They auctioned the majority of their personal property in 17 February 2013. Since they are no 18 19 longer manufacturing, we request 20 cancellation of the remaining contracts. focused on IBM, so a very 1 2 exciting project opportunity with 3 a world class company and in a sector that department has been targeting for sometime, so we're very excited to bring that project to fruition and excited about the potential here in Baton 8 9 Rouge and the State.

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Also wanted to mention that we continue to receive positive recognition out of the State. FDI Magazine, which covers investment across the globe, recently recognized both New Orleans and Lafayette among top American cities of the future. Their assessment was based on a wide variety of factors. With New Orleans ranking 7th -- I'm sorry, 6th overall in the top ten

23	future. Only one other American
24	city was in that list that the
25	remaining were in Canada, and
