CALL TO ORDER

There were no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVOUS MEETING

Commissioner Strain asked the board members to review the minutes from the September 22, 2014, meeting.

Motion: A motion was made by Mr. Viator to approve the minutes from the September 22, 2014, meeting. It was seconded by Mr. Stutts, and passed unanimously.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

Mrs. Catrina Irvin presented LAFA's Financial Statements to the board and answered the members' questions.

COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

Mr. Simon updated the board on the status of the Lacassine Industrial Park.
Porocel is occupying the mill site and has started to make several improvements.
LAFA is in the process of upgrading the electrical system and drainage at the site.

OLD BUSINESS

Lacassine Industrial Park Rail Consultant

Mr. Simon stated that ViaRail Logistics is currently reviewing the growth potential of the Lacassine Industrial Park, and will be developing competitive rates for the site.

Mr. Simon stated that LAFA signed a six month agreement with Chris Cruze to market the Winnsboro property.

NEW BUSINESS

<u>Municiplaities Continuing Disclosure Cooperative (MCDC) Initiative of the Securities Exchange Commission</u>

A resolution was offered by Mr. Hawkins authorizing the Commissioner Strain to consult with counsel and determine whether to participate in the Municipalities Continuing Disclosure Cooperative (MCDC) Initiative of the Securities Exchange Commission (SEC).
