Our survey will be scheduled for a digital survey between January 1, 2022 and February 28, 2022. She stated that CAHSD's current accreditation will remain in effect until the outcome of the survey is available to us which should be available no later than April 28, 2022.

		laws/statutes, before considering/making any changes to the Ends					
		Statement and the Financial Conditions & Activities Policy, the					
		CAHSD attorney was contacted for an opinion.					
		The essence of the attorney's opinion is that any type of change					
		we make has to be carefully made and we have to put it through					
		legal review. Our recommendation, based on the attorney's					
		opinion, is that we accept the Ends Statement and the Financial Conditions and Activities Policy as they are written now, without					
		revisions, without trying to change our Board governance model					
		until the Board has had time to review/discuss proposed changes					
		and the impact they would have on CAHSD. We would work					
		through legal before making any changes. Legal will review and					
		make sure we are within the scope of what we are allowed to do					
		based on law/statutes before we make any changes.					
		Dr. Laughinghouse's suggestion re: changing the Board governance					
		model is that the Board can review the legal opinion and at the					
		upcoming Board retreat, decide if they want to appoint an ad hoc					
		committee to determine if they want to change the Board model. The current CAHSD Board model is the Carver model. Other models are					
		the Complementary model and the Traditional model. Dr.					
		Laughinghouse stated that she believes because the CAHSD Board is a					
		policy governance board, the Traditional model appears to be a lot					
		more into operations, which is not what the law allows. The					
		Complementary model would be the model that could be looked at that					
		would be comparable to the Carver model. She suggested that if you					
		want to do that, all directors receive training even if a decision is made					
		to keep the Carver model. There are directors who have been here for					
		a while that know the Carver model and what your responsibilities are

		have been pretty thorough and the Board delegates the authority to the					
		Executive Director. He asked if the CAHSD attorney could be present
