Crime Victims Reparations Board

MARCH 10, 2015

A quorum was not present at the monthly meeting for the Crime Victims Reparations Board on March 10, 2015. The members present made the decision to discuss the cases before them and make recommendations for the April 21, 2015 meeting.
