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MR. STEWART:

All right. Well, it looks like everyone is here that's going to be here today. So, at this time I'd like to call to order the fourth and final meeting of 2014 of the Board of Certification and Training for Solid Waste Management Operators in Patterson Civic Center at ten o'clock a.m.

First item on the agenda is roll call. Ms. Bordelon, please.

MS. BORDELON:

Yes.

Jonathan Fourrier?

MR. FOURRIER:

Present.

MS. BORDELON:

Gary Bonvillain?

Mia Townsel?

MS. TOWNSEL:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Bubba Wynn?

Lindsey Turtle?

MS. TURTLE:

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Present.

MS. BORDELON:

Bo Lagrange?

MR. LAGRANGE:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Fred Williams?

MR. WILLIAMS:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Terrance Stewart?

MR. STEWART:

Here.

MS. BORDELON:

Crystal Perkins?

Troy Barber?

MR. STEWART:

Next item is reviewing of the
October 21, 2014 minutes from Shreveport.
Any questions? Any changes? Any motion
to --

MR. WILLIAMS:

So moved.

MR. STEWART:

Motion by Mr. Williams.

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MR. LAGRANGE:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Second by Mr. Lagrange.

Any discussion? Any opposition?

Minutes accepted.

Third item is issue certificates to new Board members Lindsey Turtle and Mia Townsel.

MR. LAGRANGE:

So moved.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Motion by Mr. Lagrange, second by Mr. Williams.

MS. BORDELON:

Mia does have all of her certifications except -- the only one she doesn't have is the refuse derived fuel facility, which we don't even actually issue anymore. But most Board members get all of them, so that's the only one that she does not have, but she has the others already.

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MR. STEWART:

Okay.

MR. WILLIAMS:

And did you say that for any particular reason? I mean, do we need to --

MS. BORDELON:

No, just saying that that's the only one that we have to issue her.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Okay.

MS. BORDELON:

Not all of them. Like, Lindsey, we will issue all certifications to.

MR. STEWART:

Okay. Any more discussion? Any opposition?

Motion carries.

Item number four is consideration of operator certifications. Review of applications for certification. We will -- what we'll do is we'll just go through one by one, maybe take a little more time and review them as we go, but we'll go through and I'll call out the

1 names, and if there's any discussion then
2 we'll discuss it and make a decision at
3 that time.

4 All right. First application is
5 Dieter Becker, C&D Level A Amid/Metro
6 Landfill. And the comments are: Has C&D
7 Level B, passed Level A on 11/18/14. It
8 shows here that --

9 MS. BORDELON:

10 He's held a Level B --

11 MR. LAGRANGE:

12 Level B for two years.

13 MS. BORDELON:

14 -- since 2012.

15 MR. STEWART:

16 So, he appears to meet the
17 qualifications.

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 Yeah, he appears to meet the
20 qualifications.

21 MR. STEWART:

22 Okay. Any more discussion on that
23 app?

24 Okay. Sandy Callahan, C&D Level B,
25 Greenpoint, Inc. Issued conditional on

1 12/13. That was of -- 12/13.

2 MS. BORDELON:

3 All right. So, now he's applying
4 for -- they're trying to get regular
5 certification for him. He won't have his
6 two years at Greenpoint until April,
7 unless we take into consideration the
8 previous employment with the use of heavy
9 equipment construction work.

10 MR. STEWART:

11 From '97 to -- what is that? 2000?

12 MR. LAGRANGE:

13 From 2001 to 2012.

14 MR. STEWART:

15 2012.

16 MS. BORDELON:

17 And then there was -- yeah, '97 to
18 2001 on the next page.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 And he's passed the exam?

21 MS. BORDELON:

22 He has.

23 MR. LAGRANGE:

24 This is for a?

25 MS. BORDELON:

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For a Level B.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Level B.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Yeah. With the construction experience, it appears that he does meet the qualifications for a Level B.

MR. STEWART:

I agree.

MR. WILLIAMS:

And he has passed the exam.

MR. STEWART:

Any more discussion?

Sandra C. DeRouen.

MS. BORDELON:

DeRouen.

MR. STEWART:

DeRouen. C&D, Level A. DeRouen's Heavy Equipment. Certification expired. Retested.

MR. LAGRANGE:

The certification expired in '08?

MS. BORDELON:

Well, this is actually a closed facility, and there recently was some

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discussion by Rhonda McCormick, the --

MR. LAGRANGE:

In Lafayette?

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah. That even though they were closed that they still needed to have certified operators. So, she requested that she come back in and get certified again.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Is that because they are under post-closure care?

MR. WILLIAMS:

Is that what it is?

MS. TOWNSEL:

They are.

MR. WILLIAMS:

So, you'll have to maintain your certification during post-closure for as long as you're there?

MS. TOWNSEL:

We are having discussions about that right now.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Okay.

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MS. TOWNSEL:

So, that's still --

MR. WILLIAMS:

Post-closure is, what, 30 years?

MS. TOWNSEL:

Exactly.

MR. STEWART:

So, she has time.

MR. WILLIAMS:

That's a long time.

MR. LAGRANGE:

That's job security for the Board.

MR. WILLIAMS:

I guess so. We'll be here.

MR. STEWART:

So --

MS. BORDELON:

So, anyway, that's why she is recertifying.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Well, it appears she meets the qualifications, although I don't know if she's worked in it, you know, since '08, since they closed, but she does have the experience -- or had the experience and

1 qualifications, it would appear to me.

2 • MR. WILLIAMS:

3 Yeah.

4 MR. STEWART:

5 Okay. Any more discussion?

6 Okay. Cheryl L. Mclaughlin, Transfer
7 Station, Level B, City of Winnfield. Has
8 conditional Level A, requesting Level B.
9 Took the Level A exam on 7/13.

10 MS. BORDELON:

11 Originally they were requesting just
12 an extension to her Level B -- I mean, to
13 her Level A, but since she has been there
14 now -- in January will have been two
15 years, I made the suggestion that she just
16 apply for a regular Level B instead of
17 another conditional Level A.

18 MR. WILLIAMS:

19 Yeah.

20 MS. BORDELON:

21 Because they do have a Level A
22 operator. And this, again, is the City of
23 Winnfield that doesn't actually even need
24 operators.

25 MR. LAGRANGE:

1 Right. She's taken the B exam?

2 MS. BORDELON:

3 She took the A exam.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 So, if you pass the A exam, that

6 counts for taking the B exam?

7 MS. BORDELON:

8 Yeah.

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 All right. She meets the

11 qualifications, then.

12 MR. WILLIAMS:

13 Yeah.

14 MR. STEWART:

15 Brian E. Meaton, Incinerator, Level

16 A, Veolia Water, issued conditional,

17 requesting regular.

18 MS. BORDELON:

19 Okay. This one -- I don't know if

20 y'all remember back in -- at the

21 Shreveport meeting we reviewed this

22 application. It was denied for lack of

23 experience and we issued him a conditional

24 replacing another operator. He has since

25 sent in additional information to his

1 application, because he feels like he does
2 have the solid waste experience. So, if
3 y'all want to look at that additional
4 information that he submitted, because he
5 does want regular certification.

6 MR. STEWART:

7 Is this the guy that you --

8 MS. BORDELON:

9 Uh-huh (yes).

10 MR. STEWART:

11 -- called me about?

12 MS. BORDELON:

13 So, he sent a letter and a resume.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 There's no denying he has experience
16 at that facility. He meets the experience
17 requirements at that facility. It's just,
18 I guess, the question was, was it enough
19 experience dealing with solid waste?

20 MR. WILLIAMS:

21 And this is all water.

22 MR. FOURRIER:

23 For incinerator. He's applying for
24 Incinerator, Level A.

25 MS. BORDELON:

1 Right. I don't know if this thermal
2 conditioning, this paragraph in his
3 letter -- his memo.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 What is thermal conditioning, John?

6 MR. FOURRIER:

7 It may be drying the sludge.

8 MR. LAGRANGE:

9 Heat drying it says.

10 MR. WILLIAMS:

11 That's heat drying instead of a
12 press.

13 MR. FOURRIER:

14 But the main consideration with the
15 incinerator would be operating it
16 correctly for your air emissions, just
17 heating up sludge, you're not generally
18 concerned with that.

19 MR. STEWART:

20 Mia, do you have any thoughts on
21 this?

22 MS. TOWNSEL:

23 No, not now.

24 MR. STEWART:

25 Is he an engineer?

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MS. BORDELON:

Yeah, I think he is.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Environmental science.

MR. STEWART:

The resume is somewhat impressive.

MR. FOURRIER:

He's only been there since September
at the current facility?

MS. BORDELON:

At the current.

MR. LAGRANGE:

At that specific facility, yeah.

MR. FOURRIER:

And he has a conditional A.

MS. BORDELON:

Correct.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Passed the test?

MS. BORDELON:

Yes.

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MR. FOURRIER:

There being -- why does he need a regular A, then? Unless he's planning to leave.

MS. BORDELON:

I guess for him right now the only advantage to having the regular as opposed to the conditional is to have to -- not to have to keep asking for extensions every six months.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Or for future employment.

MR. LAGRANGE:

His previous experience has been at wastewater facilities. This is his first experience at an incinerator facility since September?

MR. STEWART:

Uh-huh (yes).

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.

MR. LAGRANGE:

And his -- he's basing his request on his qualifications at those wastewater treatment facilities. He handled solids,

1 which are considered solid waste.

2 MR. WILLIAMS:

3 Solid waste, yeah.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 Mainly, I guess, sewer sludges.

6 Right? So, the question we have is, if

7 that constitutes --

8 MR. WILLIAMS:

9 Constitutes.

10 MR. LAGRANGE:

11 -- experience in solid waste.

12 MR. STEWART:

13 I tend to agree.

14 MR. WILLIAMS:

15 I don't know whether --

16 MR. LAGRANGE:

17 In waste handling, because this is

18 for an incinerator waste handling.

19 MR. WILLIAMS:

20 So, what are our options?

21 MR. LAGRANGE:

22 Well, the options are: Do not approve

23 his application for a regular, he

24 continues with his conditional, renews his

25 conditional once he gets -- with an

1 engineering degree and after one year's
2 experience at the facility, he can apply
3 for a regular certificate. Right?

4 MR. WILLIAMS:

5 Is that a motion?

6 MR. LAGRANGE:

7 Well.

8 MR. WILLIAMS:

9 Yeah, I agree with that.

10 MR. STEWART:

11 Okay. So, I've got a motion by
12 Mr. Lagrange, second by Mr. Williams.

13 MS. BORDELON:

14 It's two years --

15 MR. LAGRANGE:

16 Is it two years experience for that?

17 MS. BORDELON:

18 Two years with an engineering degree.

19 MR. LAGRANGE:

20 Oh, I'm sorry. I thought it was one
21 for a class A. Okay.

22 MS. BORDELON:

23 It says a minimum three years in the
24 field of solid waste management.

25 MR. LAGRANGE:

1 All right. Well, I still --

2 MR. WILLIAMS:

3 Yeah.

4 MR. LAGRANGE:

5 -- I think there's still some
6 question that being in a wastewater
7 facility meets that criteria.

8 Mr. Chairman, what's your thoughts on
9 that?

10 MR. STEWART:

11 I agree. It's just -- it's not
12 enough experience for me to, you know.
13 It's minimal experience in solid waste.

14 MR. LAGRANGE:

15 All right.

16 MR. STEWART:

17 So, do you stand on your motion?

18 MR. LAGRANGE:

19 Repeat my motion.

20 MR. WILLIAMS:

21 Was it a motion or were you just?

22 MR. LAGRANGE:

23 No, I was just commenting at the
24 time. But, I will -- I'll move to -- that
25 we deny his application for the regular

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certification because he does not meet the qualifications for experience.

MR. STEWART:

Okay. Motion by Mr. Lagrange.

MR. WILLIAMS:

I second.

MR. STEWART:

Second by Mr. Williams.

Any more discussion? Motion carries.

Philip Parsons, Landfill, Level A,
Acadia Parish Landfill. Has Level B.
He's been there since --

MS. BORDELON:

It'll be four years in January.

MR. STEWART:

Yeah, so. And based on what his --

MR. FOURRIER:

He's got a high school diploma.

MS. BORDELON:

Yes. Yeah, they actually sent in three applications, one who had a Level B already applying for an A, and didn't have a high school diploma, so we pulled that one.

MR. STEWART:

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Any discussion?

MR. LAGRANGE:

It appears he meets the qualifications.

MR. STEWART:

Joshua P. Ravey, Landfill, Level B, Acadia Parish Landfill.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Is that 7/13 '13 or '14?

MS. BORDELON:

It's '13.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Thirteen? Okay.

MR. STEWART:

So, he's only been there a little over a year.

MS. BORDELON:

But he has almost a year previous to that.

MR. STEWART:

Okay.

MR. WILLIAMS:

September 10 to July 11.

MR. STEWART:

And he did the same thing at the

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previous.

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah, I don't know why he separated it because the title of his position was -- everything was exactly the same.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah, that's what I was -- I was wondering the same thing.

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah.

MR. FOURRIER:

Must have left for two years.

MS. BORDELON:

He left for two weeks, actually.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Two --

MS. BORDELON:

Oh, no, two years.

MR. FOURRIER:

Two years.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Two years.

MS. BORDELON:

You're right. You're right.

MR. FOURRIER:

1 But that would give him two years of
2 experience.

3 MR. LAGRANGE:

4 He had eight months and then ten
5 months.

6 MS. BORDELON:

7 Yeah, it still gives him the two
8 years.

9 MR. LAGRANGE:

10 It does?

11 MR. FOURRIER:

12 Yeah.

13 MR. LAGRANGE:

14 Okay.

15 MR. FOURRIER:

16 And he's got a high school
17 equivalent, well, that's not necessary for
18 a B.

19 MS. BORDELON:

20 Right.

21 MR. FOURRIER:

22 So, he's got the experience.

23 MR. WILLIAMS:

24 Yeah.

25 MR. STEWART:

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Okay.

Bobby B. Taylor, C&D, Level B,
Amid/Metro Landfill. Passed on 11/18/14.

MS. BORDELON:

Bobby Taylor -- we actually -- last year, maybe a year and a half ago, he came and took the Level A exam, and did not pass it. But the Board approved his application for a Level B. He didn't have -- I don't believe he had the qualifications for an A at the time anyway. So, he came back and took the B exam. His application had already been approved previously for a Level B.

MR. FOURRIER:

Yeah, he's got enough time.

MR. STEWART:

He seems to have the time he needs.

MR. FOURRIER:

Yeah.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.

MR. STEWART:

Okay. All right. Can I get a motion to accept these applications?

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MR. WILLIAMS:

So moved.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Moved by Mr. Williams, second by Mr. Lagrange. Any discussion? Any objection?

Motion carries.

Next item is review of extensions to conditional certifications.

MS. BORDELON:

This Jevcon facility, these are -- this will be their -- they were originally issued conditionals in July of 2013, they're just asking for another extension.

MR. STEWART:

And we've approved them in the past?

MS. BORDELON:

Right.

MR. FOURRIER:

They've been to the training?

MS. BORDELON:

So, this will be their -- yeah.

MR. LAGRANGE:

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They've met all of the requirements
for extension?

MS. BORDELON:

Yes. This will be their second or
third extension.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Mr. Chairman, do you want to read
those names into the record and what their
conditionals are for?

MR. STEWART:

Tora Fontenot.

MR. LAGRANGE:

C&D?

MR. STEWART:

C&D, Level B.

Henry Gaspard, C&D, Level B.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Harry?

MS. BORDELON:

Harry.

MR. STEWART:

Harry. Harry. I'm sorry.

Jevon Natali, C&D, Level A.

Those were the only three?

MS. BORDELON:

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Uh-huh (yes).

MR. LAGRANGE:

So moved, Mr. Chairman.

MR. STEWART:

Moved by Mr. Lagrange.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Second by Mr. Williams. Any further discussion? Any objection?

Motion carries.

MS. BORDELON:

Actually, we do have one -- I'm sorry, I left one application for conditional certification.

MR. WILLIAMS:

I was wondering why we skipped that one.

MR. STEWART:

William T. Hays?

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.

MR. STEWART:

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You didn't put him on the --

MR. WILLIAMS:

He's on the bottom of the page.

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah. He's asking for conditional right now, replacing Kurt Leger whose termination date was November 25, 2014. He's asking for conditional now because he didn't -- hasn't been able to come and take the exam, but would like his application reviewed for regular certification so that when he does take the exam we don't have to review it again.

MR. LAGRANGE:

All right. First of all, I'll make a motion to grant the conditional.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Motion by Mr. Lagrange, second by Mr. Williams. Any discussion? Any objection?

Motion carries.

MR. LAGRANGE:

All right. Now, let's look at his

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qualifications.

MR. STEWART:

2004 to present.

MS. BORDELON:

He's got an -- there's an attachment.
I asked him to go into more detail on his
experience.

MR. FOURRIER:

He appears to have the experience, so
now he just needs to take and pass the
test.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Pass the test.

MS. BORDELON:

Right.

MR. FOURRIER:

And then after that we can issue --

MS. BORDELON:

A regular. Uh-huh (yes).

MR. LAGRANGE:

But today we can approve his
application.

MR. FOURRIER:

His experience.

MS. BORDELON:

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We can issue him a conditional now until the Board meets again in March.

MR. LAGRANGE:

We just did.

MR. WILLIAMS:

We did that. But we can approve his application.

MR. LAGRANGE:

So now, when John makes the motion we'll approve the application.

MR. FOURRIER:

Motion to approve the application.

MR. STEWART:

Motion by Mr. Fourrier to approve the application.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Second by Mr. Williams. Any further discussion? Any objections?

Motion carries.

13 Level A, Transfer Station, Level A, C&D,

22 MS. BORDELON:

23 -- when we issued certifications.

24 MR. WILLIAMS:

25 Okay.

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MR. STEWART:

Get a motion to accept these
recertifications?

MR. LAGRANGE:

So moved.

MR. STEWART:

So moved by Mr. Lagrange.

MR. FOURRIER:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Second by Mr. Fourrier. Any
discussion? Any objection?

Motion carries. Issuance of operator
certificates.

MS. BORDELON:

Dieter Becker, C&D, Level A, Sandy
Callahan, C&D, Level B, Sandra DeRouen,
C&D, Level A, Cheryl Mclaughlin, Transfer
Station, Level B, and Bobby Taylor, C&D,
Level B.

MR. STEWART:

Motion to accept?

MS. TURTLE:

Motion to accept.

MR. STEWART:

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Motion by Mr. Turtle.

MS. BORDELON:

Mr. Turtle?

MR. STEWART:

Ms. Turtle, I'm sorry.

MS. TOWNSEL:

Second.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Look at her again.

MR. STEWART:

I'm looking at Mr. Lagrange.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Second.

MR. STEWART:

Ms. Townsel beat you. Motion by Ms. Turtle, second by Ms. Townsel. Any objection? Any discussion?

Motion carries.

All right. Next item is committee reports. Awards, Ms. Krystal Perkins.

Ms. Bordelon, do we have any news?

MS. BORDELON:

Just that I will be emailing out nomination forms for Operator of the Year awards for the conference.

1 MR. STEWART:
2 Okay.
3 MS. BORDELON:
4 I'll do that probably in January.
5 MR. STEWART:
6 Okay. Testing? Any news on the
7 testing?
8 MS. BORDELON:
9 No. No news.
10 MR. STEWART:
11 How about continuing education?
12 MS. BORDELON:
13 No.
14 MR. STEWART:
15 No news?
16 MS. BORDELON:
17 Everybody's positions have been
18 appointed.
19 MR. STEWART:
20 I think I go off. I'm the only one
21 going off for --
22 MR. LAGRANGE:
23 No, that's on the nominating.
24 MS. BORDELON:
25 No.

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MR. LAGRANGE:

You're not on nominating, you're on continuing education.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Right.

MS. BORDELON:

Oh, yeah.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Leave my report alone.

MR. STEWART:

Oh, okay.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Can I make my report?

MS. BORDELON:

Wait? What's continuing education?
That's conferences. That's workshops.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Obviously, the conference has already been approved.

MS. BORDELON:

Right.

MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah..

MR. LAGRANGE:

For ten hours.

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MR. STEWART:

In March.

MR. LAGRANGE:

Which will be held in March. And it is my understanding there will be some presentations at the March Board meeting to approve some workshops in June or July and October.

MR. STEWART:

Okay. All right. Now, nominating, Mr. Williams?

MR. WILLIAMS:

Well, that report has already been made.

MS. BORDELON:

Yeah. Sorry.

MR. STEWART:

Well, I have to go through them anyway.

The next item is other business. Any public comments?

MR. LAGRANGE:

Mr. Chairman, I just want to -- on behalf of the Board, I want to welcome our new members --

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MR. WILLIAMS:

Yeah.
