Regional Military Museum Foundation: Report by Mart Black:

- 1) RMMF's Executive Committee met to review 2021 budget proposal to be approved by RMMF Board on 08/09/2020 meeting & transmitted to Kandace to District for approval.
- 2) In-house repairs to man-lift, half of lights in Museum have been replaced. Lights purchased through a grant and burn less electricity. A dimmer feature installed on just 8 lights.
- 3) Great progress & functionality restored to the Link Trainer. This artifact will be moved into the Museum when completed & expected to be a popular attraction.
- 4) Minor work remains on the Lathe & will be completed after lights installation. They plan to sell this Lathe.
- 5) Restoration work on the LCVP will resume after lathe is repaired.
- 6). Dexter is actively pursuing grants. Richard is working on exhibit-building & exhibit maintenance.
- 7). RMM received a \$1000.00 donation from the estate of Ray Marcello to be used for Library where he worked until his death.
- 8). A 2004 Jeep donated by Mary Downer, we expect to clean up, make operational & sell. A 2005 Jeep donated by MG Hunt Downer will be put on Museum display & used in parades and static displays.
- 9). Working to secure antique licenses & insurance for all operational Jeeps that are used in parades and static displays.
- 10). Expect to have self-guide acoustic guide system operational for visitors by the end of the year or shortly thereafter.
- 11). Since our last board meeting, the Museum has had 121 visitors.
- 12). Have received a donation of four authentic WWII era maps from the WWII Museum in New Orleans.
- 13). The museum's website can now take payments for donations, memberships, & memorial bricks. You are encouraged to visit the website & subscribe to receive e-mail updates.
- 14). Any comments on the Strategic Plan that Mart Black handed out last month?

Mr. C.J. Christ reported that he had two interviews about the Museum and felt that they went very well.

Discussion of other matter: Ms. Kandace reported that the Government Tower is still closed to the public until phase 3 is reached. Also parking at the Museum for the handicap: After further discussion, parking cones could be placed out on the day and time for meeting allowing safe parking for handy accessible vehicles, then using new ramp into building.
