12	is expected to have a cap of
13	\$1.45 million and will consist of
14	\$700,000 from E.I. Williams for
15	capital equipment, and \$750,000
16	for building renovations. 500 of
17	this will come from the district
18	with the additional 250 for EDAP.
19	E.I. Williams has agreed to
20	create 100 jobs with an estimated
21	payroll of \$4.5 million by 2029.
22	Northwestern Parish has an
23	unemployment rate of 6.3 percent
24	compared to 4.8 for the state,
25	and a per capita of 40,175



1	compared to 46,242 for the state.
2	The project is estimated to
3	create state revenues of \$4.7
4	million with the company
5	receiving incentives of 1.4 for
6	the quality jobs program and
7	250,000 for the EDAP. This will
8	result in a net revenue of almost
9	\$3 million for the state.
10	Staff recommends the \$250,000
11	sponsored EDAP for the usual
12	contingencies including the copy
13	of the lease once executed to be
14	submitted prior to the execution
15	of the EDAP. Number the
16	contingency No. 3, which was a
17	board resolution in favor of the
18	project by the northwest parish
19	industrial district was received
20	yesterday.
