1. Lansing Trade Group, LLC

1. Grain and Cotton Indemnity Fund and Self-Insurance Fund Balances

Mrs. Fitzgerald stated that the balance of the Grain and Cotton Indemnity Fund is \$4,776,263 and the Self-Insurance Fund is \$883,047. Mr. Robert Hanks asked if there were any pending claims. Mrs. Fitzgerald stated there were no pending claims. The Self-Insurance Fund will rise greatly during licensing applications. Mr. Berken asked about the status on legislation and the sweeping of funds. Mrs. Fitzgerald stated that the Commissioner was in Washington last week and that the legislative session would begin next month and that the Commissioner would do what he could to avoid any sweeping of funds but at this time there was no way to create legislation to avoid the sweeping of funds if the Legislature decided to do so.
