state in so many capacities, such an honorable person and we owe him that moment of silence.

(Whereupon a moment of silence was

observed.)

MR. ANDRE:

Okay. Thank you.

Okay. We're here this morning to amend an EDAP that we approved at the last Board meeting, so, Susan you want to introduce it?

MS. BIGNER:

Yes, sir.

Good morning. I appreciate all of you taking your time to come and brave the cold weather. As you remember, last month we approved Flying Tiger for a \$575,000 sponsored EDAP. It's going to be sponsored by the City of Bastrop. Mayor Jones is here to represent the City. Kay King is here for the Morehouse Economic, and Retired Colonel Lawrence Rolfs is here -- "Mo" is how he goes by -- for the company.

As Mr. Andre said, unfortunately
Mr. Barham died last month, and we had requested a
personal guaranty by him as well as Mr. Rolfs. Due to
the circumstances, we'd like to amend the contract to
state that only a personal guaranty is required from
Mr. Rolfs. We will still have the company guaranty.



1	Barham Brothers will still own 25 percent of the
2	business. There's been no other changes. We just would
3	like to amend the guaranty from Mr. Barham and Mr. Rolfs
4	to just Mr. Rolfs.
5	MR. CANGELOSI:
6	Barham Brothers was going to be
7	guarantors as well. Are they still going to be
8	guarantors?
9	MS. BIGNER:
10	Yes. The son one of the sons is
11	going to be
12	MR. CANGELOSI:
13	I noticed that in there, but you didn't
14	say anything, so I wanted to mention that.
15	MS. BIGNER:
16	Okay. I'm sorry. Thank you very much.
17	I appreciate that.

19	So summarize for us the guaranty.
20	MS. BIGNER:
21	We're going to have a guaranty for the
22	\$575,000 EDAP by the company, Flying Tiger, which is 75
23	percent owned by Mr. Rolfs and 25 percent owned by
24	Barham Brothers, and then we're going to have a personal
25	in solido guaranty by Mr. Rolfs, so the EDAP is still



1	going to go forward. It's still going to be use for		
2	tarmacs. There's been no change in anything else. It's		
3	just due to this unfortunate circumstance, we're going		
4	to have to change the guarantor.		
5	MR. CANGELOSI:		
6	The last time, we were going to have a		
7	75 percent guaranty from Mr. Rolfs and a 25 percent		
8	guaranty from Mr. Barham. We'll no longer have that 25,		
9	but Mr. Rolfs has stepped up to 100 percent.

8	I could do a deal with on a handshake and it would be
9	honored, and I had been looking for that my whole life.
10	He was a mentor to me for two years, and just a huge,
11	huge loss, not in terms of his technical expertise or
12	anything he would have brought to this project or
13	anything he could have done physically, but just his
14	presence and his wisdom and his
