24	new website will be a valuable resource
25	for Louisiana employers to help them

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quickly locate talented, qualified applicants. Additionally, it will provide new opportunities for former residents of Louisiana to find good job opportunities here in the state.

So we wanted to introduce this website to our Board members and ask that you take a look at the website. If there is applicability to any of your business needs, there is an opportunity to sign on and become part of the website. Also, as you are talking in your local communities about workforce related challenges, issues, opportunities, I would appreciate you referring people to this new tool.

We're very excited about the possibility and think that you will be, too, when you learn more about it, so, Brenda, I will turn it over to you.

The lights.

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As Steve said, that on June 13, LED rolled out the Louisiana Job Connection, which we're very glad to share with you today as you can take back to your prospective areas of the state. It's a new free website that will help the needs of the talent recruitment needs of Louisiana employers while serving as a centralized hub for job seekers. It was rolled out on June 13th for employers, and it will be rolled out on August 18th for job seekers, so it's very exciting and we wanted to share this with you, and I will make a few comments after we view the video.

MS. GUESS:

Quite exciting. I think that the majority of the presentation or any materials there -- I have given you a handout. That was the press release that was issued by the Department back in June. There is a website,

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www.louisianajobconnection.com, and one of the things that we think that is going to be a very robust job matching opportunity that puts job seekers with the right employers and -- with the right applicants -- sorry. I think everybody heard me, though. But, so, what we're really excited as a Department to have this rolled out, and if there are any questions that you might have at this time, I will try to answer them. If not, we'll make certain that if you have any further needs for any of the presentations within your area to larger groups for employers or prospective employers, contact us. Our communications department does have plans to roll this out and to larger groups. Thanks.

## MR. GRISSOM:

I wanted to make a few additional comments. As part of our LED FastStart efforts, LED FastStart has consistently been ranked in the top workforce development program, state

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workforce development program in the U.S., and part of their services involves recruiting. It's essentially recruiting and training employees as new jobs are filled. LED FastStart was essentially implementing this type of recruiting functionality for individual companies somewhat on an ad hoc basis as companies need it, and so as LED FastStart has developed more and more clients as we've announced more projects, there was a need to replicate this type of service.

We looked at how those types of capabilities might benefit all of Louisiana employers, and so ultimately decided this could be something that any Louisiana based employer might benefit from, and that's what prompted this rollout, so we're excited about the opportunity. It's an easy to use system, and one that's been -- that, along with the process, has been executed very successfully for LED FastStart clients, so we think there's

Page 29 a group opportunity to leverage this 1 approach across the state. 2 MR. FRUGE: 3 Okay. Thank you, Mr. Grissom. 4 Did you want to speak to this at all? 5 MS. GUESS: 6 I will -- I will take that as 7 well. The other handout that you have 8 before you is a -- some information 9 based on what was taken from the 10 minutes from the April meeting, some 11 concerns of the comparisons between the 12 amount of the incentives that are used 13 for residents, businesses and those 14 that might be recruited into the state. 15 We've provided that information for you 16 and we hope that that suits the needs. 17 If there are any additions, 18 corrections or any further information 19 that you would like for us to take a 20 look at, we'll be more than happy to do 21 22 so. It has been brought to my attention today that the legislature has apparently commissioned a study by Dr. Richard or Richardson from LSU, and the results of that study should be available next year. Just — which would quantify some of the economic impacts, I think, of our programs.

Mr. Chairman, first of all, thank you to Brenda and the rest of the staff that worked on this. I know that we had an opportunity to speak by telephone since last meeting and they were trying to clarify exactly what we were looking for, and I appreciate the dialogue and I appreciate the work, and I think this is good information.

I just -- I know we all come

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to these meetings every other month and there is a lot of things that go on, for those of you sitting in the audience, with a lot of rubber stamping that seems to go on, but there is a lot of work that goes into these meetings and a lot of work that goes into these programs, and I think one of my desires is I have grown to know more about these programs is that we start helping the public understand how important they are; not only the companies that are able to take advantage of the incentive programs, but also the public at large to know that these programs are available and they are doing a great deal to help.

I was riding the elevator
with somebody coming in today and the
company has been here for 40 years and
able to expand his business and add new
employees simply because of the
incentives made the margins worked, and
I think that's real important, and I
like to see these numbers because these
