Motion by Will Theriot; 2nd by Jack Croker to approve the minutes of the meeting of September 5, 2013 with the correction of the spelling of Jack Croker's name on the motion to provide up to \$500.00 for the Museum Ground Breaking Ceremony. Approved by the Board.

A request was made for comments from the public with no response.
