The center in Baton Rouge is anticipated to be open in May of this year, so that's an 800-hundred job IBM Technology Center.

Later that month, Qalytics announced their relocation of a Seattle-based game testing company to the Louisiana Technology Park here in Baton Rouge.

Later that month, High Voltage Software announced the establishment of New Orleans game development studio. This Chicago-area tech firm was established in 1993. The project will result in 80 new direct jobs and over 110 new indirect jobs. This project has shipped over 95 game titles and worked with over 25 major brands, including Toy Story, Batman, LEGO and others since that 1993 timeframe. They'll be leasing space in the New Orleans Central Business District.

Earlier this month, we broke ground on a new 50,000 square foot facility that will serve as the University of Louisiana at Lafayette Research Park anchor. CGI will house a 400-job technology center at that facility in Lafayette. With the indirect jobs included, this represents 800 new permanent jobs in Acadiana, and the announcement also includes a \$4.5-million higher-education initiative, which will be lead by UL Lafayette and result in tripling the number

of undergraduate degrees awarded annually by the School of Computing and Informatics, so an exciting announcement in Lafayette.

And just this month, a few days ago, actually, IBM announced a 400-job Application

Development and Innovation Center in Monroe. The technology facility will anchor an 80-acre

CenturyLink-affiliated technology park and will employ a wide range of college graduates and experienced professionals in computer science, other quantitative-intense fields such as engineering, mathematics and science. With the indirect jobs included, a total of 800 new permanent jobs in Northeast Louisiana.

so really over the last several months, a host of milestones and announcements related to software development. We're excited to see that momentum and great to see that companies are investing across the state, so a variety of locations across the state associated with that. So I wanted to cover that trend we've been seeing.

Also, I wanted to hit on our industrial manufacturing projects. We continue to see a wave of interest in Louisiana. We saw the BG/Energy Transfer project on our agenda today with the LNG project. We

also had two additional LNG projects. LNG Export
Facilities announced over the last several months its
Venture Global LNG and Live Oak LNG at 4.25-billion and
2-billion here each in the Southeast Louisiana area, so
quite a lot of activity related to LNG Exports.

We also saw Honeywell announced the completion of a \$33-million manufacturing expansion in Baton Rouge.

Just this month, Metalplate Galvanizing announced a \$9.7-million investment for a new galvanizing facility in Jennings Louisiana. This company has been in business since the 1930s based in Birmingham, Alabama with seven facilities across the U.S. This is the first facility in Louisiana.

And then just Friday, American Specialty Alloys announced a plan for a \$2.4-billion aluminum mill complex in Central Louisiana. The plan calls for the creation of over 1,400 new direct jobs and the 12,000-acre mill complex is the complex known and formerly operated by International Paper in Pineville and the mill is targeting strong light-weight metal for the automotive and aerospace industries as those industries transfer to lighter and lighter material. So a very exciting announcement in central Louisiana as well.



When you take a look at those two
segments along with other projects over the last several
years, since 2008, we secured projects resulting in more
than 91,000 new direct and indirect jobs and 62-billion
in new capital investment across the state. So, again,
we continue to see a lot of positive momentum in the
software development and our industrial manufacturing
sectors, in particular. We're seeing a lot of
activities and exciting about those success and the
opportunities ahead for the calendar year.
With that, I will wrap up my remarks,
but, again, I want to thank all of our Board members for
their participation, and, again, with the inclement
weather, we appreciate you making the trip in.
