- Mr. Simon stated the he has been in contact with representatives from the 3D Company which is interested in using Louisiana Sweet Potatoes in pet food.

- In August, Mr. Simon met with a group of French farmers who were interested in the sweet potato industry.
- Mr. Simon, Ms. Mary Gallent, and Mrs. Melanie Tullier attended the Louisiana Restaurant Association Food Service Expo in August.
- Mr. Simon and Ms. Gallent attended the Produce Marketing Association show in Anaheim, CA, in October.

- Mr. Simon notified the board that the McCall's plant will be closing.

REPORT FROM DIANE ALLEN AND ASSOCIATES
