		Data shows that 90% of the people CAHSD serves have some social detrimental health, some issues regarding housing, their jobs, foods, and security. Top ten diagnoses were reviewed.  Dr. Laughinghouse provided an overview of the process to make external referrals for clients who need services not provided by CAHSD.  The medical provider at the clinic is Gertrude Chimeka Anyanwoke, MD, an Infectious Disease Specialist. Other clinic staff are a nurse, a CMA, the CAHSD Director of Nursing and Director of Operations who manages the clinic. Accreditation is required in order to bill Medicaid and indicates compliance with Medicare.</li> </ul>	
Billing/RCM Update	Dr. Laughinghouse	A billing report for July 2024-December 2024 was provided for review. Dr. Laughinghouse reminded the Board that CAHSD began filing paper claims after the cyberattack last Fall. CAHSD began filing electronic claims again in February and were able to go back to other claims electronic filing beginning again in June. All the claims were refiled to TriZetto. CAHSD met 72% of the annual collection goal and is on track. There were no questions.
