#### APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM PREVOUS MEETING

Commissioner Strain asked the board members to review the minutes from the July 21, 2017 meeting.

#### **REVIEW OF FINANCIAL STATEMENTS**

#### COMMISSIONER'S REPORT

- Mr. Simon updated the board on the Lacassine Industrial Park (LIP). Rail Logix is now the official rail provider at the LIP. Rail Logix will take over as management of the park in February 2018. All construction in Phase 1 is expected to be completed in the summer of 2018.
- Mr. Simon notified the board that the Defeasance of the 2012 Racino Bonds was completed in December. The bonds were paid off on September 15, 2017. LAFA is now out of debt.

# 2016 Louisiana Farm Recovery Grant Program

LAFA received 1065 applications to the 2016 Louisiana Farm Recovery Grant Program. The program is approximately 40% complete with Phase 1. Phase 1 should be completed by January 31, Phase 2 completed by February 28, and awards are expected to be funded in March.

## Appointment of Deana Erdey as the Assistant Director of LAFA

A motion was made by Mr. Parker to appoint Deana Erdey as Assistant Director of LAFA. It was seconded by Mr. Petree, and passed unanimously.

#### Lease of former computer server room at LDAF headquarters to Louisiana State Police Commission

A motion was made by Mr. Viator to put out a bid for a cash rent lease of the LDAF Seedling Nursery property at the Monroe office complex. It was seconded by Mr. Parker, and passed unanimously.

#### Resolution to allow DOTD to resurface Woodworth airport runway

A motion was made to approve the resolution allowing DOTD to resurface the Woodworth airport runway by Mr. Parker. It was seconded by Mr. Waguespack, and passed unanimously.

#### LDAF/LAFA's marketing efforts and overhaul of the Louisiana Certified Programs

Deana Erdey is currently working on revamping the Louisiana Certified Programs. She has met with other states to get advice on what has helped their programs. The new website will be launching in January. The currently budget for 2018 marketing efforts is \$500,000.
