A motion was made by Mr. Viator to give Commissioner Strain the authority to negotiate on behalf of the LAFA board the sale and/or lease of the Winnsboro office. It was seconded by Mr. Waguespack, and passed unanimously.

City of Vidalia/Healthy Hunger Free Kids Act Program

Porocel Request for Option to Lease 50 Acres at Lacassine Industrial Park

Porocel is seeking an option to lease an additional 50 acres without a financial consideration. A motion was made by Mr. Parker to not accept Porocel's request. It was seconded by Mr. Viator, and passed unanimously.

Consideration to Lease Portion of the Opelousas Building

Our Savior's Church is requesting to lease 11,000 square feet of the Opelousas building through 2016 (two year lease).

A motion was made by Mr. Gauthier to give Commissioner Strain the authority to proceed with negotiations with Our Savior's Church. It was seconded by Mr. Viator, and passed unanimously.
