CALL TO ORDER

The meeting was called to order by Mr. Danny Logan at 10:05 a.m.

ROLL CALL

The roll was called by Tonya Peairs.

PUBLIC COMMENT

There were no public comments.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion: Mr. Parker made a motion to approve the meeting minutes from November 5, 2013. The motion was seconded by Mr. Walker and passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS

Mr. Bordelon informed the commission that Mr. Skipper Guillot has made final payment on the fine imposed by the commission on December 13, 2011. He also gave an update on 2013 cotton acreage and payment totals.

NEW BUSINESS

Report from the Commissioner

Mr. Parker introduced Christopher Mora, Attorney for the Department of Agriculture and Forestry, who was on hand to answer any legal questions. A discussion ensued regarding draft regulations drawn up by the Department of Agriculture and Forestry and how it pertained to the boll weevil eradication regulations.

Motion: Mr. Parker made a motion to adopt the draft regulations and move forward with promulgation and with an emergency rule to immediately implement the regulations. The motion was seconded by Mr. Guthrie and passed unanimously.

Mr. Bordelon read the resolution verbatim and Mr. Mora summarized the resolution for the commission.

Motion: Mr. Parker made a motion to accept the resolution for adoption of regulations. This motion was seconded by Dr. Kerns. The motion passed unanimously.

Update from the Director

Mr. Bordelon informed the commission that there were significant stalks remaining for one grower and that grower would receive a warning letter.

Technical Advisory Committee

Dr. Kerns gave a report from the Technical Advisory Committee Meeting held in February. The meeting included discussions on Standard Operating Procedures and Trapping Protocols exceeding minimum standards with no recommendations for change. He also informed the commission that the National Boll Weevil Protection Committee is promoting an assessment of up to .75 cents per acre to maintain the buffer zone in Texas.

Mr. Lacour asked Dr. Kerns to discuss benefits of stalk destruction at the next Technical Advisory Committee meeting and report its findings to the commission.

There was no new update from Mr. Breaux.
