## I. Call to Order and Pledge of Allegiance

Chairman Carmouche called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m. and asked for everyone to join in the Pledge of Allegiance. Carmouche asked Black to call roll. With twelve of the thirteen Commissioners present, Carmouche declared a quorum.

### II. Agenda Approval

Chairman Carmouche called for a motion to approve the agenda for this meeting. Stansbury made a motion to approve the agenda. Seconded by Black. Motion carried unanimously (13-0) with Burton absent.

#### III. Minutes Approval

Chris Burton noted that he was indicated as absent the draft minutes, but he did attend the meeting. Bergeron made a motion to approve the minutes as amended. Seconded by Rummler. Motion carried unanimously (14-0) with Burton present.

### VI. Executive Director Update

The Executive Director position was open on the State Civil Service website from December 17, 2019 until January 17, 2020. 80 applications were received. Staff will review applications and submit top candidates to the Executive Committee for interview selection by the full Commission in February.

### VII. 2019 National Park Service Reporting

OCD staff will complete the FY18-19 federal reporting and FY19-20 federal budget request and scope of work. The final documents will be shared with the Commission after submitted.

## VIII. Grants Overview/Update

OCD staff reviewed the grant spreadsheet presented to the Commission. Proctor made a motion to approve the pending grant application by the St. Mary Parish Tourist Commission for Wings to Soar 2020. The grant application was for \$3,250. Seconded by Bergeron. Motion carried unanimously (13-0-1) with Stansbury abstaining.

Black made a motion to ratify all the grant applications that are executed or underway. LeGrange made a substitute motion to ratify the grant applications that are executed or underway, except the grant to the Atchafalaya Basinkeepers. Seconded by Gardner. Motion carried unanimously (11-0-3) with Bergeron, Davis and Rummler abstaining.

Proctor made a motion to approve the pending grant application for the Thibodaux-Loudun Twinning Association for \$3,150 (\$2,800 for transportation and \$350 for speaker fee and lunch). Black seconded. Motion approved unanimously (14-0).

In the future, the Executive Committee will serve as the Grant Committee.
