be denied because he need
2 more experience also?
3 MR. WYNN: That's correct.
4 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, any more questions?
5 MR. BRANCAMP: Yeah, question. I know it says oil
6 and gas, but our 360 is an oil and gas landfill.
7 Those 6 1/2 years don't count.
8 MR. WYNN: Is it?
9 MR. BRANCAMP: Yes.
10 MR. WYNN: Okay, I was wrong there because I did
11 not see the R360.
12 MR. WYNN: R360, yes.
13 MR. BRANCAMP: Page three, Employer #2R360 for 6
14
15 1/2 years.
16 MR. WYNN: Okay.
17 MR. LEBOUF: 2018 and '24, I'd like to know what
18 happened there.
19 MR. BRANCAMP: Yeah, there's a definite gap.
20 MR. LEBOUF: There's a gap of six years after that
21 in between those two. I'm confused
22 MR. BRANCAMP: Below that employer 3-11-18 to
23 January of 2023, R 360 and if so, he worked for two
24 R 360 facilities between 23 and 13.
25 DR. DE ABREU: No, the regulation, the regulations,

1 yes, and I just, I'm reminded that the regulations
2 don't stipulate that you have to have consecutive
3 years of experience to qualify for.
4 MR. LEBOUF: Only cumulative.
5 DR. DE ABREU: It's only commutative, yes, not not.
6 MR. LEBOUF: All right, well, I withdraw that
7 motion.
8 DR. DE ABREU: So Mr. LaBeouf withdraw the motion,
9 and do we hear a motion to accept.
10 MR. COLONA: Donnie, I second.
11 DR. DE ABREU: You make a motion to accept?
12 MR. COLONA: Oh yes, make a motion to accept.
13 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. Colona, do we hear a
14
15 second?
16
17 MR. BRANCAMP: This is Jason I'll 2nd.
18
19 MR. WYNN: Jason, I appreciate you bringing that out
20 because I did not see the R360.
21
22 DR. DE ABREU: Oh yes.
23
24 MR. BRANCAMP: Oh yeah, no problem.
25
26 MR. LEBOUF: Absolutely, Jason, thank you, thank
27 you, Jason.
28
29 DR. DE ABREU: Yes. And then he, he and he, he puts
30 in the application as a landfill on R360 landfill
31 specifically, He may work on R360 or not in the

1 landfill itself, but in the application it shows
2 that.

3 MR. WYNN: Yeah, okay.

4 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, the motion carries. Next
5 Robert Mayeaux, Transfer Station, Waste
6 Connections, Robert Mayeaux.

7 MR. DRISKILL: I'll make the motion to approve.

8 MR. WYNN: I'll accept that, go ahead.

9 MR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Driskill, seconded
10 by Mr. Wynn. Any comments? Hearing none, the
11 motion carries. Next is Ross Walet, C&D Level B
12 with Pace Landfill

13 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make that motion, Doc.

14

DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef; do we hear
15 a second?

16

MR. WYNN: I second.

17

DR. DE ABREU: A second by Mr. Wynn, any comments?
18 Hearing none, the motion carries. Next is Scott
19 Berry Transfer Station, Omega Waste Management.

20

MR. WYNN: I make a motion that we accept.

21

DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn to approve the
22 application; do we hear a second?

23

MR. BRANCAMP: This is Jason. I'll second.

24

DR. DE ABREU: A second by Mr. Brancamp. Any

25

1 comments or questions? Hearing none, the motion
2 carries. Next is Stephen Mosely, Transfer Station,
3 American Recovery, L.L.C.

4 MR. DRISKILL: I'll make the motion to accept.

5 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Driskill, do we hear
6 a second?

7 MR. COLONA: I'll second.

8 DR. DE ABREU: Donnie, a second by Mr. Colona; any
9 questions or comments? Hearing none the motion
10 carries and this we conclude the applications for
11 regular certification to be approved. We don't
12 have any conditional certifications or any
13 extensions.

14
15 Next item in the agenda is the applications for
16 recertification and let's try to approve that as a
17 group, so all these have completed the 40 hours
18 that are required and paid the fees, is that
19 correct, Ms. Robbins?

20 MS. ROBINS: Yes.

21 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, so before I read the names off
22 everybody, any questions on any of those
23 applications? Okay, I'm just going to read the
24 name for our minutes. We have Anthony Nunez, C&D
25 Level B with BP Disposal, Darrell Thompson,

1 Landfill Level B with Waste Management, Eric
2 Pederson, C&D Level A with BP Disposal, Jason
3 Williams, Landfill Level B, Tangipahoa Parish,
4 Keith Singleton, Landfill Level B with St. Landry
5 Parish, Marshall Bancroft, Landfill Level A with
6 West Carroll Police Jury, Robin Sessions, C&D Level
7 A with Jackson Parish Police Jury and Tamisha
8 Jordan, Landfill Level B with Republic Services.
9 Do we hear a motion to approve all these
10 applications for recertification?
11 MR. LEBOUF: Richard LeBouef, I'll make that
12 motion.
13 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef to accept the
14
15 applications for recertification; do I hear a
16
17 second?
18
19 MR. BRANCAMP: Jason, the second.
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Brancamp, any comments
22
23 or questions? Hearing none the motion carries.
24
25 Next in the agenda is the Incomplete
Recertification Applications and let's go one by
one just to comment and then we can approve or deny
as a group, so the first one we have is Bridget
Tillman, Landfill Level B with DeSoto Parish Police
Jury. She had 10 hours, but she got those 10 hours

1 at a Lake Charles conference, as Miss Connie told
2 me this morning, so she already has the 40 hours
3 that's required, okay; any comments on that or
4 questions?

5 MR. LEBOUF: So she did attain her 40 hours,
6 totaled up?

7 DR. DE ABREU: And she, yes, yes, she doesn't have
8 the certificate in her hands there because she just
9 took the 10 hours, but yes. Next, we have Gary
10 Braxton, Transfer Station Level B with Waste
11 Connections. He needed 10 hours. He actually
12 received the last certification that certificate
13 that he needs, so he has the 40 hours now. Any
14

15 comments on him? And Mr. Robbins, please interrupt
16 me if I'm saying something. that's not correct,
17
18 okay?

19 MS. ROBINS: Okay.

20 DR. DE ABREU: Next, Jared Patterson, Incinerator
21 Level A, MWM Raven, and he needs 30 hours and as
22 far as I haven't received anything back from him.
23 I don't know if you received Ms. Shirley.

24 MS. ROBINS: No, I have not. I did e-mail him
25 about it. He only sent me that list that I emailed
you guys.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, any comments on him, okay,
2 then we have Linda Murray, C&D Level A, Waste
3 Connections, needed 10 hours and she was scheduled
4 to attend the July 2024 workshop and she attend the
5 workshop and she has paid the, the fee attendance,
6 attendance fee. Any questions? Okay, next I have
7 Michael Nase, C&D Level A with Waste Pro/KV
8 Landfill. He needed 10 hours. He was supposed to
9 attend the October 2024 workshop, and he did, he
10 already paid the fee, Any questions? Okay, next is
11 Stanley Woodley, Landfill Level B, the DeSoto
12 Parish Police Jury, he needed 10 hours. He was
13 registered to attend the Lake Charles Conference
14
15 and workshop and he attended, so he has the last 10
16 hours,

17 MR. LEBOUF: So Doc, this is Richard Leboeuf. The
18 only one that is incomplete is Jared Patterson
19 asking for the Incinerator Level A, correct?

20 DR. DE ABREU: That is correct, so I'd like a
21 motion to approve the following applications,
22 Bridget Tillman, Gary Braxton, Linda Murray,
23 Michael Nase, and Stanley Woodley.

24 MR. LEBOUF: This is Richard LeBouef. I'll make
25 that motion.

1 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef, do I hear a
2 second?
3 MR. DRISKILL: Donavan, I'll second it.
4 DR. DE ABREU: A second by Mr. Driskill, Any
5 comments or questions? Hearing none the motion
6 carries. Now, I make a motion or I want a motion,
7 hear a motion to deny the application of Jared
8 Patterson, Incinerator Level A with MWA Raven.
9 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make that motion, Richard
10 Leboeuf.
11 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. LeBouef, do I hear a
12 second?
13 MR. DRISKILL: Again.
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Driskill, any comments
16 or questions?
17
18 MS. ROBINS: I have a question for Jared. You
19 denied it because he don't have his hours.
20
21 DR. DE ABREU: Right.
22
23 MS. ROBINS: So would he have to start over or how
24 would that work?
25
26 MR. WYNN: Yes, he would have to re- test.
27
28 MS. ROBINS: Re-test, okay, he's denied, and he
29 need to re-test.
30
31 MR. WYNN: Correct.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Any other questions or comments?
2 Hearing none, the motion carries.
3 MS. ROBINS: I do have a question going back to Mr.
4 Justin Echols.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Yes.
6 MS. ROBINS: I have a question. I know you guys
7 were saying about the Type 2 and he need a Type 3
8 test. We don't have - I don't have a different
9 test for Type 2 and Type 3. I only have one test
10 for --
11 MR. WYNN: Yes, no, you've got a C&D type 3 test
12 and you've got a Type 2 Solid Waste Test.
13 MS. ROBINS: Okay, let me --
14
15 MR. WYNN: The Type 3 is C&D Landfill.
16
17 MS. ROBINS: Oh, okay, okay, I see what you mean,
18 so Type 3 is the C&D for.--
19
20 MR. WYNN: That's correct. That's correct.
21
22 MS. ROBINS: Okay, will that be the Level A or
23 Level B what he needs to take?
24
25 MR. WYNN: It would be the Level A if he's applied
for a Level A and the Type 2.
MS. ROBINS: Okay, okay, so when I contact him I
need to let him know that he needs to - he's
approved for the Level 2 --

1 MR. WYNN: Yes.
2 MS. ROBINS: -- but he has to test the C&D level A
3 for the Type 3.
4 DR. DE ABREU: If he wants to to be a Level A, Type
5 3 for the landfill, yes.
6 MS. ROBINS: If he wants to be - say that one more
7 time?
8 MR. WYNN: Dual certified.
9 DR. DE ABREU: Yes.
10 MS. ROBINS: Okay and then he'll get both
11 certificates, the Level of A and the landfill
12 level, the C&D Level A?
13 MR. WYNN: Correct.
14
15 MS. ROBINS: Okay, but as of right now, he only
16 receiving a Landfill Level A?.
17
18 MR. WYNN: That's correct.
19
20 MS. ROBINS: Okay, thank you, I think I got it.
21
22 DR. DE ABREU: All right, so next in the agenda is
23 the recertification of Danny Hylton to the board
24 member lifetime certification, so as most of you
25 know, Danny Hilton was a board member for two
consecutive terms and he is requesting to receive
the member Lifetime Certification, and he has all
Level A's to have, I'm sorry to have ALL Level A's

1 Certification.
2 MR. WYNN: I'll make that motion we approve it.
3 DR. DE ABREU: A motion by Mr. Wynn, do I hear a
4 second?
5 MR. LEBOUF: I second the motion.
6 DR. DE ABREU: A second by Mr. LeBouef, any
7 comments or questions? Hearing none, the motion
8 carries.
9 Next is the issuance of Operators
10 Certificates, Ms. Robins, could you please tell
11 the name of all the applicants that are receiving
12 the operator certificates?
13 MS. ROBINS: Okay, so everyone who's approved today
14
15 is Bryan Smith, Bryant, Whittington, Cary Percle,
16
17 Christopher Fuselier, Darryl Perry,
18
19 DR. DE ABREU: Just, just a second, just a second,
20
21 so we gave certificates only to people that passed
22
23 the test too, okay?
24
25 MS. ROBINS: Okay, okay, okay, yeah, they passed.
26
27 DR. DE ABREU: Okay.
28
29 MS. ROBINS: Okay, yes, Christopher Fuselier.
30
31 MR. LEBOUF: Christopher Fuselier.
32
33 MS. ROBINS: Fuselier, I'm sorry.
34
35 MR. LEBOUF: There you go.

1 MS. ROBINS: I'm bad with these names now. Okay,
2 Darryl Perry, Heather Romero.
3 MR. LEBOUEF: Romero
4 MR. WYNN: Romero.
5 MS. ROBINS: Justin Echols, Justin Watson, Ladarrin
6 Folsie, Latrell Primeaux-Gala, Louis Sanchez, Marcus
7 Chauvin.
8 MR. LEBOUEF: Chauvin.
9 MS. ROBINS: Chauvin, Monica Matthews, Raymond
10 Payne, Raymond Payne, Robert --
11 MR. WYNN: Wait a minute; you skipped one, Nelson
12 Crader.
13 MS. ROBINS: Yeah, he didn't pass the test yet.
14
15 DR. DE ABREU: He didn't pass the test.
16
17 MR. WYNN: Okay.
18
19 MS. ROBINS: Yeah, that's why I skipped him, Raymond
20 Payne, Ross Walet, Scott Berry, and Stephen Mosely.
21
22 DR. DE ABREU: So anyone wants to make a motion we
23 should --
24
25 BY MR. LEBOUEF: I have, I have a question.
26
27 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, yes, sir.
28
29 MS. ROBINS: Yes.
30
31 MR. LEBOUEF: Singleton.
32
33 MS. ROBINS: Which one?
34
35

1 MR. LEBOUF: Keith Singleton.
2 MS. ROBINS: Singleton, wait, what, you asking me
3 about a name?
4 MR. LEBOUF: Yes, ma'am, Keith Singleton.
5 MS. ROBINS: Keith Singleton.
6 MR. LEBOUF: It's one of operators that's for,
7 that's for recertification.
8 MS. ROBINS: Oh, recertification, I'm sorry, okay,
9 yes, what about?
10 MR. LEBOUF: Okay, I was just asking. I just want
11 to know if you turned everything in to him.
12 MS. ROBINS: Yes, we have everything.
13 MR. LEBOUF: Thank you.
14
15 MS. ROBINS: You're welcome.
16
17 DR. DE ABREU: All right, so do we hear a motion to
18 approve all the issuance of operating
19 certifications to all those applicants - that are
20 applicants for regular certification.
21 MR. LEBOUF: I'll make that motion, Doc.
22
23 DR. DE ABREU: Motion by Mr. LeBouef, do I hear a
24 second?
25
26 MR. BRANCAMP: Jason, I second.
27
28 DR. DE ABREU: Second by Mr. Brancamp, any comments
29 or questions? Hearing none, the motion carries.

1 Next the committee reports. I have award - Richard
2 LeBouef.

3 MR. LEBOUF: I have not received anything yet.
4 I'm working on a couple on my end and that is going
5 to be the deadline for that will be this month on
6 the 30th, but I have not received anything as of
7 yet.

8 DR. DE ABREU: Okay and everybody received the
9 forms.

10 MR. WYNN: Yes.

11 DR. DE ABREU: They have received the forms for the
12 Bentley Mackay Award for Level A and for Level B.
13 Now the board votes on the nominations for the
14

15 Bentley Mackay Award and the deadline, we put a
16 deadline on November 30, 2024, so probably we can
17 vote that or the person who it will be and the
18 board votes on that on the December meeting. We
19 can vote on that, so please if you want to nominate
20 somebody, please fill out the form for the Bentley
21 MacKay Award and send to Ms. Shirley Robins by the
22 end of this month. Of course, you can also
23 nominate someone for the Level A and for the Level
24 B operator of the year. That's not exclusive of the
25 board, but the board members can also nominate

1 people for Level A and Level B, and I encourage
2 everybody to do so, please. All right, anything
3 else Mr. LeBouef.
4 MR. LEBOUF: That's all I have, sir.
5 DR. DE ABREU: Next - Testing - Bubba Wynn.
6 MR. WYNN: I will go back to Shirley and have her
7 with a report on the tests, on how many tests and
8 how many passed.
9 MS. ROBINS: We had eight that came and took the
10 test, and they all - well seven passed, one
11 failed.
12 DR. DE ABREU: All right, thank you, Ms. Shirley,
13 anything else Mr. Wynn?
14
15 MR. WYNN: No, that's pretty well it.
16
17 DR. DE ABREU: Okay, next, continuing education -
18 Donavan Driskill, anything to report?
19
20 MR. WYNN: How many total did, how many total did
21 we have at the workshop?
22
23 MR. DRISKILL: I'm not sure. I haven't gotten the
24 report from Miss Connie on that.
25
26 MR. WYNN: Because the last, the last I heard it
27 was about 105, wasn't it, Richard?
28
29 MR. LEBOUF: Sir.
30
31 MR. WYNN: Wasn't it about 105 people at the

1 conference.
2 MR. LEBOUF: The last I heard it was 104. The last
3 I heard Bubba I think it was 104 or 105, correct.
4 MR. WYNN: Yeah, yeah. Yeah, yeah. (inaudible).
5 MR. LEBOUF: Yeah, we're doing that comparison to
6 Shreveport.
7 DR. DE ABREU: Great attendance, yeah, very good,
8 anything else Mr. Driskill?
9 MR. DRISKILL: That's it.
10 DR. DE ABREU: All right, next - nominating,
11 Donnie Colona.
12 MR. COLONA: I don't have anyone in mind, but we
13 really do need some more people on the board. If
14
15 y'all know anyone that's capable or eligible.
16
17 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, the the problem we have Mr.
18 Colona is that we don't have - and we're not having
19 any feedback back from LMA, Louisiana Spell
20 Association, and we have three people that are, I
21 mean there are three positions available from the
22 LMA and --
23 MR. WYNN: I, I got into --
24
25 DR. DE ABREU: And I know that, yes, yes, Mr. Wynn,
I know that, go ahead, go ahead.
MR. WYNN: Well, I was just saying I have I have

1 got in touch and I have got the come back to the
2 lady again that I'm in touch with, and we're going
3 to see what we can get worked out.

4 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, we definitely need some more
5 people in the board. That's, that's for sure.
6 That's for sure, so please, please continue the
7 effort. Any other business, any new business, any
8 kind of comments?

9 MR. LEBOUF: Yes, I have one question. Now that,
10 now that Mr. Driskill is, is retired, who's going
11 to be in charge of the food at the December
12 meeting; he did such a good job at the last one?

13 DR. DE ABREU: That's, that's a very important
14
15 question, Mr. Leboeuf, and listen, even if I'm not
16 in the board anymore, I will come to that one too.
17 I'm inviting myself, yes.

18 MR. WYNN: There you go. I would love, would love
19 to have you there.

20 MR. LEBOUF: If I can have another question being
21 that we looking for three additional, I know that
22 Mr. Wynn is now the Chairman, but I mean you
23 continue to serve until replaced?

24 DR. DE ABREU: Yes, yes, absolutely.

25 MR. LEBOUF: I like the sound of that.

1 DR. DE ABREU: Yes.
2 MS. ROBINS: I have a question also. Okay, so I know
3 Mr. Wynn will be the Chairman now and Mr. LeBouef
4 is the Vice Chairman, as for as the award and
5 testing they still stay in that spot or someone
6 else have to go there?
7 MR. WYNN: No, no, we'll have to move those
8 positions to somebody else.
9 MS. ROBINS: Okay.
10 MR. WYNN: We'll have - and I'm sure we'll have some
11 good volunteers to take those positions.
12 MS. ROBINS: Okay,
13 MR. LEBOUUEF: Thank you for asking that question,
14
15 Miss Robbins.
16
17 MS. ROBINS: Yes, I was wondering that.
18
19 DR. DE ABREU: If somebody can fill that positions
20 at our next meeting we're going to have probably
21 more, hopefully we'll have more board members too,
22 so that that will be good. Do we have a date for
23 the next meeting, Shirley?
24 MS. ROBINS: No, not that I know of.
25
26 MR. WYNN: December the 13th?
27
28 DR. DE ABREU: December the 13th
29
30 MS. ROBINS: Okay.

1 MR. WYNN: Am I right, Richard?
2 MR. LEBOUUEF: Yes, on the Friday in Patterson
3 MR. WYNN: Yeah.
4 MS. ROBINS: Do you have a time?
5 MR. LEBOUUEF: No, ma'am, I do not.
6 MR. WYNN: Not yet.
7 MR. LEBOUUEF: I could, I could check with Bo and
8 I'll get back with you
9 MS. ROBINS: Okay, thank you.
10 DR. DE ABREU: All right, any other comments? Mr.
11 Thomas, you're, you're quiet there Any comments?
12 MR. THOMAS: No, no comments for me.
13 DR. DE ABREU: All right.
14
15 MR. LEBOUUEF: I have, I have one quick thing to Rob,
16 I don't know if Yolanda's still on and also Miss
17 Shirley. I don't know if Keri is still on, but I
18 just want you guys to know we had over 20 DEQ
19 agents that came and assisted us with our hazardous
20 household waste recycling day. I cannot begin to
21 say thank you enough.
22 MS. MEYERS: Good, good, glad, glad to hear that.
23 MR. LEBOUUEF: It was a success, a home run. Thank
24 you all so much. The guys did such an amazing job.
25 Thank you all again.

1 MR. THOMAS: Good deal, thank you.
2 MR. LEBOUF: That's all I got.
3 DR. DE ABREU: I have my last words. I would like
4 to thank everybody. It's been a privilege to be in
5 this board and been a privilege to be your
6 Chairman, and I, I really enjoyed and enjoyed
7 being with my friends here, and I hope that I can
8 come back one day. For now, we need new blood in
9 this, in this board for sure. We need some more
10 new people too. And if you want anyone that can,
11 wants to serve on the Board I would like to ask
12 you to please contact LMA directly and see if they
13 can nominate this person. I also just because I'm
14
15 not on the board, doesn't mean that I'm not
16 available for anything and Miss Robbins, if you
17 need anything, please, please and Keri, please,
18 you can call me anytime, you can send them in the
19 mail. This is a volunteer job and I'm a continuing
20 to volunteer my time to the Board as, not as a
21 Chairman and not as a board member, but I would
22 like to volunteer my time to help our fellow
23 operators' vision and that's, I mean that's a very
24 important, that's a very important job you guys do
25 and it's crucial to our industry that we have good

1 people in charge of your landfills that take care
2 of our environment, okay. Thank you everybody. I
3 really appreciate your time. Hopefully I'll see you
4 in December again.

5 MR. WYNN: And Ricardo, I'm sure I we will be
6 calling you.

7 DR. DE ABREU: Please do so. Please do so, Mr.
8 Wynn.

9 MR. LEBOUF: It's, it's not uncommon for Dr. de
10 Abreu to be walking on stage in Pennsylvania,
11 getting an award, and he'll take a call. Been
